Upon completion of the bid process, authorize the Assistant County Executive Officer/EDA to submit the contracts for award of the bid, to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for each bid package to the Chairman of the Board, and authorize the Chairman to execute the agreement on behalf of the Board; provided that, if any of the following occur, the award will be submitted to the Board for action: there is a bid protest, the lowest bid exceeds the estimated construction budget, the low bidder is disqualified, two or more bids are the same and are the lowest, or a bidder requests relief from its bid due to an error;
- 6. Authorize the Assistant County Executive Officer/EDA to administer the contracts for the awarded low bidders in accordance with applicable Board policies;
- 7. Ratify Change Order No. 1 to Unlimited Environmental, Inc. in the amount of \$30,135 for unforeseen conditions during abatement and demolition; and find that the work was integral to the project and that competitive bidding would not produce an advantage and is impractical for the work;
- 8. Delegate authority to the Assistant County Executive Officer/EDA, or his designee, to execute any utility contracts for the project within the dollar limits provided by statute and that do not exceed the project budget; and
- 9. Direct the Clerk of the Board to file the Notice of Exemption with the office of the County Clerk within five working days of approval by the Board.

BACKGROUND: Summary

The Local Agency Public Construction Act (Public Contract Code Section 20100 et seq.) and Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (Public Contract Code Section 22000 et seq.) require officials to invite bids for construction projects and award contracts to the lowest responsible bidder. The Local Agency Public Construction Act (Public Contract Code Section 20101 et seq.) allows officials to pre-qualify contractors for public works projects.

On May 12, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved a contract with Tilden-Coil Constructors, Inc. (Tilden-Coil) to provide construction management multi-prime (CMMP) services for the project.

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BACKGROUND:

Summary (Continued)

On June 30, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved and authorized Tilden-Coil and the Economic Development Agency (EDA) to issue a pre-qualification package for the purpose of establishing a list of pre-qualified prime contractors for various trades. Upon review of the submitted pre-qualification responses, it was determined the contractors on the attached list are qualified to bid in their respective trades. The contractor's pre-qualification status will remain current one year from the date of Board approval. EDA will utilize the various pre-qualified contractors for other county projects. This process of pre-qualifying a pool of prime contractors will help ensure the bids received on county projects will be from responsible and responsive contractors with experience in the selected trades.

The bid documents for the construction of the new MH Crisis Service Center are now complete; therefore EDA requests approval to solicit bids for construction of this project.

On June 30, 2015, the Board approved the plans and specifications for the demolition of the existing buildings. On August 17, 2015, seven bids were received and Unlimited Environmental, Inc. was the low bid in the amount of \$154,000. A purchase order was issued along with the notice to proceed on October 3, 2015. During the abatement and demolition, additional hazardous materials were discovered which required abatement. Halting construction and bidding out this scope would have rendered the site in an unsafe condition and not produce an economic advantage to the County. The change order to the purchase order was issued in the amount of \$30,135 bringing the total contract value to \$184,135. The new contract value is still \$19,050 lower than the second low bid by Interior Demolition, Inc.

In order to keep the project moving forward and meet project schedule commitments, staff recommends the Board of Supervisors authorize the Assistant County Executive Officer/EDA to determine award of the project in accordance with Board Policy B-11, and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the agreement on behalf of the Board of Supervisors, provided that the lowest bid falls within the allotted project budget amount for construction.

Pursuant to CEQA, the action was reviewed and determined to be categorically exempt from CEQA under Guidelines 15302, Class 2 - Replacement or Reconstruction Exemption. The proposed project is the demolition and construction of existing structures at the same location with substantially the same purpose and capacity, and where no alteration or no expansion of an existing use will occur.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

Construction of the new Riverside MH Crisis Service Center will benefit the community by providing crucial crisis mental health services. Approval of the list of Pre-Qualified Prime Contractors will position the county to expedite the construction of various county wide projects by hiring responsible and responsive contractors with experience in the selected trades.

The DMH, in collaboration with the Economic Development Agency (EDA), will reconstruct two new facilities funded by IMHW funds and one new facility with State Mental Health Services Act funding, on county owned property located at 9990 County Farm Road, Riverside, California, providing community based crisis stabilization and residential programs. The proposed Project, under the State California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) includes the demolition of three buildings which no longer meet current building codes, and replacement with three new buildings at the same location with substantially the same purpose and capacity. The demolition of the existing buildings consists of approximately 12,500 square feet of existing structures and includes site clearance, improvements pertaining to egress and ingress of the site, and tree removal. While out of the avian nesting season, an MBTA nesting bird survey was not recommended. Additionally, the ornamental trees, as those found at the project site, are not protected by the MSHCP or other local or state regulations, and the site is not within an MSHCP burrowing owl survey area therefore no MSHCP burrowing owl surveys was required. Construction of the proposed buildings is anticipated to begin in early 2016 and be completed by 2017.

Exempt Status: State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15302, Class 2 (b) Replacement or Reconstruction; and Section 15061(b) (3), General Rule or "Common Sense" Exemption, Codified under Title 14, Articles 5 and 19, Sections 15061 and 15300 to 15333).

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The Project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA specifically by CEQA Guidelines as identified below. The Project will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the categorical exemption as detailed under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2. The Project will not cause an impact to an environmental resource of hazardous or critical concern nor would the Project include a reasonable possibility of having a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances. The Project would not result in impacts to scenic highways, hazardous waste sites, historic resources, or other sensitive natural environments, or have a cumulative effect to the environment. No significant environmental impacts are anticipated to occur with the demolition and replacement of three buildings on the proposed site.

- Section 15302 Class 2 (b), Replacement or Reconstruction Exemption: This categorical exemption includes "...replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced..." The Project would demolish three existing single-story buildings and replace them with three new singlestory buildings of substantially the same size, purpose and capacity. The proposed Project would have the same general purpose as the existing buildings to provide mental health services, with similar uses that include administrative support, an outpatient clinic, and residential treatment. While the exact square footages of the proposed buildings are still under design, the proposed Project is located on a 7.87-acre parcel that currently has a combined building area (structures) footprint of approximately 11 percent of the total parcel. The new proposed building area footprint would be approximately 13.5 percent. The proposed project would slightly increase the building area of the parcel area by approximately 2.5 percent. The increase in the footprint of the buildings would be to improve the design, access, and efficiency of operation of the site. The prior use of the facility included a programmed capacity for 28 patients/residents, and approximately 30-35 staff for treatment and administrative support. The new proposed use would continue to have a similar programmed capacity for 28 patients with a staff of the same size (30-35). The new structures will be constructed at the same location and will not substantially increase the capacity or intensity of use of the site; therefore, the Project meets the scope and intent of the Class 2 Exemption identified in Section 15302, Article 19, Categorical Exemptions of the CEQA Guidelines.
- Section 15061 (b)(3) "Common Sense" Exemption: In accordance with CEQA, the use of the Common Sense Exemption is based on the "general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment." State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15061(b) (3). The use of this exemption is appropriate if "it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment." Ibid. This determination is an issue of fact and if sufficient evidence exists in the record that the activity cannot have a significant effect on the environment, then the exemption applies and no further evaluation under CEQA is required. See No Oil, Inc. v. City of Los Angeles (1974) 13 Cal. 3d 68. The ruling in this case stated that if a project falls within a category exempt by administrative regulation or 'it can be seen with certainty that the activity in question will not have a significant effect on the environment', no further agency evaluation is required. With certainty, there is no possibility that the Project may have a significant effect on the environment as the proposed project would replace existing facilities that are out of compliance with building codes with three new buildings similarly sized with the same purpose and intensity of use. The reconstruction of three buildings will not require any changes to the existing land use and would not lead to any direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical environmental impacts. Construction of the site will be temporary and is not anticipated to result in any significant impacts related to biological resources, noise, or air quality. Therefore, in no way, would the Project as proposed have the potential to cause a significant environmental impact and the Project is exempt from further CEQA analysis.
