BACKGROUND:

Summary

1. The Boys & Girls Clubs of Coachella Valley gives youth the education, and experience to help them overcome the many obstacles they face on a daily basis. This club offers health and life skills, education, career, character and leadership development and sports recreation. The funds will be equally distributed among the following clubs: Boys & Girls Club of Coachella, Boys & Girls Club of Desert Hot Springs, Boys & Girls Club of Indio, Boys & Girls Club of La Quinta and Boys & Girls Club of Mecca. CID funds will be used toward the costs of operating expenses such as utilities, program activities and transportation.
