**Summary (continued)**

1. Law Enforcement Appreciation Committee - \$1,000 the funding will be used to recognize Riverside County public safety officers for valor, and exemplary service to the community.
2. Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee- \$2,500 will be allocated to support Riverside National Cemetery to celebrate and recognize freedom and liberties that veterans who have served their country with the 15<sup>th</sup> annual Concert for Heroes.
3. Senior Citizens Service Center of Rancho Area, Inc. - \$1,000 the funding will be utilized for food purchase to supplement USDA food commodities program to feed low income individuals.
4. Temecula Valley American Association of University Women - \$2,500 the will be used to encourage a diverse groups of young women to increase their participation in STEM careers by attending college and studying the science's.
5. Chaparral High School Education Foundation – CHS Band and Guard - \$1,000- the funding will go towards the purchase of musical instruments, and uniform repairs and or replacements.
6. Animal Friends of the Valleys - \$500 – the allocation of funds will sponsor the annual fundraiser for support of the programs that benefit homeless and companion animals.
