RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Finds that the vacation in real property is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") as it has been determined that the project qualifies for a "Class 25 Categorical Exemption" pursuant to the State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15325(a), "Acquisition, sale, or other transfer of areas to preserve the existing natural conditions, including plant or animal habitats" and Section 15061(b)(3), "Common Sense Exemption"; and
- 2. Adopt Resolution No. F2016-06, Authorization to Summarily Vacate a District Right of Way along Rice Canyon Levee, in the Lake Elsinore Area, RCFC Parcel No. 3050-1; and
- 3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk within five (5) working days of approval by the Board.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

In 1957 the District was granted an easement by Mr. and Mrs. Shupp, now known as RCFC Parcel No. 3050-1, recorded as Instrument No. 67251 on September 18, 1957, in the Official Records of Riverside County, California, for the construction and maintenance of a channel, levees and appurtenant works for control and flow of flood, storm and other waters, which encompasses over 80 acres in the unincorporated area of Lake Elsinore referred to as Rice Canyon. This dedication was prior to any design or construction in the Rice Canyon watershed.

In 1999 a portion of this easement was quitclaimed to the existing land owners, Lake Elsinore Unified School District, pursuant to Board Agenda Item 9.4 on November 2, 1999, after it was determined that flood protection was provided by the proposed development, and the easement was no longer necessary in this area. This was recorded as Instrument No. 1999-521858 on November 30, 1999.

In 2010, an additional portion of this easement was vacated for the benefit of the existing land owners, K. Hovnanian Homes, pursuant to Board Agenda Item 11.2 on December 7, 2010, as necessary flood improvements were conditioned by the City of Lake Elsinore, constructed and the remaining property was to be converted into a conservation easement. The District reviewed the developer's improvements and determined that there would be no maintenance responsibilities for the District or additional impact on the natural conditions within this area in the present or future. Therefore the District had determined that it could summarily vacate its easement interests over this area. The vacation was recorded as Instrument No. 2010-0602857 on December 15, 2010.

The District has now evaluated the remaining acreage and determined that there is no future use of the property rights as dedicated in the original 1957 Grant of Easement within the City of Lake Elsinore's general plan. The property shall stay in its natural condition with no additional improvements. The underlying land owner has requested that the District vacate its remaining interests as the landowner intends to convey a conservation easement over the property which would assure that these conditions cannot be altered.

The project is exempt from CEQA because it qualifies as a "Class 25 Categorical Exemption" pursuant the State CEQA Guidelines Section 15325(a), "Acquisition, sale, or other transfer of areas to preserve the existing natural conditions, including plant or animal habitats". The project is also consistent with Section 15061(b)(3), "Common Sense Exemption" because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposed project may have a significant effect on the environment, as it is merely vacating an unnecessary flood control easement on undisturbed property to the existing property owner for which the property will convey a conservation easement for land conservation purposes.

Therefore, the District recommends that the easement right of way referred to as RCFC Parcel No. 3050-1, as dedicated in Instrument No. 67251 on September 18, 1957, be summarily vacated.

AUTHORIZATION TO SUMMARILY VACATE A DISTRICT RIGHT OF WAY ALONG RICE CANYON LEVEE, IN THE LAKE ELSINORE AREA, RCFC PARCEL 3050-1 LOCATED IN THE CITY OF LAKE ELSINORE, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE RICE CANYON LEVEE, PROJECT 3-0-00050

WHEREAS, the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) is the owner of certain real property easement interest known as RCFC Parcel No. 3050-1, over Assessor Parcel Numbers listed on Attachment "1", attached hereto and made a part hereof, which encompasses approximately 80 acres of land, (the "ROW") is legally described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, on March 29, 2016, the District's Board of Supervisors (Board) adopted Resolution No. F2016-05 declaring the ROW as Surplus, that it is no longer needed, nor will be needed in the future, for the District's use and purposes, and provided notice of its intention to summarily vacate the ROW; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Water Code Appendix Section 48-9, Subsection 5 Chapter 48-13, the District may dispose of real property after adoption of a resolution declaring that a real property interest is no longer necessary to be retained for District use or purposes as was previously adopted and noted in Resolution No. F2016-05; and

WHEREAS, the District has reviewed and determined the vacation of the ROW as categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15325(a), "Acquisition, sale, or other transfer of areas to preserve the existing natural conditions, including plant or animal habitats", as the District is merely vacating an unnecessary flood control easement on undisturbed property to the existing property owner for land conservation purposes. Furthermore, the project is also consistent with State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), "Common Sense Exemption" because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposed project may have a significant effect on the environments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by vote of the Board of Supervisors of the District, in regular session assembled on April 12, 2016, in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors of the District located on the 1st Floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, at 9:00 a.m. or soon thereafter,

that this Board, based on the review of the proposed vacation, the environmental impacts of the project have been sufficiently assessed and have been determined that the proposed action qualifies for a "Class 25 Categorical Exemption" pursuant to Article 19 of the CEQA, State CEQA Guidelines: Section 15325(a) and Section 15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question will have a significant effect on the environment because the District is merely vacating an unnecessary right of way on undisturbed property to the existing property owner for land conservation purposes and the vacation of the easement does not adversely affect a change in the environment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by a vote of this Board that this Board authorizes the summary vacation of the ROW, RCFC Parcel 3050-1, that certain real property located in the City of Lake Elsinore, County of Riverside, State of California, more particularly described in Exhibit "A".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Clerk of Board is directed to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk within five (5) working days of approval by the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Clerk of the Board is directed to cause a certified copy of this resolution to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County of Riverside, California.



Therefore, pursuant to California Water Code Appendix Section 48-9, Subsection 5 and Chapter 48-13, the District may dispose of real property when interest is no longer necessary to be retained for District use or purposes.

Exempt Status: Categorical Exemption Pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines §§15325(a) and 15061(b)(3)

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The project qualifies for the following CEQA exemptions:

Section 15325(a) - "Acquisition, sale, or other transfer of areas to preserve the existing natural conditions, including plant or animal habitats." The District is merely vacating an unnecessary flood control easement on undisturbed property to the existing property owner for land conservation purposes.

Section 15061(b)(3) - The project qualifies for the "General Rule" or "Common Sense Exemption" because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposed project may have a significant effect on the environment.

The project does not affect a change in the environment. The project will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the validity of the categorical exemptions as detailed under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2. The project will not cause any impacts to scenic resources, historic resources, or unique sensitive environments. Furthermore, no unusual circumstances or potential cumulative impacts would reasonably occur that may create an environmental impact.

Based upon the exemptions identified above, the District hereby concludes that no physical environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the project as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.
