The Economic Development Agency received a request to provide a power source to RCIT's PSEC site at Toro Peak. The work included relocating an existing shelter and fuel tanks to a new location and retrofitting the shelter with new generators.

On October 4, 2011, the Board of Supervisors approved the construction agreement for Job Order Contract No. 004 between the County of Riverside and Angeles. Pursuant to the contract, various job orders were issued for the RCIT PSEC Toro Peak Generator project in the combined amount of \$455,531.

The project has been inspected and found to comply with the contract requirements. This Board action will release the contract retention funds of \$45,554 to Angeles after the Notice of Completion has been filed and the 35 day lien period has expired. The contract retention funds are within the overall PSEC project budget.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

Providing power to the Toro Peak communications site ensures a critical part of the PSEC network of sites is functional and operational in case of a disaster.
