BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department (County) recently completed construction of a major widening project on State Route 79 (SR-79) between Domenigoni Parkway and Thompson Road. This eight mile segment of SR-79 was widened from two to four lanes to accommodate current and projected traffic volumes between the Temecula/Murrieta area and the Winchester/Hemet/San Jacinto area.

The SR-79 Widening Project included drainage improvements along the entire segment to protect SR-79 and the traveling public from flooding during storm events. The flood control improvements included replacing and upsizing the existing culverts that had been in place since the original construction of the two lane highway. One of the culverts that was replaced was a 30-inch diameter corrugated steel pipe that crossed under SR-79, just north of Newport Road. This pipe was replaced with a double six foot by three foot concrete box culvert to better accommodate the runoff and protect the newly widened highway from a 100 year storm event. A consequence of the SR-79 widening was that a natural detention basin on the west side of SR-79 was regraded, and the larger culvert would no longer restrict the flow of water downstream. The County made modifications to the outlet of the box culvert to redirect flows as part of the SR-79 Widening Project; however, additional modifications are needed upstream to detain the water and replicate the before condition. The permanent improvements require modification to the box culvert and the construction of a detention basin upstream of the culvert.

As part of future development on the west side of SR-79, the developer is conditioned to construct a detention basin to fully control flows through and downstream of the SR-79 culvert at Newport Road. The developer is in the early stages of development, and it is unknown when the detention basin will be built. Since the basin is critical to the function of the newly constructed box culvert and resolves an existing drainage deficiency, the County proposes to build a portion of the basin to better control the current storm water runoff. The right-of-way for the basin is being provided at no cost to the County by the Developer. Once the development is initiated, the basin will be improved by the developer to accommodate a park, a soccer field, and a playground, as well as manage storm water flows. After the developer's basin is constructed, maintenance of the detention basin/park will be transferred to Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District (VWRPD). The developer has executed easement documents to allow the County to construct the basin within their property.

By Minute Order dated July 21, 2015 (Agenda Item 3-53), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the SR-79 basin in the community of Winchester.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their Contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The addendum was issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addendum is attached.

The contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents, which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The construction of the detention basin on the west side of SR-79, north of Newport Road, will control the flow of water through the culvert under the road and minimize downstream drainage impacts.

The construction work will take approximately two months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to Vance Corporation for the total amount of \$254,153. The project is funded with Measure A/Western funds. Ongoing maintenance costs are expected to be approximately \$5,000 per year, which will be funded by Gas Tax. The County will maintain the basin in the interim until the ultimate basin, which will also be a park site, is maintained by VWRPD. There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Nine bids were received on August 12, 2015, ranging from \$254,153 to \$474,370. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Vance Corporation in the amount of \$254,153, which is \$35,132 (12%) lower than the Engineer's Estimate.

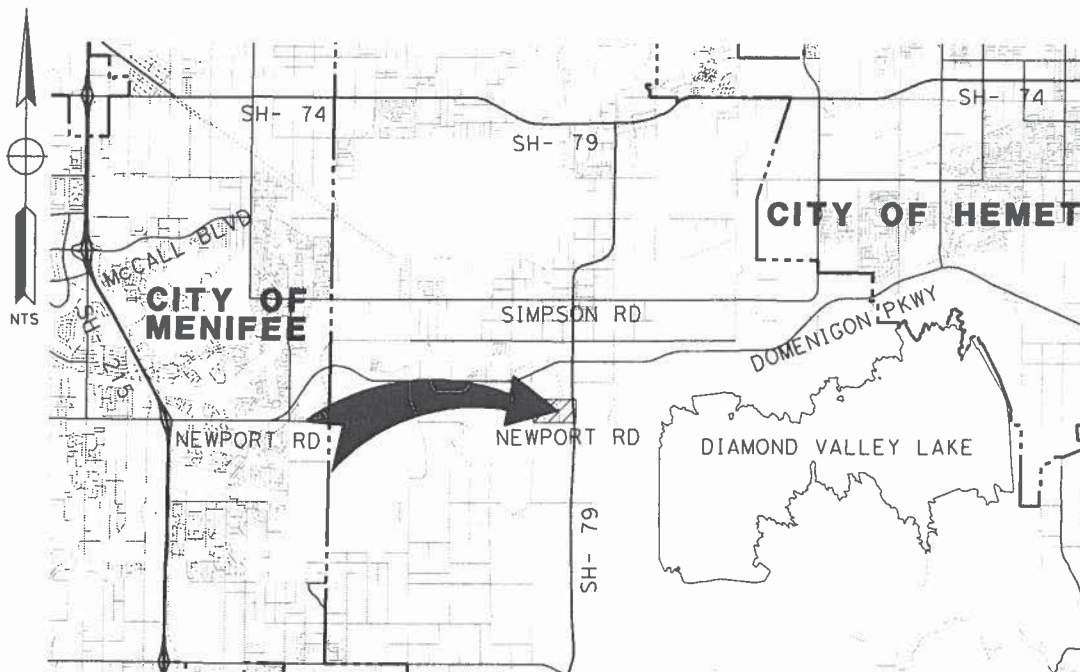
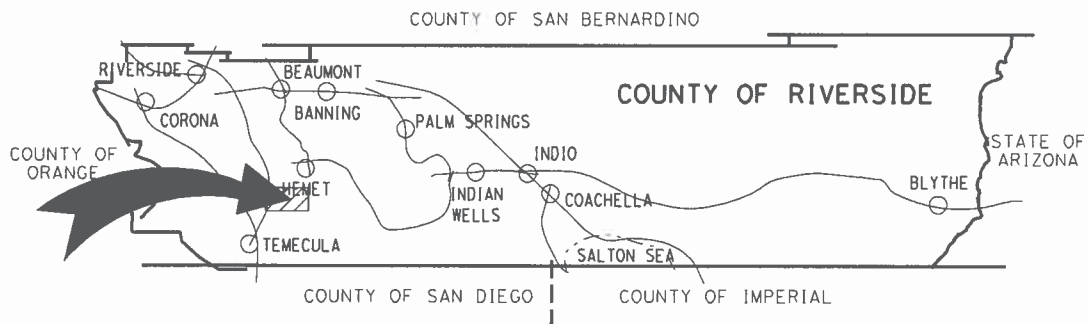
Vicinity Map

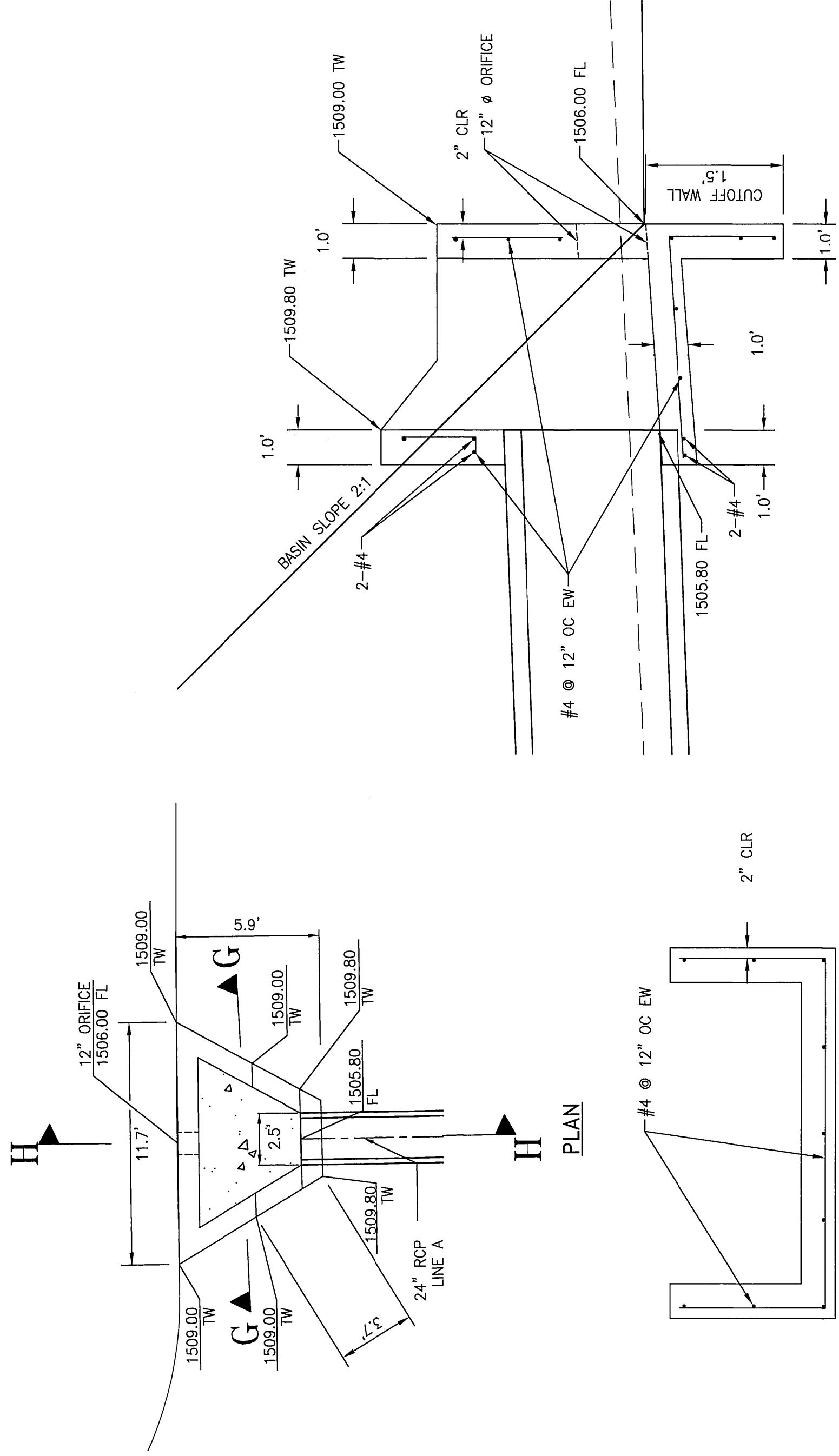
CONCRETE BULKHEAD AND RCB CONNECTION DETAIL
