**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center - \$2,500** funding will be used to support their efforts to provide direct services to victims of sexual assault and their families free of charge, prevention presentations across the full spectrum of the population, and will also assist Law Enforcement and the District Attorney's office by accompanying the Victim through judicial proceedings.
2. **Assistance League of Temecula Valley - \$2,500** funding will be used to support the Operation School Bell program. The program plans on clothing approximately 550 disadvantaged schoolchildren in the First District
3. **City of Riverside - \$5,000** funding will be used to support GrowRIVERSIDE. GrowRIVERSIDE is a program with the goal to foster the growth of a sustainable local food and agriculture system that benefits the community, environment and economy of Riverside.
