**BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:**

The Riverside County Behavioral Health Commission (BHC) is an advisory body, composed of volunteers appointed by the Board of Supervisors, who work in conjunction with the Riverside University Health System, Behavioral Health to ensure citizen and professional input and involvement in all aspects of Department Services.

Mr. Divine has served on the Behavioral Health Commission formerly known as Riverside County's Mental Health Board for 19 years. He was previously an appointee of the 4<sup>th</sup> Supervisorial District, and will now be an appointee of the 2<sup>nd</sup> District.
