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4 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

5 EXTENDING THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

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7 **WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 8630, Article 14, of the California Emergency
8 Services Act requires that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside review, at least
9 every thirty (30) days until such Local Emergency is terminated, the need for continuing the
10 Local Emergency; and

11 **WHEREAS**, a period of Local Emergency presently exists in the County of Riverside in
12 accordance with the proclamation thereof by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
13 Riverside, by Resolution No. 2015-195, on August 18, 2015, as a result of conditions of
14 extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within said county, caused by a severe
15 microburst which took place in the unincorporated area of Thermal, within the County of
16 Riverside, creating winds in excess of 70 mph, producing rainfall, hail, lightning strikes, and
17 damage to personal property and critical infrastructure; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside has reviewed the
19 need to continue the existence of the Local Emergency; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the situation resulting from said condition of extreme peril is still deemed
21 to be beyond the control of normal protective service, personnel, equipment, and facilities of
22 and within said County of Riverside; now, therefore,

23 **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside does
24 hereby proclaim the extension of the period of Local Emergency for thirty (30) additional days
25 unless sooner terminated.

26 **IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that said Local Emergency shall be deemed to continue
27 to exist until its termination is proclaimed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
28 Riverside.

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
