BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation Funds will be allocated to one (1) 2016 High School Graduate, who served on the Fifth District Youth Advisory Council, and is the recipient of a Fifth District Scholarship.

1. This scholarship award is designed to reward Fifth District Youth Advisory Council Members (YAC) hard work, assist in their education and improve our community.
 - a. All 12th grade YAC members were able to apply for this scholarship.
2. Eligibility considerations are as follows:
 - a. Graduating seniors who are attending community colleges, public colleges or universities, private universities, or eligible trade schools (proof of acceptance required)
 - b. Total number of hours that were contributed to the council
 - c. How many years served as a member on the YAC (up to \$250 per year served)
 - d. Has the YAC member demonstrated any growth?
 - e. What sorts of ideas or projects have been contributed to on the council?
 - f. Provision of Official Transcript
 - g. Applicants must turn in an essay regarding how acting as a Youth Advisory Council member has made a positive influence on both their professional development and college preparation.
