BACKGROUND:

Summary (continued)

The Integrated Cooperative System is currently paying for maintenance and repair. With the acceptance of the engines, the replacement will now be paid by the Engine Use Agreement Fund, which the Rubidoux Community Services District will now be contributing into for the replacement.

The transfer is beneficial to the Rubidoux Community Services District as well as the surrounding Cities and Unincorporated areas. The engines currently provide depth within the Fire Department and are used within the Integrated Cooperative Regional System. The transfer of title will ensure that these engines continue to be functional and available for the Regional System. It will also allow the department more flexibility to move the engines to other locations when necessary; however, these engines will be stationed at Rubidoux's FS 38 for the time being.

Additional Fiscal Information

The maintenance and repair of these engines will be allocated through the Department's Cost Allocation Plan, as all vehicles that are maintained by the Department that are utilized in providing Fire Services are allocated in our annual Cost Allocation Plan. There is no net cost to the county or our partners due to this transfer, except the Rubidoux Community Services District will be paying into the engine replacement fund for when these engines ultimately need to be replaced.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The Rubidoux Community Services District has been contracting for Riverside County Fire Service since 1988 and most recently approved their Cooperative Agreement on January 28, 2014 Item 3-16.
