BACKGROUND:

Summary

Briggs Road crosses Warm Springs Creek at approximately 1.2 miles south of the Scott Road intersection over a low water crossing supported on a timber culvert. The current width of the culvert is approximately 18 feet; therefore, the two lane road is narrowed down to one lane for bidirectional traffic at the culvert crossing. Currently, there are signs and traffic striping directing northbound motorists to yield to the oncoming traffic.

By Minute Order dated October 6, 2015 (Agenda Item 3-48), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the Construction of Briggs Road Low Water Crossing Improvements at Warm Springs Creek in the French Valley Area, and to take action approving the CEQA Notice of Exemption. Subsequently, the relocation of a Verizon telecommunications line was determined to be necessary and is the reason for the revised CEQA Notice of Exemption. The Briggs Road Low Water Crossing Improvement is exempt from the CEQA pursuant to Section 15301 (c) (existing facilities) and the relocation of the Verizon Telecommunication is exempt under Section 15301 (b) (existing utilities) of the CEQA.

Briggs Road is a one lane road in each direction immediately north and south of the low water crossing. At the low water crossing, the road is wide enough for only one lane for both directions. The widening of the culvert to one lane in each direction does not involve an expansion of an existing use; therefore, the project qualifies for a CEQA exemption under Section 15301 (c).

Traffic on Briggs Road has increased due to new development and the opening of the Dorothy McElhinney Middle School and Lisa J. Mails Elementary School. This project will widen the existing low water crossing on Briggs Road at Warm Springs Creek by 13 feet in order to allow accommodate continuous traffic flow for both the northbound and southbound traffic, thus enhancing safety.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and No. 2.

The proposed budget as shown on attachment "A" includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

The Transportation Department recommends award of the following schedules of work in the Contract amount of \$353,820:

Base Bid Schedule:	Briggs Road Low Water Crossing Improvements
Alternate Bid Schedule 1:	90 Days Plant Establishment Work

The Contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents, which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Briggs Road will be closed to traffic during construction between Scott Road and Baxter Road.

Public outreach informing the area residents and schools will occur prior to and throughout construction. A traffic management plan will be in place to address access during construction for residents and emergency vehicles.

The construction duration set for this project is 52 working days, approximately two and a half months, and construction is anticipated to be completed in the spring of 2016.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to Riverside Construction Company, Inc. for the total amount of \$353,820. The project will be funded with Gas Tax/ HUTA funds. There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

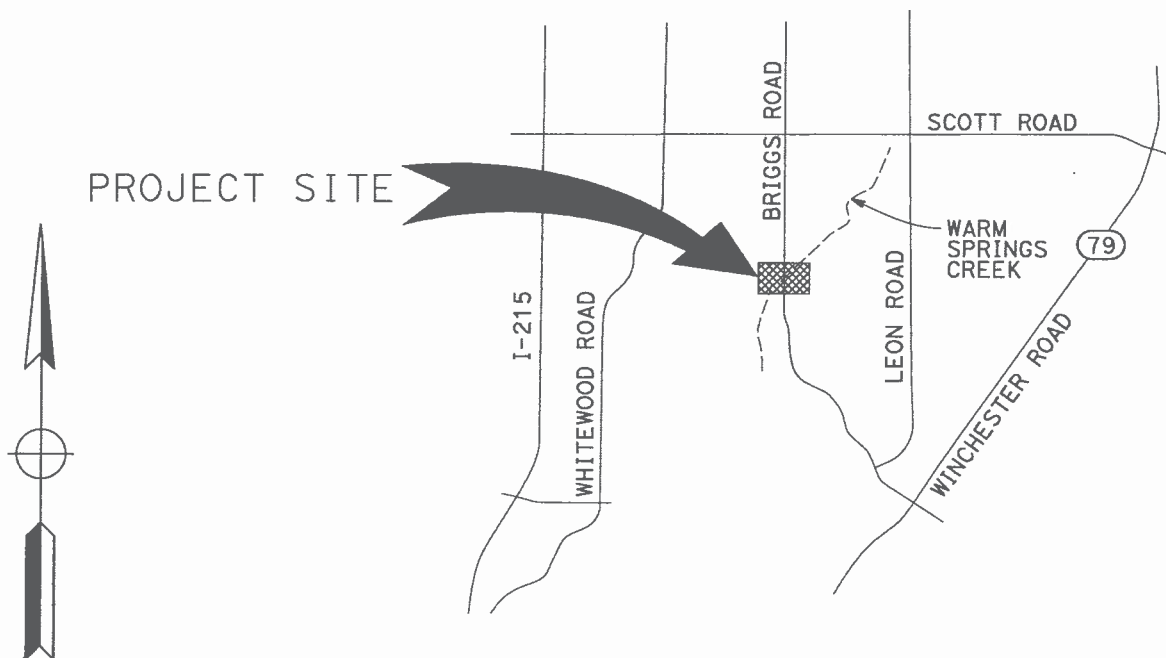
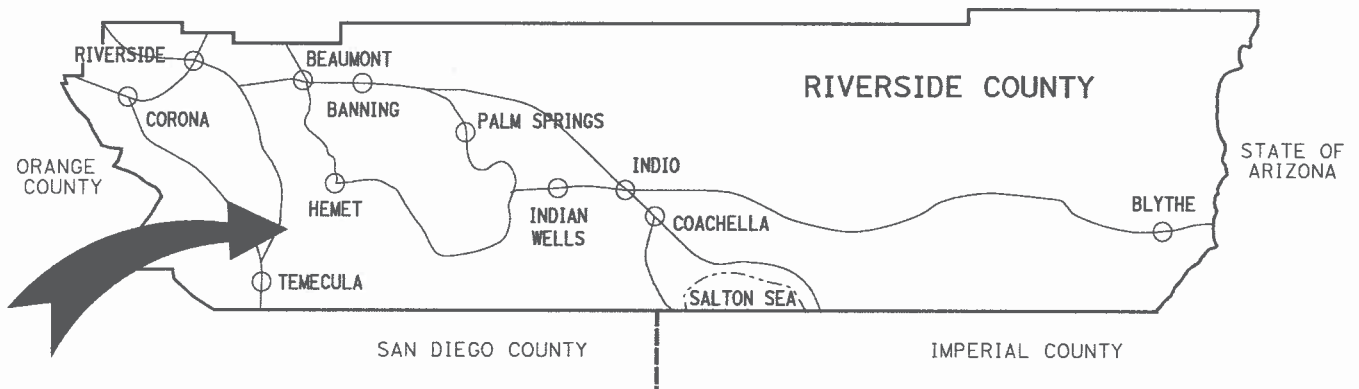
Four bids were received on November 10, 2015, ranging from \$353,820 to \$518,750 (including Base Bid Schedule and Alternate Bid Schedule 1). The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Riverside Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of \$353,820 which is \$60,893 (21%) higher than the Engineer's Estimate. Bid prices received, higher than the Engineer's Estimate costs, are due mainly to higher than anticipated prices for supplying and driving piles and structural concrete items of work.

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: Third

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (COUNTY) proposes roadway improvements to Briggs Road over Warm Springs Creek. Briggs Road is a two-lane rural road, with a 60-foot wide right-of-way and one lane in each direction, located in Riverside County east of the City of Menifee. Briggs Road is classified as a Major Highway in the Riverside County General Plan.

Briggs Road crosses Warm Springs Creek with a timber culvert approximately 1.2 miles south of the intersection of Scott Road. The timber culvert serves as a low-flow culvert over the Warm Springs Creek to convey an approximately 4-year flood. Warm Springs Creek intersects Briggs Road at a skew of approximately 20 degrees. At approximately 18 feet wide, the two-lane road is narrowed to a one-lane road for bidirectional traffic through the culvert. There is signage and striping warning northbound motorists to yield to oncoming traffic. West of Briggs Road, Warm Springs Creek flows south close to Briggs Road.

Improvements to Briggs Road at Warm Springs Creek are necessary in order to provide for one lane in each direction. Briggs Road is one lane in each direction north and south of Warm Springs Creek.

A Verizon Telecommunications Line will be relocated within the project limits.

Briggs Road will be closed between Scott Road and Baxter Road during construction. A traffic management plan will be implemented to address access during construction.

The improvements along the east side of Briggs Road will provide an edge-to-edge pavement width of 32 feet to accommodate a 12-foot wide travel lane and a 4-foot wide shoulder in each direction. Along the widened portion of Briggs Road, there will be a 3-foot wide unpaved shoulder and the remaining area between the east right-of-way and the edge of the shoulder will be graded to join the existing original ground elevations. Briggs Road, within the limits of work, will be striped with a double yellow solid stripe and white edge stripes.

The embankment of Warm Springs Creek will receive minor grading within Briggs Road right-of-way in order to construct the extension of the culvert abutments. No excavation of the channel bottom is anticipated inside or outside of the roadway right-of-way.

The structural widening improvements will consist of relocating the east metal railing of the existing structure, constructing an extension of abutments matching the alignment and the span length of the existing culvert and installing a timber deck matching the existing roadway finished surface elevation.

In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County Multi-Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP), necessary operation and maintenance activities of public facilities are considered a Covered Activity.

Compliance with the MSHCP is documented through the preparation of the focused surveys and consistency analysis (LSA 2015).

A Cultural Resources Assessment (LSA 2015) did not identify any cultural resources within the project area.

Riverside County Transportation Department Staff conducted a review of the above referenced project and has determined that the proposal qualifies for a Categorical Exemption per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines, Section 15301 (b) – Existing utilities such as the Verizon telecommunication line relocation are exempt from CEQA.

California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines, Section 15301 (c) – Minor alteration of existing public facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of lead agency's determination. Briggs Road is an existing highway with a one lane low water crossing. The COUNTY determined that the minor alteration to the crossing is necessary for consistency with the existing two-lane roadway. The project involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use because Briggs Road is a one lane road in each direction immediately north and south of the existing timber culvert. At the timber culvert, the road is wide enough for only one lane for both directions. The widening of the culvert to one lane in each direction does not involve expansion of an existing use; therefore, the project qualifies as an exemption under Section 15301(c) of CEQA.

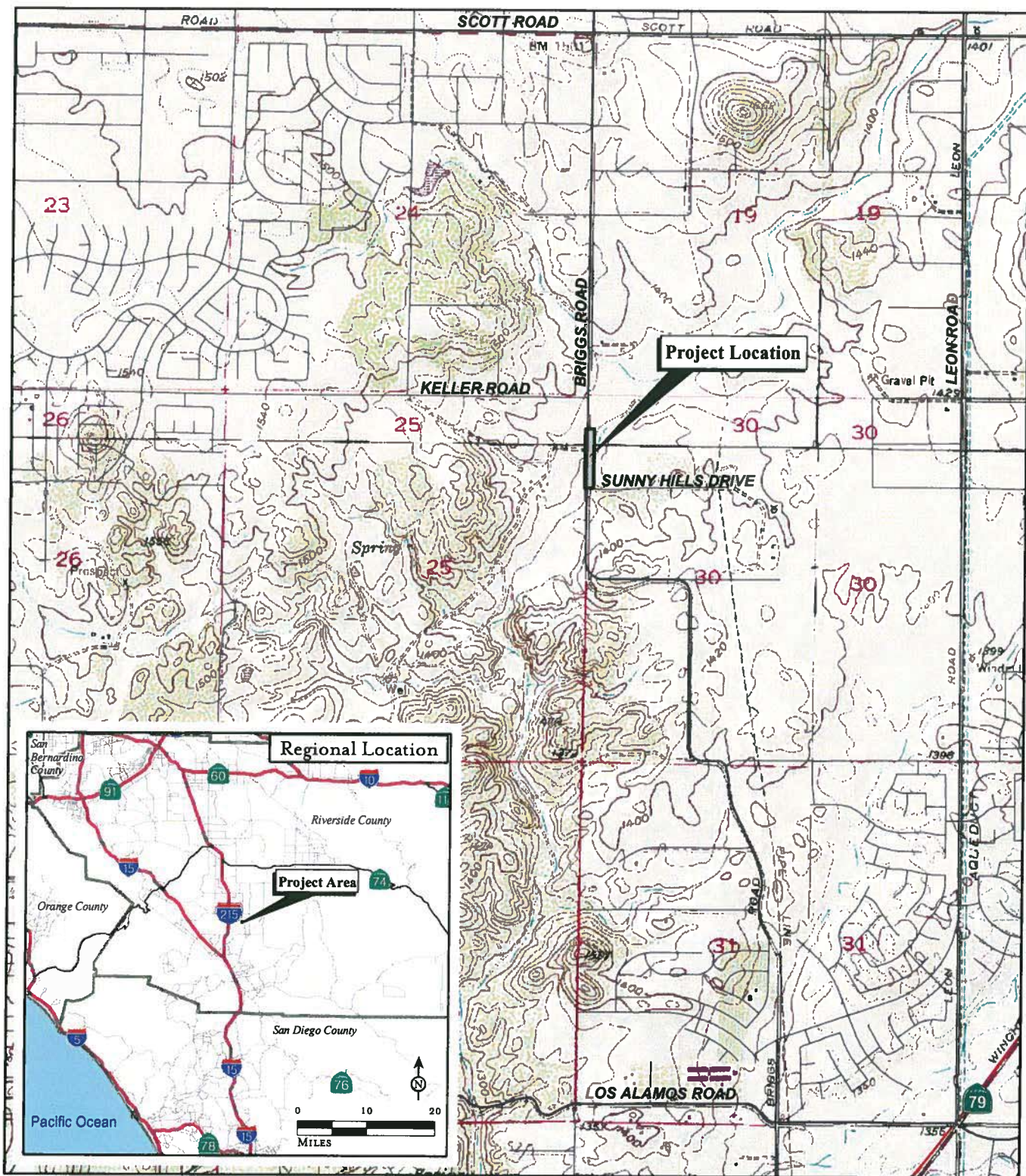
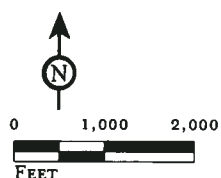

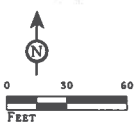

You must cooperate with utility companies which have a need to adjust or relocate facilities within the project limits.

No on-site work by the County's Contractor will be allowed in the utility relocation areas unless specifically agreed to by both the utility company and the County's Engineer. The Utility company days are anticipated to not be sequential, and will be assigned by the Resident Engineer in coordination with the scheduling needs of the affected utility companies.

If necessary, removal and disposal of abandoned utility conduits, conductors and other facilities shall be considered as incidental excavation, and shall be included in the various items of work.

The Utility owner shall provide traffic control as required to support the above described work. If necessary, the contractor shall coordinate his traffic control with the utility owner's traffic control to ensure safe passage for the traveling public.

Full compensation for the provisions of this Special Provision shall be considered as included in the various items of work, and no additional compensation will be allowed therefore.

Item 4: Addition to Special Provisions – Type ESA Temporary Fence. The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereof:

Add to section 14-1.03A(1):

Segments of Type ESA Temporary Fence must be installed and maintained along the easterly and westerly right of way lines on Briggs Road and areas adjacent to Warm Springs Creek in accordance with Section 14-1.03 of the Standard Specifications, these Special Provisions and Standard Plan No. T65. The exact location of the fence will be determined by the Resident Engineer and the County Biologist in the field during construction.

Construction employees will strictly limit their activities, vehicles, equipment, and construction materials to the proposed project footprint and designated staging areas and routes of travel. The construction areas(s) shall be the minimal area necessary to complete the project.

Add to section 14-1.03D:

The contract price paid per linear foot for temporary fence (Type ESA) includes full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in constructing and maintaining the temporary fence (Type ESA) as directed by the Engineer and County Biologist, complete in place, including maintenance, removal of materials, and backfilling and repairing holes, depressions and other ground disturbance, as shown on the plans, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these special provisions, and as ordered by the Engineer.

Item 5: Addition to Special Provisions – Cultural Resources. The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereof:

Add to section 14-2.01:

CULTURAL RESOURCES

The County will have available a qualified archaeologist as specified in these Special Provisions for a training session and on-site monitoring. "Archaeological Monitor" referenced in these specifications refers to the archaeologist provided by the County. Archaeological monitoring and Native American monitoring shall be requested by the Contractor from the Engineer at least 10 days prior to the initial performance of work activities, including any ground disturbance activities.

The California Public Resources Code Chapter 1.7, Section 5097.5 makes it a misdemeanor for anyone to knowingly disturb an archaeological or historical feature. California Public Resources Code Sections 5097.98 and 5097.99 require protection of Native American remains which may be found and outlines procedures for handling any burials found.

If human remains are found at the project site during excavation of the project, work shall be suspended in the immediate area of the find and the Engineer will notify the Riverside County Coroner's Office. Standard guidelines set by California law for the treatment of human remains shall be followed (Public Resources Code § 5097.98 et seq., Health and Safety Code § 7050.5, and others).

If previously unidentified archaeological materials are found during the course of construction, it is Department policy that all work be halted in the area until the Archeological Monitor can assess the nature and significance of the find. Additional archaeological survey will be needed if the limits of the proposed work extend beyond the current survey limits.

The County reserves the right to use other forces for exploratory work to identify and determine the extent of the area requiring archaeological artifact recovery and for removing archaeological artifacts from such area.

Payment

In the event that any damage occurs to any cultural resource as a result of the Contractor's activities, the Contractor shall bear the full cost of resource damage evaluation and restoration, and such payment shall not relieve Contractor from civil or criminal remedies otherwise provided by law.

If ordered, furnish resources to assist in the investigation or recovery of archeological resources. This work will be performed as Extra Work.

Item 6: Addition to Special Provisions – Biological Monitoring. The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereof:

Add to section 14-6.01A(1):

BIOLOGICAL MONITORING

The County will have available a qualified biologist as specified in these Special Provisions for training session, a pre-construction survey of the project site, installation of the ESA fencing, on-site monitoring and all Endangered species handling that may be required. "Biologist" or "Monitor" referenced in these specifications refers to the biologist provided by the County. The County's biologist will perform pre-construction surveys for burrowing owl, bats and migratory birds. The Contractor shall request this service from the Engineer at least 10 days prior to the initial performance of work activities.

The project's Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP) requires that prior to earthwork operations, the RCTD Biological Monitor conduct a training session for all project personnel. Training will include a description of the species of concern and its habitats, the general provisions of the Endangered Species Act (Act) and the MSHCP, the need to adhere to the provisions of the Act and the MSHCP, the penalties associated with violating the provisions of the Act, the general measures that are being implemented to conserve the species of concern as they relate to the project, and the access routes to the project site boundaries within which the project activities must be accomplished.

Prior to construction the County's Biological Monitor will confirm that the limits of the project disturbance are clearly defined and marked in the field with ESA fencing prior to initiation of construction.

The County's Biological Monitor will monitor construction activities for the duration of project to ensure the practicable measures are being employed to avoid incidental disturbance of habitat and species of concern outside of project footprint.

If a regulated species is discovered during construction, construction activities will halt within a 100 foot radius, unless a different radius is defined in the Streambed Alteration Agreement issued by the California Department of Fish & Wildlife.

Item 7: Addition to Special Provisions – Erosion Control (Bonded Fiber Matrix (BFM) With Seeds . The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereof:

21 EROSION CONTROL

Replace section 21-1.02K with the following:

21-1.02K EROSION CONTROL (BONDED FIBER MATRIX (BFM) WITH SEEDS):

21-1.02K(1) General

This work includes applying erosion control materials to roadway slopes and flat areas impacted/disturbed by construction activities on Briggs Road slopes and flat areas (e.g. graded but unpaved other than shoulders) and disturbed areas of Warm Springs Creek as directed by the Engineer in the field during construction.

Erosion Control (Bonded Fiber Matrix (BFM) with Seeds) shall be used on Briggs Road slopes and flat areas (e.g. graded but unpaved other than shoulders) and disturbed areas of Warm Springs Creek. Specific direction shall be given by the Engineer.

Erosion control (BFM) must comply with Section 21, "Erosion Control," of the Standard Specifications.

Before applying erosion control materials, prepare soil surface under Section 19-2.03G, "Slopes," of the Standard Specifications except that rills and gullies exceeding 2 inches in depth or width must be leveled. Remove invasive vegetative growth (weeds), temporary erosion control materials, and other debris from areas to receive erosion control.

Before applying erosion control materials, the Engineer designates the location of erosion control in increments of 1 acre or less for smaller areas. Place stakes or other suitable markers at the locations designated by the Engineer. Furnish tools, labor and materials required to designate the various locations.

Before applying erosion control materials, provide the County no less than three (3) results from no less than three (3) random soils tests from the area to receive erosion control materials. The results shall be come from a reputable, resourceful, and professional soils and plant laboratory. Scientific test results shall include soil Ph, total dissolved salts, sodium absorption ratio, organic matter, soil texture, infiltration rate, nutrients N-P-K, all minor elements, and trace elements.

Before applying erosion control materials, provide the County with a submittal outlining type of seed with species and common name, pure live seeds per acre, bonded fiber matrix product and application rate, premium compost product and application rate, organic fertilizer product and application rate, mycorrhizal fungi soil amendment product and application rate. Provide information on selected vendor and products as requested.

21-1.02K(2) MATERIALS

Materials must comply with Section 21-1.02, "Materials," of the Standard Specifications and these special provisions.

Measure and mix individual seed species in the presence of the Engineer.

Seed must not contain more than 1.0 percent total weed seed by weight.

21-1.02K(4) Seed Sampling Supplies

At the time of seed sampling, furnish individual glassine lined bag and custody seal tag for sealing each seed sample.

21-1.02K(5) Bonded Fiber Matrix (BFM) Product

Fiber must comply with Section 21-1.02E, "Fiber," of the Standard Specifications and these special provisions. Fiber must be long strand, whole-wood fibers, thermo mechanically processed from clean, whole-wood chips, containing a minimum of 25 percent at 3/8 inch long, with a minimum of 50 percent retained on a No. 25 sieve. The wood chips must not contain lead paint, printing ink, varnish, petroleum products, seed germination inhibitors, or chlorine bleach. Fiber must not be produced from sawdust, cardboard, paper, or paper by-products.

The Bonded Fiber Matrix (BFM) shall be a hydraulically applied flexible erosion control blanket composed of long strand, thermally processed wood fibers and a proprietary crosslinked, hydro-colloid tackifier. The BFM may require a 24-48 hour curing period to achieve maximum performance. Once cured, the BFM forms an intimate bond with the soil surface to create a continuous, absorbent, flexible and biodegradable erosion resistant blanket that allows for rapid germination and accelerated plant growth. (**Product described is Profile Hydro-Blanket or County-approved equal.)

Tackifier must be bonded to the fiber or prepackaged with the fiber by the manufacturer. Tackifier must comply with the specifications for stabilizing emulsion under Section 21-2.02F of the Standard Specifications, and be nonflammable, non-toxic to plants and animals and must have no germination or growth inhibiting factors.

The tackifier must be a combination of a cross-linked polymer and an organic, high viscosity colloidal polysaccharide with activating agents or a blended hydrocolloid-based binder. Application rate shall be 1 lb./acre. (**Product described is Tri-C Humate or County-approved equal.)

21-1.03J(1) APPLICATION AND INSTALLATION

Application and Installation must comply with Section 21-1.03E, "Hyrdomulch and HydroSeed" of the Standard Specifications and these special provisions.

Add a coloring agent to the emulsion to contrast with the area on which it is applied. The coloring agent must not include copper, mercury, or arsenic and must be biodegradable and nontoxic.

The ratio of fiber to water must be as required to facilitate even application of the material and per approved product manufacturer's installation instructions. The proportions of various erosion control materials may be changed by the Engineer to meet field conditions. Once work is started in an area, complete stabilizing emulsion applications in that area on the same working day.

Use hydroseeding equipment to apply erosion control to all disturbed soil surfaces. Apply erosion control from 2 or more directions to avoid shadowing effects forming a continuous mat without gaps between the mat and the soil surface. Apply erosion control in layers to avoid slumping and to aid drying. Unless manufacturer guidelines allow for application during wet weather, apply materials during dry weather with a minimum of 24-36-48 hours of dry weather between completion of material application and predicted precipitation.

Step 1 – In tank, mix seed, compost, fertilizer, mycorrhizal fungi, and humate in tank with a small amount of BFM (5-15% for visual metering). Apply to areas designated to receive BFM. Begin application within 60 minutes of adding seed to the mixture.

During the 90 days maintenance, if directed by the Engineer, the Contractor shall maintain the area free of non-desired weeds and at no additional cost to the County.

A written notice requesting start of 90 days of Maintenance or a final inspection shall be received by the Engineer 5 days in advance.

Reapply erosion control products in the same fashion as noted above in the section "Application and Installation".

Reapply erosion control when the area treated exhibits visible erosion. Reapply erosion control within 24-48 hours of identifying visible erosion, unless otherwise approved by the Engineer.

Repair erosion control damaged during the progress of work resulting from your vehicles, equipment, or operation. Repairs shall be made as soon as possible or by the direction of the Engineer.

Reapply erosion control to areas noted by the Engineer as directed or as needed or required prior to demobilization.

Monitoring for pollutants not visually detectable in storm water is required by the General Construction NPDES Permit including soil amendments and soil stabilization products.

The Contractor is responsible for the development and implementation of the watering method required for the establishment of the treated area including but not limited to the furnishing of all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for coordinating all the required work.

The plant watering method watering method shall be submitted to the Engineer for approval prior to implementation.

Contractor is responsible to maintain their water method at all times.

Payment for any modifications done to the watering method by the Contractor during the plant Maintenance period shall be considered as included in the contract payment for Plant Establishment Work and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Add to section 21-1.04:

The unit price paid per acre for Erosion Control (Bonded Fiber Matrix with Seeds), shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in applying erosion control (BFM with Seeds, amendments), complete in place, including soil tests, and as shown on the plans, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

The unit price paid per lump sum for Plant Establishment Work, shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in maintaining erosion control (BFM with Seeds, amendments) for 90 days, complete in place, including necessary watering for the establishment of the seed mix, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 8: Environmental Permits.

- The "California Department of Fish and Wildlife Streambed Alteration Agreement", and
- The "California Regional Water Quality Control Board Water Quality Certification" will not be available for inspection on the County of Riverside Transportation Department website during the advertisement period.

Although not available for inspection, the County believes that much of the permits conditions have been already included in the different Contract Documents available.

Final copies of the "California Department of Fish and Wildlife Streambed Alteration Agreement", and the "California Regional Water Quality Control Board Water Quality Certification," will become available to the awarded contractor.

No major deviations are expected between the currently information available in the Contract Documents and the final "California Department of Fish and Wildlife Streambed Alteration Agreement", and the "California Regional Water Quality Control Board Water Quality Certification".

In the event that new restrictions are required by the final "California Department of Fish and Wildlife Streambed Alteration Agreement", or by the "California Regional Water Quality Control Board Water Quality Certification", any additional work performed by the Contractor as a result of such restrictions and or new requirements shall be handled per General Conditions, Section 24, Extra Work.

When the final "California Department of Fish and Wildlife Streambed Alteration Agreement", and "California Regional Water Quality Control Board Water Quality Certification" become available, these shall become part of the Contract Documents.

Commencement of work on the Warm Springs Creek area will not start until the final "California Department of Fish and Wildlife Streambed Alteration Agreement", and the "California Regional Water Quality Control Board Water Quality Certification," are received by the County. Permits are anticipated to be received near the project award schedule.
