#### **BACKGROUND:**

## **Summary**

The goal for the Riverside County Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) CalWORKs Housing Support Program (HSP) is to help homeless families receiving CalWORKs benefits to secure permanent housing, thus removing a significant barrier to participation in the Welfare-to-Work (WTW) program and facilitating progress toward employment and self-sufficiency.

DPSS will leverage existing resources and systems to partner with the Housing Authority (HA) of the County of Riverside to continue to maintain the CalWORKs Housing Support Program (HSP) that was implemented last year. This program will provide immediate housing and supportive services for 280 CalWORKs families that are homeless and receiving services through the DPSS Family Stabilization Services (FSS) program. The additional funding of \$800,000 to the Housing Authority will provide permanent housing placement and short-term rent subsidies for additional homeless CalWORKs families, beyond the 150-200 families originally estimated to be served.

#### Impact on Residents and Businesses

This project will provide much needed assistance to individuals or families in the CalWORKs / Rapid Re-Housing program in Riverside County and provide support to CalWORKs families that are homeless and need immediate permanent housing before they are able to progress towards employment and self-sufficiency. Housing stability is one of the greatest challenges that the CalWORKs families face. In Riverside County, 3,790 CalWORKs families (almost 8% of the total CalWORKs population) have been identified as homeless.

#### **SUPPLEMENTAL:**

## **Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

On Monday, June 15, 2015, the California State Senate and Assembly passed a 2015-16 budget that included \$35 million General funds allocated for the Housing Support Program. DPSS previously received \$1,000,000 for the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 for the CalWORKs / Rapid Re-Housing program. An amount of \$700,000 was allocated for the Housing Authority and \$300,000 for DPSS Operational Costs. The \$300,000 previously allocated for DPSS' Operational Costs will be moved to the Housing Authority to service additional families. On October 1, 2015, DPSS received additional funding in the amount of \$500,000. The funding breakdown is as follows:

Operational Costs -- HA: \$ 1,500,000

Total: \$ 1,500,000

DPSS negotiated the agreement with Housing Authority of the County of Riverside without competition in accordance with California Department of Social Services (CDSS) manual section 23-650, paragraph 1.14, which states that contracts may be negotiated without formal advertising "for any service to be rendered by any federal, state or local governmental agency, public university, public college or other public educational institution."
