

**BACKGROUND:** Community Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. VOICES/Joey's Pals—annual funding will provide assistance for programs and opportunities for children and families in the fifth district.
2. Perris Valley Youth Association Sports—annual funding will assist towards their youth football program which will assist with their safety equipment.
3. P.W. Enhancement Team—annual funding will assist with their programs and services provided to serve low income individuals, families and veterans, such as homeless prevention, food and employment assistance.
4. Side by Side Humanitarian—annual support will be used to support their quarterly food distribution which serves the Pass area communities.
5. Santa Rosa Plateau Nature Education Foundation—annual funding will be used to support the “No Child Left Inside” Environmental Education program provided to students grades 3-12.
