

BACKGROUND: Summary (continued)

- 1. Riverside National Cemetery Memorials & Monuments \$2,500 the funding will go towards the construction of American Indian & Alaska Native Veterans Memorial at the Riverside National Cemetery.
- 2. Santa Rosa Plateau Nature Education Foundation \$1,500 the funds will support The No Child Left inside environmental education program for grades 3-12 to educate and empower youth to appreciate, preserve and protect nature.
- 3. The Colony at California Oaks Emergency Preparedness Program \$2,500 the allocation of funds will assist in purchasing an emergency supply storage unit to store supplies for senior citizens.
- 4. Murrieta Chamber of Commerce \$2,500 funds will support the growth of the chamber and engaging more of the communities and businesses in the overall economic development of Southwest Riverside County.
- 5. March of Dimes \$2,500 the funding will support programing for community service, advocacy efforts and research to prevent premature child birth.
