BACKGROUND:
Summary

The Board approved a contract with Spiess Construction Company, Inc., in the amount of \$1,661,553 as Agenda Item Number 11-1 on October 21, 2014. The total payment of the contract is \$1,704,823. This includes a change order for subsurface trash removal within the basin and overage due to quantity adjustment, which totals 2.6% and is under the 10% project contingency. The District does not anticipate any claims for additional compensation from the Contractor.

This project will consist of the construction of approximately 1700 lineal feet of reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) ranging from 60 inches to 72 inches for the mainline and 18 inches to 36 inches for the laterals. Three catch basins, one along Temescal Canyon Road and two along Foster Road, will collect local drainage. The outlet structure will be an impact type energy dissipator. The mainline will cross underneath Temescal Canyon Road and connect to an existing 54-inch culvert. The proposed project is located south of the City of Corona within unincorporated Riverside County, east of the I-15 freeway and south of Dos Lagos Drive.
