BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Foundation for Economic Security \$8700 FES will be assisting the 1st District in purchasing and distributing frozen turkeys to residents in need throughout the 1st District. The turkeys will be distributed through the following nonprofit organizations: Bryant Park, Casa Blanca Home of Neighborly Service, Community Settlement Association, Helping Our People in Elsinore, Janet Goeske Center, Latnet-Centro de Ninos, Newman Center, Queen of Angels, The Concerned Family, Whiteside Manor, and Wildomar Senior Community. Foundation for Economic Security will purchase the turkeys and the 1st District Supervisor's Office will arrange for the nonprofit organizations to pick up and either distribute the turkeys to their communities or provide a community meal.
- 2. Community Outreach Ministry \$500 funds will be used to benefit their Annual Angel Tree Christmas Tree Project which will provide food and clothing to 200+ at-risk and/or needy children (ages 0-18) whose parents are incarcerated, as well as provide them with a holiday meal.
- 3. Elsinore High School \$1,000 funds will be used to assist the Elsinore High School Aquatics Program repair safety and cosmetic issues of the aging pool at Elsinore High School. The pool is used for school sports teams as well as programs open to the public.
- 4. Kiwanis Club of Uptown Riverside \$1000 funds will assist in helping needy families in Riverside Unified School District. Kiwanis adopts 150 needy RUSD families to feed and clothe during the Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday seasons.
- 5. Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Inland Empire \$1500 funding will be used to provide support to a free after school program that matches high school students with elementary school students on school campuses in the 1st District to promote academic and social support.
