Summary

1. The Boys and Girls Club of Cathedral City provides the Triple Play Healthy Habits program. This program provides a multi-faceted approach to health and wellness for children ages 6 to 18. CID funds will be used to support the Triple Play Healthy Habits program.
2. The Health Assessment and Research for Communities (HARC) mission is to provide objective reliable research, analysis and technical service of health needs to the Coachella Valley. HARC will be collecting data for the 2016 Coachella Valley Community Health Monitor. HARC will analyze the data and present it to the community in reports and online databases. CID funds will be used toward the cost of this health survey.

The Unforgettables Foundation enables low-income families the ability to give their children a burial, educate parents, caregivers and communities on children's health and wholeness. CID funds will be used toward the cost of the burial project.
