BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Inland Library Network, a part of the Riverside County Library System, provides automation services to several independent but cooperating libraries within Riverside County. Agreements for these services have been in place since 1997. This agreement extends the current agreement through June 30, 2018.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

Providing automation services is part of the Riverside County Library System mission to encourage cooperation between jurisdictional lines. This Amendment will continue the automation services for patrons of the College of the Desert and surrounding community.

1 **SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR AUTOMATED LIBRARY SERVICES**

2 (Riverside County Library System and College of the Desert)

4 WHEREAS, the County of Riverside, Riverside County Library System (“County”) has
5 entered into a contract with the College of the Desert (“College”) for the provision of
6 automated library services (the “Agreement”) and both parties now agree to further amend the
7 Agreement, to be effective on July 1, 2016:

8 NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

9 A. Section 1 is amended as follows:

10 “The term of this Agreement is extended to include the time period of July 1, 2016 to
11 June 30, 2018”.

12 B. Section 3 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

13 The total amount payable to County for Fiscal Years 2016/17-2017/18 shall not exceed
14 \$87,186 per fiscal year.”

15 C. The following electronic databases listed in Section 4 of Exhibit A have been removed
16 at their entirety:


