### BACKGROUND: Summary

- 1. The Coachella Valley Association of Governments' Homelessness Committee will be authorizing the purchase of bus passes from the Sunline Transit Agency for the benefit of local homelessness service providers. Clients will be able to utilize the SunLine Bus to access supportive services and seek employment so that they can become self-sufficient. In 2014, the CVAG Homelessness Committee distributed more than 5,000 passes to clients in the Coachella Valley. The CID funds will be used to purchase bus passes.
- 2. Healing Horses is a non-profit organization that is committed to improving the lives of special needs children and adults utilizing a multi-pronged therapeutic approach that will produce positive changes in critical areas of development. CID funds will be used towards operating costs such as veterinary care and supplies.
- 3. The Riverside County Board of Supervisors will present the 2015 State of Riverside County event on November 19, 2015 at the Morongo Casino Resort. This event will highlight Riverside County's efforts over the past year. CID funds will used towards the cost of the event.

- 4. The Desert Hot Springs Family Resource Center will hold its 4<sup>th</sup> annual holiday event, the Build-A-Bike Project on December 23, 2015. This event is a way to help families during the holiday season as well as to encourage exercise and healthy activities for their children. The Desert Hot Springs Family Resource Center Advisory Board will distribute bicycles to 100 children from low income families in the Desert Hot Springs area. CID funds will be used to purchase bikes, helmets and age appropriate gifts in lieu of bicycles for children selected to participate in this event.
- 5. The Riverside National Cemetery Memorials & Monuments Committee is raising funds to construct an American Indian & Alaska Native Veterans Monument. This memorial will be the first monument of its kind at a national cemetery to specifically honor the military service of American Indian and Alaska Native veterans. CID funds will be used towards the cost of the monument.
