#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### **Summary**

In accordance with Section 3691 et seq. of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and with prior approval of the Board of Supervisors, The Tax Collector conducted the February 4, 2014 public auction sale. The deed conveying title to the purchasers at the auction was recorded March 21, 2014. Further, as required by Section 4676 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, notice of the right to claim excess proceeds was given on April 22, 2014 to parties of interest as defined in Section 4675 of said code. Parties of interest have been determined by an examination of lot book reports as well as Assessor's and Recorder's records, and various research methods were used to obtain current mailing addresses for these parties of interest. #### RECOMMENDED MOTION:

- 2. Deny the claims, unless an appeal has been filed in Superior Court, pursuant to the California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 4675.
- 3. Authorize and direct the Treasurer-Tax Collector to transfer the unclaimed excess proceeds in the amount of \$105,041.58 to the county general fund pursuant to Revenue and Taxation Code Section 4674.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### Summary (continued)

Revenue and Taxation Code 4676 (b) states that the county shall make reasonable effort to obtain the name and last known mailing address of the parties of interest. Then, if the address of the party of interest cannot be obtained, the county shall publish notice of the right to claim excess proceeds in a newspaper of general circulation in the county as per Revenue and Taxation Code 4676 (c). The Treasurer-Tax Collector's Office has made it a policy to take the following actions to locate the rightful party of the excess proceeds.

- Examined title reports to notify all parties of interest attached to the parcel.
- Researched all last assessee's through the County's Property Tax System for any parties of interest.
- Used Accurint (people finder) to notify any new addresses that may be listed for our parties of interest.
- Advertised in newspapers for three consecutive weeks in the Desert Sun, Palo Verde Valley Times and the Press Enterprise referring any parties of interest to file a claim for the excess proceeds.
- Sent out a certified mailing within 90 days as required by Revenue and Taxation Code 4675.

According to Revenue and Taxation Code 4675 (a) Any party of interest in the property may file with the county a claim for the excess proceeds, in proportion to his or her interest held with others of equal priority in the property at the time of the sale, at any time prior to the expiration of the one year following the recordation of the Tax Collector's deed to the Purchaser, which was recorded on March 21, 2014.

The Treasurer-Tax Collector has received two claims for excess proceeds:

1. Claims from Pami Lani Kai Quilici based on a Quitclaim Deed recorded July 22, 2002 as Instrument No. 2002-398509 and Quitclaim Deed recorded July 22, 2002 as Instrument No. 2002-398506.

Pursuant to Section 4675 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, it is the recommendation of this office that Pami Lani Kai Quilici be denied since she was not a party of interest at the time of the sale. Since there are no other claimants the unclaimed excess proceeds in the amount of \$105,041.58 will be transferred to the county general fund. Supporting documentation has been provided. The Tax Collector requests approval of the above recommended motion. Notice of this recommendation was sent to the claimant by certified mail.

Dear GP,

You will find enclosed a short legal memorandum giving my analysis of the law as it pertains to the facts of your case, a copy of Matthew Bender's Forms of Procedures and Practice on Adverse Possession, a copy of Witkins Summary of California Law on Adverse Possession, a few pertinent cases, and a copy of Rebecca Pauline's obituary. In the memorandum you will find my legal analysis of the law regarding the viability of your quiet title action along with conclusions and recommendation's. Separately, you will also find a sample of a revocable trust that I will discuss in the fourth paragraph below.

In addition to the above, I have attached hereto a sheet showing the expenses I have incurred thus far in researching the facts and the law and evaluating the entire situation. The purpose is not so that you might reimburse me, but rather to show you just what a few days of legal work can entail in costs alone. This does not even include an hourly rate for attorney's fees or an hourly rate for a law clerk, and it does not include all of the miscellaneous cash outlay that I did not keep track of. I want you to have a full sense of what is involved if this case goes forward immediately in the event that you are able to find supportive case law. In that case, you will be looking at substantial detective fees, publication fees, court fees, service of process fees, possibly deposition costs and court and jury fees. This is no small proposition. In my opinion, however, this case is not ready to go forward in order for you to gain title under adverse possession by claim of right. You will still have to incur substantial expenses in order to either fence the land, bring the water on to the land to grow crops for five years, or to dwell on the land for five years. I realize that you may not be able to afford the burden of such costs at this time, and I realize that you are possibly looking to me to shoulder those costs as well as to handle the case for you. Upon due consideration, I must decline because I cannot take on a project of this magnitude.

Since I do not practice in this particular field of law, I strongly urge you to consult with an attorney who specializes in adverse possession. Additionally, I suggest that you consult with other family members who stand to benefit from your endeavors in the long run to assist you as you move to reach a decision on a plan of action. You will need their support with finances and/or labor, and they should be more than happy to help you.

As to the trust, the language in the trust can be adjusted to meet your

needs. However, this will just give you an idea of how a revocable trust is superior to a will in its flexibility to meet your needs. The settlor is the person who is placing their property into the trust for the benefit of the beneficiaries of the trust. The trustee is the person who administers the trust. This person can be the same as the settlor. The trustee(s) has all the rights and duties regarding the property as are designated in the trust document. This means that if you name yourself as the trustee you can add and take away property to and from the trust at your pleasure (since the trust is "revocable"). This may accommodate you more than a will in two regards. First, a trust does not have to go through probate upon the death of the settlor and the settlor can name other specific events upon which the property may be disbursed. Secondly, during your lifetime you may place new property into the trust or take trust property out of the trust. You may sell trust property if you choose to do so. If you decide that you prefer to have a will rather than a trust, all you have to do is to retype the wording of the will in its identical format and substitute the names of the executor(s) in the appropriate places and sign it before a notary. Retain a copy and give a copy to the executor or any pertinent family member(s). I would suggest that you attach all deeds, bank account booklets, and any other documentation of pertaining property so they can be easily located.

In closing, I am sure that you have a great deal of information to digest and consider before making any decisions. I know it will take you a good deal of time, but each move should be given careful consideration. Take your time to consult with experts in the field as well as with other family members.

Dear Pami:

I received your letter of September 10, 2009. To answer your question, I do not have a copy of our father's will. I did not prepare it for him. The will that I saw was drawn up after the mid 1960's (if memory serves I believe it was around 1967) and was formally written (presumably by an attorney) on ivory stationery. About five years ago, I flew to Los Angeles at his request to see him regarding another matter and stayed with him for a few days. He showed his will to me and stated he was thinking of changing it. I did read it, but not wanting to get involved with that subject, I just briefly told him how to do it himself since it was a simple matter of just using the same format and changing the names as he desired, and then I went on to the issue at hand.

In the will he named you as the executrix and you and me as the sole beneficiaries. He did not itemize his property or specify who was to receive what, but just stated (and I paraphrase) that everything was to be divided equally. I was quite surprised, because both DeeDee and Anji were born by then and still living with him when his will was written and he did not mention them at all. I think Lehua was born by then as well. I have no idea if he subsequently changed his will, but I do not think so. It was my belief that he was attempting to draw me back into the family vortex by dangling the prospect of getting all his worldly goods...and he was certainly not above playing what I call "codger games" to get me there. He could not grasp how thoroughly through I was with it all. I guess that is because I would call him once a week or go to see him when I was in town, but I did that out of decency because he was my father and very old. This makes me think that he had no actual intention of changing his will at all and, since I showed no interest in him doing so, he probably dropped the matter.

Evidently, DeeDee has all of his papers. Perhaps she has not had the opportunity to go through all of them yet, but I would surmise that his will and other important papers are in her possession. Since our father only lived a month after moving to Texas, I don't believe he lived there long enough to establish his residency. I don't do probate law so you will want to get a second opinion, but I am pretty sure that means the Los Angeles Probate Court will still have jurisdiction...assuming he had enough property to go through probate. The Mojave property was no longer in his possession when he died. We were trying to help him establish a solar farm for his benefit with him receiving the proceeds from the venture. So it was put into a trust for him and we are the beneficiaries since we spent time and money to work on the project.

I do need to talk to you about his other land, but I cannot until you are able to establish yourself as his executrix by either locating the will, or, if it cannot be located and he died intestate, having the court appoint you (or someone else) as his representative. Then you, or his representative, can waive the attorney-client privilege without waivers from anyone else. Or, as I suggested before, all of his potential heirs can waive the privilege rather than have me sort out the will/no will situation.

Meanwhile, if DeeDee is in possession of the confidential legal memorandum that I wrote for him, she just may be privy to that information which will put her light years ahead of the rest of you as far as the information you need to know. But, that may just give her enough information to screw things up for all of you since she does not know what she is doing and how to handle the information properly, discretely and following the correct procedure, etc. Therefore, I would urge you to have her find the will as soon as possible and for you to give me a waiver. TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE! I do not know the total state of our father's affairs when he died. Certain things must be looked into immediately! This is for the benefit of the girls and with my life...but other circumstances will close the door of opportunity to you...and then there will be nothing I can do.

Get back to me as soon as you are able to sort matters out.
