

**BACKGROUND:**

**(Summary)**

On September 1, 2015, the Board approved the contract documents for the Construction of 2015 Site Improvements at the Badlands Landfill, and authorized the Department to advertise for bids. During the advertisement period, the Department issued one (1) Addendum. On September 21, 2015, a total of five (5) bids were received, with H&H General Contractors, Inc. submitting the lowest bid. After review of the bid results, Department staff has determined that H&H General Contractors has the necessary experience and capability to perform the work, and County Counsel has determined that the bid documents are in order. A summary of the bids received, along with the Contract Agreement between the County and H&H General Contractors, and the required performance and payment bonds are attached herewith.

**California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Findings**

On September 1, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved contract documents for the construction of site improvements at the Badlands Landfill. As such, a Notice of Exemption (NOE) was filed, identifying that the Project was exempt from CEQA pursuant to the State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) (General Rule for Exemption), and categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15301 Existing Facilities and Section 15304 Minor Alterations of Land. The 35-day statute of limitations for review and comment has expired, with no comments or challenges to the NOE received. Since the proposed motion in this Form-11 simply involves the award of a contract to complete the work already assessed under the NOE, nothing further is required under CEQA.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

Completion of the project will improve drainage structures, create all weather access and enhance existing erosion control measures within existing public facilities. As a result, water quality within the facilities storm water discharge shall improve.

Budget for this additional work will be provided from Fund 40200, Department ID – 4500100000.

**Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

This is a public works construction contract with a specified duration of 50 working days for completion. Due to the competitive bid process, and also based on recent similar projects, Department staff believes that the submitted bid amount is reasonable.

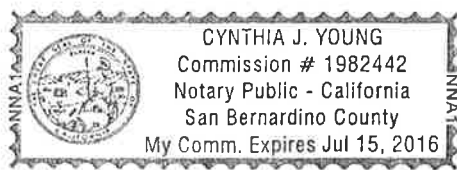

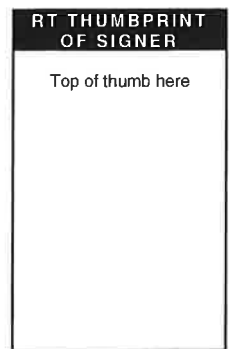

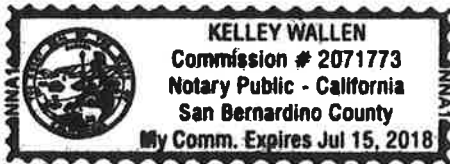
