BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated March 29, 2016 (Agenda Item 3-40), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the Construction of the Exchange Club Park Frontage Improvements Project at Mayberry Avenue and Fairview Avenue in the Community of Valle Vista.

This project will provide street frontage improvements, site grading, construction of a parking lot and off site water and sewer connections necessary for the future construction of a multi-purpose community park site located at the southwest corner of Mayberry Avenue and Fairview Avenue in the Community of Valle Vista.

The improvements include minor street widening, curb, gutter and sidewalk along Mayberry Avenue and Fairview Avenue. A new parking lot will be constructed on site for shared use by the future park developed by Valley Wide Recreation and Parks District and a new Early Childhood Education Center being developed by Hemet Unified School District (HUSD) on the shared site. The project includes the installation of new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant pedestrian ramps and extension of water and sewer utilities onto the site to serve the future development.

The project includes new pedestian ramps on Mayberry Avenue near the new parking lot driveway and adjacent to the easterly school parking lot diveway in anticipation of the need for a mid-block, marked school crosswalk. After the street improvements are completed, the County of Riverside Transportation Department (Transportation Department), working with the HUSD, will conduct an engineering study to determine if a mid-block, marked crosswalk will be beneficial. If determined benefical by Transportation Department and HUSD, this action will authorize the Director of the Transportation to install a marked crosswalk and associated signage and pavement markings as part of the performance of routine maintenance activities.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addenda on their contractor Bid in order to be considered for award. The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

The proposed budget as shown on attachment "A" includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

The Transportation Department recommends award of the following schedules of work in the Contract amount of \$985,300:

Base Bid Schedule 1:

Mayberry Avenue and Fairview Avenue Frontage Improvements

Base Bid Schedule 2:

Site Grading and Parking Lot Construction

Base Bid Schedule 3:

Water Improvements

Base Bid Schedule 4:

Sewer Improvements

The County is resposible for funding Bid Schedule1 items while Valley Wide Recreation and Parks District and Hemet Unified School District are responsible for sharing the costs shown in Bid Schedules 2, 3 and 4.

The Contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract and has provided bonds, which meet the requirements of the Contract. Acceptable insurance documents will be provided prior to the issuance of the notice to proceed with construction.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The project will improve traffic and pedestrian safety by providing an ADA compliant pedestrian path for student and parents going to and from Valle Vista Elementary School and the planned Early Childhood Education Center The new parking lot will provide additional parking for both the elementary school as well as the park site.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer of 2016 while Valle Vista Elementary School is on summer break. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction and will take approximately two months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to Beador Construction Company, Inc. for the total amount c \$985,300. The project will be funded with Gas Tax/ HUTA funds, Third District Developer Agreement Public Facilities Trust funds, Hemet Unified School District, and Valley Wide Recreation and Parks District funds in accordance with the three party agreement approved on January 12, 2016 (Agenda item 3-12).

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Four bids were received on April 27, 2016, ranging from \$985,300 to \$1,340,568 (including Base Bid Schedules 1 2, 3, and 4). The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Beador Construction Company, Inc. in the amount c \$985,300 which is \$75,067 (8.25%) higher than the Engineer's Estimate. Bid prices received, higher than the Engineer's Estimate costs, are due mainly to higher than anticipated prices for supplying and maintaining trafficontrol devices and installing aggregate base material items of work.



5-1.36D(1)(d) Payment

Payment for furnishing and installing water and sewer line extensions and installations shall be considered as included in the payment for the different items of work found on "Bid Schedules 3 and 4" of the proposal (bid items list), water and sewer improvements.

Item 9: Addition to Special Provisions – Removal of Traffic Stripes and Pavement Markings. The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereby:

Add to Section 15-2.02C Remove Traffic Stripes and Pavement Markings:

REMOVE TRAFFIC STRIPES AND PAVEMENT MARKINGS:

Traffic stripes and pavement markings shall be removed as shown on the plans and as directed by the Engineer.

The removal of traffic stripes and markings shall be accomplished by either of the following methods.

- A. Wet Sandblasting: Where blast cleaning is used for the removal of painted traffic stripes and pavement markings or for removal of objectionable material, and such removal operation is being performed within Ten (10) feet of a lane occupied by public traffic, the residue including dust shall be removed immediately after contact between the sand and the surface being treated. Such removal shall be by a vacuum attachment operating concurrently with the blast cleaning operation and shall comply with AQMD regulations.
- B. Grinding: A minimum of 3 passes with the grinder in a rectangular area rather than just lettering or markings so the old message cannot be identified is required. Removal shall be to a maximum depth of 1/10". Removal depth may exceed 1/10" only when necessary to effectively remove paint, and only on approval by the Engineer. Asphalt emulsion slurry shall be applied to the areas where stripes or pavement markings have been removed.

After removal of traffic stripes and pavement markings, a fog seal coat shall be applied in conformance with the provisions in Section 37, "Bituminous Seals" of the Standard Specifications and the following:

If removal of existing striping is performed more than 24 hours prior to final striping, the Contractor shall place reflective temporary striping tape throughout the limits of sandblasting, to provide channelization of traffic, for all lanes of travel.

Temporary striping tape shall be removed subsequent to final striping.

Nothing in these Special Provisions shall relieve the Contractor from his responsibilities as provided in Section 7-1.04, "Public Safety," of the Standard Specifications.

It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to properly dispose of the residue from removal of striping and pavement markings.

<u>Payment:</u>

Full compensation for removing traffic stripes and pavement markings including furnishing all labor materials, tools, equipment and incidentals as specified in the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer, shall be considered as included in the contract prices paid per linear foot for Paint Traffic Stripe (2-Coat), and per square foot for Thermoplastic Crosswalk and Pavement Markings and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

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Item 10: Modification of Special Provision – Removal of Existing Signs. Delete Section 15-2.03, Salvage, Remove and Salvage Existing Signs and Posts, on page 27 of the Special Provisions, and, replace with the following Special Provisions added and made part hereby:

Add following to section 15-2.02J

15-2.02J Remove Roadside Sign

Existing roadside signs and posts, shall be removed, and properly disposed of as shown on the plans in conformance with Sections 15-2.02J, "Remove Roadside Signs" of the Standard Specifications.

Payment:

Full compensation for Remove Roadside Sign shall be considered as included in the price paid per each, and shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, incidentals and for doing all the work including properly disposing of Road Signs as specified in the these Special Provisions and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

The unit price paid per cubic yard for Roadway Excavation shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all work involved including hauling, excavation and compaction, saw-cutting as shown on the plans, removal of existing pavement and base, as directed by the Engineer and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 12: Modification of Special Provision – Site Grading. Refer to Section 19-10, Site Grading on pages 30 and 31 of the Special Provisions. Delete Payment paragraph on page 31 of the Special Provisions and replace it with the following paragraph:

Payment:

Full compensation for Over Excavate, Import Material, Re-compact and Excavation (Site Grading) including compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all work involved including hauling, excavation, over-excavation and compaction, removal of existing concrete footing, as directed by the Engineer shall be paid on a lump sum basis and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 13: Addition to Special Provisions – Import Borrow Material. Refer to Section 19-10, Site Grading, on pages 30 through 31 of the Special Provisions. The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereby:

Add to Section 19-10, Site Grading, of the Special Provisions:

IMPORT BORROW:

Imported borrow and fill material needed for on-site fill areas shall be free from organics and deleterious material, and free from man-made refuse (such as: Portland cement concrete, Asphalt concrete, Residue from grooving and grinding operations, Metal, Rubber, Mixed debris, Rubble), and shall conform to the provisions of Section 19 Earthwork of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions, and shall be material that is similar or better in quality than the existing soil.

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Imported Borrow material must be obtained from sources that comply with section 6-2.04, Local Materials, of the Standard Specifications.

Payment:

Full compensation for imported borrow shall be considered as included in the contract price paid per lump sum for Over Excavate, Import Material, Re-compact and Excavation (Site Grading), and shall include full compensation for clearing and stripping the material sites if necessary; excavating, loading, hauling, depositing, spreading and compacting the material in place, within the on-site as specified. It shall also include furnishing all labor material, tools, equipment and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in obtaining and placing import borrow, complete in place and as shown on the plans and as specified in these specification and special provisions and as directed by the Engineer and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 14: Addition to Special Provisions – Erosion Control (Hydroseed). The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereby:

Replace Reserved Section 21-1.02N in the Standard Specifications with:

21-1.02N Erosion Control (Hydroseed)

21-1.02N(1) GENERAL

21-1.02N(2) Summary

This work includes applying erosion control (hydroseed) materials including seed, fiber, commercial fertilizer, organic fertilizer, straw, and tackifier to on-site graded areas shown on the plans.

Comply with Section 21, "Erosion Control," of the Standard Specifications.

If notified by the Engineer that an area is ready to receive erosion control materials, start erosion control (hydroseed) work within 5 business days of the Engineer's notification to perform the work.

The Engineer will designate the ground location of all erosion control (hydroseed) areas in increments of one acre or smaller by directing the placing of stakes or other suitable markers. Furnish all tools, labor, materials, and transportation required to adequately mark the various erosion control (hydroseed) locations.

21-1.02N(3) MATERIALS

21-1.02N(3)A Seed

Deliver seed to the job site in unopened separate containers with the seed tags attached. A container without a seed tag attached is not accepted. The Engineer takes a sample of approximately 1 Oz or 2 Oz of seed for each seed lot greater than 2 lbs. Seed must comply with the following and table shown in section 21-1.02N(4)B "Application" of these Special Provisions:

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21-1.02N(3)B Seed Sampling Supplies

At the time of seed sampling, provide the Engineer a glassine lined bag and custody seal tag for each seed lot sample.

21-1.02N(3)C Commercial Fertilizer

Commercial fertilizer must have a guaranteed chemical analysis within 10 percent of 5 to 8 percent nitrogen, 3 to 6 percent phosphoric acid and 1 to 3 percent water soluble potash.

21-1.02N(3)D Straw

Straw must be one of the following:

- 1. Wheat
- 2. Barley
- 3. Wheat or barley

Wheat and barley straw must be derived from irrigated crops. Straw must be free of plastic, glass, metal, rocks, and refuse or other deleterious material.

21-1.02N(3)E Tackifier

Tackifier must be:

- 1. Nonflammable
- 2. Nontoxic to aquatic organisms
- 3. Free from growth or germination inhibiting factors
- 4. Bonded to the fiber or prepackaged with the fiber by the manufacturer
- At least 10 percent of the weight of the dry fiber and include the weight of the activating agents and additives
- Organic, high viscosity colloidal polysaccharide with activating agents, or a blended hydrocolloidbased binder

21-1.02N(3)F Fiber

Fiber must be:

- 1. Long strand, whole wood fibers, thermo-mechanically processed from clean, whole wood chips.
- 2. Not made from sawdust, cardboard, paper, or paper byproducts.
- 3. At least 25 percent of fibers 3/8 inch long.
- 4. At least 50 percent held on a No. 25 sieve.
- 5. Free from lead paint, printing ink, varnish, petroleum products, seed germination inhibitors, or chlorine bleach.
- 6. Free from synthetic or plastic materials.
- 7. At most 7 percent ash.
- 8. Coloring agent for fiber must be a biodegradable nontoxic coloring agent free from copper, mercury, and arsenic.

21-1.02N(3)G Coloring Agent

Use a biodegradable, nontoxic coloring agent free from copper, mercury, and arsenic.

21-1.02N(4) CONSTRUCTION

21-1.02N(4)A Site Preparation

Immediately before applying seed to erosion control (Hydroseed) areas, remove trash and debris and weeds.

Removed weeds must be disposed of in conformance with the provisions in Section 7-1.13, "Disposal of Material Outside the Highway Right of Way," of the Standard Specifications.

21-1.02N(4)B Application

Apply erosion control (hydroseed) materials in separate applications in the following sequence:

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 Apply the following mixture with hydroseeding equipment at the rates indicated within 60 minutes after the seed has been added to the mixture:

Fiber	3,500
Commercial Fertilizer	1,000

- 2. Apply straw at the rate of 565 pounds per acre based on slope measurements. Incorporation of straw will not be required. Distribute straw evenly without clumping or piling.
- 3. Apply the following mixture with hydroseeding equipment at the corresponding

Tackifier	565

The ratio of total water to total tackifier in the mixture must be as recommended by the manufacturer.

Seed may be dry applied at the total rate specified in the preceding table for small areas not accessible by the hydroseeding equipment if approved by the Engineer. Dry-applied seed must be incorporated into the soil a maximum depth of 1/4 inch by raking or dragging.

Hydraulic application of erosion control (hydroseed) materials for rolled erosion control product (netting) areas must be applied by hose, from the ground. Erosion control (hydroseed) materials must be applied onto the slope face such that the materials are well integrated into the rolled erosion control product (netting) and in contact with ground surface. Application must be perpendicular to the slope face such that rolled erosion control product (netting) materials are not damaged or displaced. Once straw work is started in an area, complete tackifier applications in that area within the same work shift.

The Engineer may change the rates of erosion control (hydroseed) materials to meet field conditions.

For any area where erosion control (hydroseed) materials are to be applied, the application of all erosion control (hydroseed) materials to be applied to that area must be completed within 72 hours from when the first materials were applied.

21-1.02N(5) PAYMENT

Erosion control (hydroseed) will be measured to the nearest 0.01 of an acre. The area will be calculated on the basis of field measurement and as computed for slope surface (not plan view) measurements.

The contract price paid per acre for erosion control (hydroseed) includes full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in erosion control (hydroseed) complete in place, as shown on the plans, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these special provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

Item 15: Addition to Special Provisions – Apply Fog Seal to Intersection. Refer to Section 37-2.01A on page 33 of the Special Provisions. The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereby:

Add to Section 37-2.01A, Summary, of the Special Provisions:

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Although not shown on the plans, the contractor will be required to apply fog seal at the intersection of Mayberry Avenue and Fairview Avenue in conformance with the requirements of Section 37, Bituminous Seals, of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Payment for Fog Seal application on Mayberry Avenue and Fairview Avenue Intersection shall be considered as included in the contract price paid per ton for Asphaltic Emulsion (Fog Seal Coat) and shall include full compensation for, furnishing and placing fog seal, and all labor and materials needed to perform the work.

Item 16: Modifications to Special Provisions – Minor Concrete Structures. Refer to Section 51, Minor Concrete Structures, on pages 45 and 46 of the Special Provisions.

1. Delete the list of minor concrete structures on Section 51-1.01, General, page 45, and replace it with the following list:

Minor concrete structures for this project shall consist of:

- Catch basin (curb inlet) per County Standard No. 300, including RCP
- 2' x 2' concrete catch basin per Brooks No. 2424 T24 including steel grate and three (3) 6" HDPE drain lines to infiltration (detention) basin
- 3' x 3' BROOKS CB3636 CATCH BASIN. Use Galvanized Traffic Grate. Use E6 TOP (Extension Section) and B36 Bottom Section. Including one (1) 12" HDPE drain line to back of street catch basin on Mayberry Avenue.
- 2. The following Special Provisions are added to Section 51-1.01 and made part hereby:

The Contractor shall furnish and install the necessary section of reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) required for connecting the new catch basin on Mayberry Avenue at Station 17+21 to the existing RCP. RCP shall conform to Section 65, Concrete Pipe, of the Standard Specifications, these special provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

Except as otherwise designated by classification on the plans or in the specifications, joints for culvert and drainage pipes shall conform to the plans or specifications for standard joints.

Full compensation for the removal of existing drop inlet, and for furnishing and installing RCP to connect the new catch basin and the existing RCP at Mayberry Avenue, Station 17+21, including the work, equipment, labor and materials involved shall be considered as included in the contract price paid per each for Catch Basin (Curb Inlet) CRS 300, and no additional compensation shall be allowed therefor.

3. The following Special Provisions are added to Section 51-1.01 and made part hereby:

The Contractor must furnish one stencil with the legend "ONLY RAIN IN THE DRAIN". The Contractor shall submit a copy of the final stencil design for approval by the Engineer prior to fabrication. After approval from the Engineer, the Contractor must spray paint the legend at the catch basin inlet located on Station 17+21. Full compensation for furnishing stencil and painting the legend shall be considered as included in the contract price paid per each for Catch Basin (Curb Inlet) CRS 300.

4. Delete Section 51-1.0, Payment, on pages 45 and 46 of the Special Provisions and replace it with the following:

51-1.04 PAYMENT

The contract unit price paid for each minor structure will not be adjusted if the constructed height of said minor structure, including revisions by Engineer, is within \pm 0.5 foot of the vertical dimension shown on the plans.

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Payment for all work involved in the construction of minor structures will be per each for Catch basin (curb inlet) per County Standard No. 300 including RCP, 2' x 2' concrete catch basin per Brooks No. 2424 T24 including steel grate and three (3) 6" HDPE drain lines to infiltration (detention) basin, and 3' x 3' BROOKS CB3636 CATCH BASIN including one (1)12" HDPE drain line to back of street catch basin on Mayberry Avenue; and shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools and equipment, and doing all work involved in the complete structure, including the structures structural excavation and backfill, removal of existing structures (inlets), furnishing and placing reinforcement steel, and metal frames, covers and grates, and no further allowances shall be allowed.

Item 17: Addition to Special Provisions – HDPE Pipe. The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereby:

HIGH DENSITY POLYETHYLENE (HDPE) PIPE:

Plastic Pipe shall conform to the provisions in Section 64, "Plastic Pipe", of the Standard Specifications, except as otherwise specified in these specifications.

Plastic Pipe shall be Type S corrugated polyethylene pipe with smooth interior wall manufactured from high density polyethylene (HDPE) virgin compounds.

Installation shall be in accordance with the plans, Standard Specifications, these specifications, and as recommended by the pipe manufacturer.

All the joints of the HDPE pipes need to be watertight. The watertight joints shall conform to section 64 of the Standard specifications. Full compensation of all labor, materials, tools, and incidentals for making the HDPE pipes watertight shall be included in the payment for the different concrete structures (2' x 2' concrete catch basin, and 3' x 3' BROOKS CB3636 catch basin) connecting to HDPE Pipe.

At all pipe joint locations, the inside of the pipe shall be smooth and free of obstructions.

Except as otherwise designated by classification on the plans or in the specifications, joints for culvert and drainage pipes shall conform to the plans or specifications for standard joints.

Pipe shall be placed in a trench 12" minimum wider than the outside diameter of the pipe being installed. Trenching shall be 6" minimum in width on each side of the pipe.

The pipe shall be placed in the bottom of the trench and the trench shall be backfilled.

If so directed by the Engineer, the pipe shall be backfilled with two sack slurry.

The slurry shall be allowed to cure a minimum of two days prior to final paving.

Slurry cement backfill shall conform to Section 19-3.02D of the Standard Specifications, except that full compensation therefor shall be considered as included in the prices paid per each for the different concrete structures (2' x 2' concrete catch basin, and 3' x 3' BROOKS CB3636 catch basin) connecting to HDPE Pipe, and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

<u>Payment:</u>

Full compensation for furnishing and installing HDPE pipe shall be as considered included in the contract prices paid per each for the different concrete structures (2' x 2' concrete catch basin, and 3' x 3' BROOKS CB3636 catch basin) connecting to HDPE Pipe, and shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all of the work involved in installing HDPE Pipe, complete in place, including structure excavation and backfill, slurry encasement if required, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these special provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

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Item 18: Addition to Special Provisions – Sign Sizes. Refer to Section 56-4, Roadside Signs, on page 46 of the Special Provisions. The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereby:

Roadside signs for this project shall be of the following sizes:

R1-1: 36" R1-3P: 18" x 6" W3-1: 36" x 36"

SR4-1 (School Speed Limit Assembly C): 24" x 48"

S1-1: 36" x 36" W16-9P: 24" x 12"

Item 19: Addition to Special Provision – Painting Curb Red. The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereby:

Add to Section 59-6, Painting Concrete of the Standard Specifications:

59-6.01 General

This work shall consist of preparing and painting concrete curb, where shown on the plans, and in conformance with these special provisions.

59-6.02 Materials

The paint shall be a light-stable, alkali-resistant, acrylic latex or acrylic latex copolymer emulsion, commercially manufactured for use as an exterior concrete coating. The paint shall conform to the provisions in Section 91-4.05, Paint, Acrylic Emulsion, Exterior White and Light and Medium Tints, of the Standard Specifications.

The paint shall be formulated and applied so that the color of the coated concrete matches Federal Standard 595B No. FS 31302, Red, or as approved by the Engineer.

The Contractor shall submit to the Engineer, not less than 7 days before initial application of the concrete coating, a copy of the manufacturer's recommendations and written application instructions.

59-6.03 Construction

Surface Preparation

New concrete surfaces to be painted shall be at least 14 calendar days old before painting, or as approved by the resident Engineer.

Concrete curb to be painted shall be prepared in conformance with the requirements of SSPC SP 13/NACE No. 6, "Surface Preparation of Concrete," of the "SSPC: The Society of Protective Coatings." After concrete surface preparation is complete, the Contractor shall clean all concrete surfaces to be painted by pressure rinsing as defined in Section 59 1.03, "Application," of the Standard Specifications.

Painting Concrete

The coating shall be applied per the manufacturer's recommendations and in conformance with the requirements of SSPC PA 7, "Applying Thin Film Coatings to Concrete," of the "SSPC: The Society of Protective Coatings."

Any damaged areas shall be repaired in the same manner as the original surface preparation and paint application.

59-6.04 Payment

The contract price paid per linear foot for Paint Curb (2-Coat) [Red] shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals for doing all the work involved in preparing, and applying paint to concrete curbs, complete in place, including repairing damaged areas, as shown on the

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plans, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these special provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

Item 20: Addition to Special Provision – Drainage Inlet Filtration System. The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereby:

Add as Section 70-5.04A:

70-5.04A Drainage Inlet Filtration System

Section 70-5.04A includes specifications for constructing drainage inlet filtration systems. Submit a certificate of compliance from the manufacturer.

70-5.04A (2) Materials

Drainage inlet filtration system must be furnished and installed as shown under these special provisions.

The allowable drainage inlet filtration systems must consist of the following or a Department-authorized equal.

 Kristar – Flogard Plus Catch Basin Insert Filter. The Flogard can be obtained from the manufacturer Oldcastle Stormwater Solutions, 7921 Southpark Plaza, Suite 200, Littleton, CO 80120. Phone 1-800-579-8819.

70-5.04A(3) Construction

Installation of drainage inlet filtration system must comply with the manufacturer's instructions.

70-5.04A(4) Payment

Drainage inlet filtration system will be measured and paid for by the unit, determined from actual count of units installed in place.

The unit price paid for installation of the drainage inlet filtration system shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing the work involved installing the drainage inlet filtration system in accordance with these special provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

- Item 21: Modifications to Special Provisions Minor Concrete Items. Refer to Section 73, Concrete Curbs and Sidewalks, on pages 47 and 48 of the Special Provisions.
- 1. The following Special Provisions are added to Section 73-1.01, General, and made part hereby:

The two curb ramps located on Mayberry Avenue at approximately Station 15+15 shall be constructed per County Standard No. 403, Curb Ramp Case C. Refer to Addendum No. 1, Attachment B, for County Standard No. 403, Curb Ramp Case C.

2. The following Special Provisions are added to Section 73-1.01, General, and made part hereby:

DETECTABLE WARNING SURFACES (TRUNCATED DOMES)

This work includes installing detectable warning surface on the curb ramps or on the areas as shown on the plans, and as specified in these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

Curb ramp detectable warning surface must be:

- 1. Yellow color complying with Federal Standard 595B, Color No. 33538.
- 2. Raised truncated domes.

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The manufacturer must provide a written 5-year warranty for detectable warning surface, guaranteeing replacement when there is defect in the dome shape, color fastness, sound-on-cane acoustic quality, resilience, or attachment. The warranty period will begin upon acceptance of the contract.

Installation of curb ramp detectable warning surface must comply with the manufacturer's recommendations.

Full compensation for Detectable Warning Surface (Truncated Domes) shall be considered as included in the contract unit prices paid for the different Minor Concrete items of work found in the bid items list, and shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals for doing all work involved in constructing detectable warning surface, complete in place, as shown on the plans, as specified in these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer, and no separate payment will be made therefor.

3. Delete the Payment paragraph on page 48 of the Special Provisions, Section 73-1.04, and replace it with the following paragraph:

Payment:

The contract unit bid prices paid per:

- each (EA) for Minor Concrete Curb Ramps, and Parking Lot Handicapped Ramps;
- · linear foot (LF) for the different kinds of Curb, and Curb and Gutter; and
- square foot (SQFT) for the different kinds of sidewalk, commercial driveway, widened curb at parking lot end stalls in planters, 6" thick PCC (on-site apron at trash enclosure), and 6" thick on-site V-gutter; shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, equipment, materials and tools, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in the concrete items construction including the grading and the removal of any obstacles within the areas of proposed concrete items, removal of existing concrete items (ramps, sidewalk, curb and gutter), concrete items transitions (curb, curb and gutter), furnishing and placing reinforcement steel, welded wire mesh, furnishing and placing expansion joints, complete in place as shown on the plans, the standard drawings, architectural details, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer, and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 22: Addition to Special Provision – Infiltration (Detention) Basin Tubular Steel Fencing and Gate.
The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereby:

Replace Section 80-11, Reserved, of the Standard Specifications with:

Tubular fencing and gate shall be installed on the infiltration (detention) basin perimeter in accordance with these Special Provisions and Valley-Wide Recreation & Parks District details and requirements.

Refer to Addendum 1, Attachment B, for VWR&PD Std. LC-12 for Tubular Steel Fencing and VWR&PD Std. LC-13 for Tubular Steel Gate.

Fencing shall be tubular steel with black powder coating. Any proposed alterations must be submitted for approval.

Vehicle access gate shall be provided for the basin entrance. Gate must be designed to restrict pedestrian or vehicle public access.

Tubular Steel Fencing

Steel material for fence panels and posts shall conform to the requirements of ASTM A653/A653M, with a minimum yield strength of 50,000 psi (344 MPa) and a minimum zinc (hot-dip galvanized) coating weight of 0.90 oz/ft² (276 g/m²), Coating Designation G-90.

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Material for fence pickets shall be 3/4" square x 16 Ga. tubing. Picket holes in the rail shall be spaced 4" O.C.

Posts shall be a minimum of 2-1/2" square x 14 Ga. Rails shall be tubular steel with a minimum radius of 1-3/8". Rails shall be installed 4" above concrete mowcurb.

Pickets, rails and posts shall be pre-cut to specified lengths.

The manufactured panels and posts shall be subjected to inline electrode position coating process consisting of a multi-stage pretreatment/wash (with zinc phosphate), followed by a duplex cathodic electro coat application of an epoxy primer followed by an acrylic topcoat. The minimum cumulative coating thickness of epoxy and acrylic shall be 2 mils (0.058 mm). The color shall be black. Any field welds if required must have one coat of epoxy primer and two coats of exterior enamel. Painting must be guaranteed for 5 years.

Gates shall be fabricated using welded ornamental panel material and gate ends having a 1-3/4" square cross-sectional size. All rail and upright intersections shall be joined by welding. All picket and rail intersections shall also be joined by welding. All welds shall be primed and receive two coats of black enamel paint.

All fence posts shall have a 2" min. standard square cap permanently secured to each post.

Concrete footings shall be 2500 PSI @ 28 days. Footings shall be as indicated within the District details.

All tubular steel fencing shall have a maintenance concrete mowcurb between each post per District detail unless approved by the District. Footing height shall allow for mow curb form boards to avoid breaking post footings in order to form and pour mowcurb

All fencing shall be installed per District details.

Payment:

The contract price paid per linear foot for Install 6' Tubular Steel Fencing including Gate shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals for doing all the work involved in furnishing and installing tubular steel fencing and gate, including concrete footings, excavation and backfill, as shown on the plans, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these special provisions, and as directed by the Engineer, and no additional compensation will be allowed.

Item 23: Modification of Special Provision – Conduit. Refer to Section 86-2.05, Conduit on pages 49 and 50 of the Special Provisions.

1. The following Special Provisions are added to Section 86-2.05 and made part hereby:

Conduit depth shall not exceed 60 inches below finish grade. Conduit depth shall be at a minimum of 36 inches below finished grade.

2. The following Special Provisions are added to Section 86-2.05 and made part hereby

Pull boxes (shown on the plans) will be required at the ends of the PVC conduit installed. Pull boxes must be 17"x30" electrical pull boxes with fiberglass body and polymer concrete ring as manufactured by J&R Concrete Products, Std. P-E6B, or approved equal. Full compensation for furnishing and installing these pull boxes shall be considered as included in the linear feet contract price paid for the different types of conduit included in the bid items list.

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3. Delete the Payment paragraph on page 50 of the Special Provisions and replace it with the following paragraph:

Payment:

GRADING GENERAL NOTES

GENERAL

- All grading shall conform to the 2013 California Building Code Chapter 17, 18 & Appendix-J as amended by Ordinance 457.
- 2. All property corners, grading boundaries and all Conservation Areas/Least Sensitive Area (LSA) determined by the Environmental Programs Department (EPD) shall be clearly delineated and staked in the field prior to commencement of any construction/grading.
- 3. All work under this permit shall be applicable to work within the property lines.
- 4. All grading shall be done under the supervision of a soils engineer in conformance with the recommendations of the preliminary soils investigation prepared by Inland Foundation Engineering, Inc. dated April 7, 2016.

- Compacted fill to support any structures shall comply with Section 1803.5.8. Projects without a preliminary soils report shall include detailed specifications in accordance with Sections 1803.2 and 1803.5 prepared by the engineer of record.
- 6. The contractor shall notify Underground Service Alert, two days before digging at 1-800-422-4133.

CUT/FILL

- 7. Maximum cut and fill slope = 2:1 (horizontal to vertical).
- 8. No fill shall be placed on existing ground until the ground has been cleared of weeds, topsoil and other deleterious material. Fills should be placed in thin lifts (8-inch max or as recommenced in the soils report), compacted and tested throughout the grading process until final grades are attained. All fills on slopes steeper than 5 to 1 (horizontal to vertical) and a height greater than 5 feet shall be keyed and benched into firm natural soil for full support. The bench under the toe must be 10 feet wide minimum.
- 9. The slope stability for cut and fill slopes over 30 feet in vertical height, or cut slopes steeper than 2:1 have been verified with a factor of safety of at least 1.5.
- 10. No rock or similar irreducible material with a maximum dimension greater than 12 inches shall be buried or placed in fills closer than 10 feet to the finished grade.

DRAINAGE, EROSION / DUST CONTROL

- 11. Drainage across property lines shall not exceed that which existed prior to grading. Excess or concentrated drainage shall be contained on site or directed to an approved drainage facility. Erosion of the ground in the area of discharge shall be prevented by installation of non-erosive down drains or other devices.
- 12. Provide a paved slope interceptor drain along the top of cut slopes where the drainage path is greater than 40 feet towards the cut slope.
- 13. Provide 5' wide by 1' high berm along the top of all fill slopes steeper than 3:1 (horizontal to vertical).
- 14. The ground surface immediately adjacent to the building foundation shall be sloped away from the building at a slope of not less than one unit vertical in 20 units horizontal (5-percent slope) for a minimum distance of 10 feet measured perpendicular to the face of the foundation.
- 15. No obstruction of natural water courses shall be permitted.
- 16. During rough grading operations and prior to construction of permanent drainage structures, temporary drainage control (Best Management Practices, BMPs) shall be in place to prevent ponding water and drainage to adjacent properties.

- 19. All existing drainage courses and storm drain facilities shall continue to function. Protective measures and temporary drainage provisions must be used to protect adjoining properties during grading operations.

NPDES: When one acre or more is being disturbed:

- Construction site Best Management Practices (BMPs) for the management of storm water and nonstormwater discharges shall be installed per the grading plan. Arrangements shall be made by the contractor to retain the SWPPP on the jobsite throughout the time of construction. The implementation and maintenance of the site BMPs is required to minimize jobsite erosion and sedimentation. The contractor shall maintain those BMPs throughout the time of construction.
- 2. Erosion control BMPs shall be implemented and maintained to prevent and/or minimize the entrainment of soil in runoff from disturbed soil areas on construction sites.
- Sediment control BMPs shall be implemented and maintained to prevent and/or minimize the transport of soil from the construction site.
- 4. The construction site shall be managed to minimize the exposure time of disturbed soil areas through phasing and scheduling of grading and the use of temporary and permanent soil stabilization.
- 5. Once disturbed, slopes (temporary or permanent) shall be stabilized if they will not be worked within 21 days. During storm season, all slopes shall be stabilized prior to predicted storm event. Construction sites shall be revegetated as early as feasible after soil disturbance.

- Stockpiles of soil shall be properly contained to eliminate or reduce sediment transport from the site or streets, drainage facilities or adjacent properties via runoff, vehicle tracking, or wind.
- 7. Construction sites shall be maintained in such a condition that a storm does not carry wastes or pollutants off the site. Discharges other than stormwater (non-stormwater discharges) are prohibited, except as authorized by an individual NPDES permit, the statewide General Permit-Construction Activity. Potential pollutants include but are not limited to: solid or liquid chemical spills; wastes from paints, stains, sealants, solvents, detergents, glues, lime, pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, wood preservatives, and asbestos fibers, paint flakes or stucco fragments, fuels, oils, lubricants, and hydraulic, radiator or battery fluids, concrete and related cutting or curing residues; floatable wastes; wastes from engine/equipment steam cleaning or chemical degreasing; wastes from street cleaning; and super-chlorinated potable water from line flushing and testing. During construction, disposal of such materials should occur in a specified and controlled temporary area on-site physically separate from potential stormwater runoff, with ultimate disposal in accordance with local, state and federal requirements.
- 8. Runoff from equipment and vehicle washing shall be contained at construction site and must not be discharged to receiving waters or local storm drain system.
- Appropriate BMPs for construction-related materials, wastes, spills or residues shall be implemented to eliminate or reduce transport from the site to streets, drainage facilities, or adjoining properties by wind or runoff.
- 10. All construction contractors and subcontractor personnel are to be trained in the implementation and use of the required BMPs and good housekeeping measures for the project site and any associated construction staging areas and all training documentation shall be maintained in the SWPPP.
- 11. Discharging contaminated groundwater produced by dewatering groundwater that has infiltrated into the construction site is prohibited. Discharging of contaminated soils via surface erosion is also prohibited. Discharging non-contaminated groundwater produced by dewatering activities may require a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit from the Regional Water Quality Control Board.
- 12. BMPs shall be maintained at all times. In addition, BMPs shall be inspected prior to predicted storm events and following storm events.
- 13. At the end of each day of construction activity, all construction debris and waste materials shall be collected and properly disposed of in trash or recycle bins.



THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **BEADOR CONSTRUCTION COMPANY**, **INC.**, hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

Recitals:

- 2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders. (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of 2010 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda (Two), (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents.
