BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated June 7, 2016 (Agenda Item 3-42), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of approximately 500 linear feet of sidewalk and associated improvements on the north side of Grand Avenue between Gregory Place and Fairmont Lane in the Community of Lakeland Village. The sidewalk will provide a safer pedestrian path for travel to and from the Lakeland Village School which serves grades K-8.

Improvements on Grand Avenue will connect the existing curb, gutter and sidewalks on the north side of the street between Gregory Place and Fairmont Lane. Currently, this segment of Grand Avenue consists of a graded dirt shoulder and lacks the protection of a raised curb barrier.

Other improvements include construction of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant ramps at the intersection of Grand Avenue and Stoneman Street.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The addendum was issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1.

The proposed budget as shown on attachment "A" includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

The County of Riverside Transportation Department (Transportation Department) recommends award of the following schedules of work in the Contract amount of \$188,740:

Base Bid Schedule: Grand Avenue Sidewalk Improvement Project
Alternate Bid Schedule 2: Masonry Block Wall

Alternate bid schedule 1, for the relocation of a gas meter, is not selected for award due to Southern California Gas Company performing the relocation work.

The Contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents, which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The improvements will improve pedestrian safety around Lakeland Village School.

The work is scheduled to begin in Fall 2016. The road will be open during construction and will take approximately one month to complete. The Contractor will be required to coordinate the construction with Lake Elsinore School District for minimum disruption of traffic during peak hours.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to S&H Civilworks for the total amount of \$188,740. The project will be funded with Gas Tax/Highway users Tax Account (HUTA) and SB-821 Local Transportation funds for which the Transportation Department successfully competed.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Eight bids were received on June 7, 2016, ranging from \$191,240 to \$345,000 (including Base Bid Schedules and Alternate Bid Schedules 1 and 2). The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by S&H Civilworks in the amount of \$188,740 which is \$11,875 (7%) above the Engineer's Estimate.

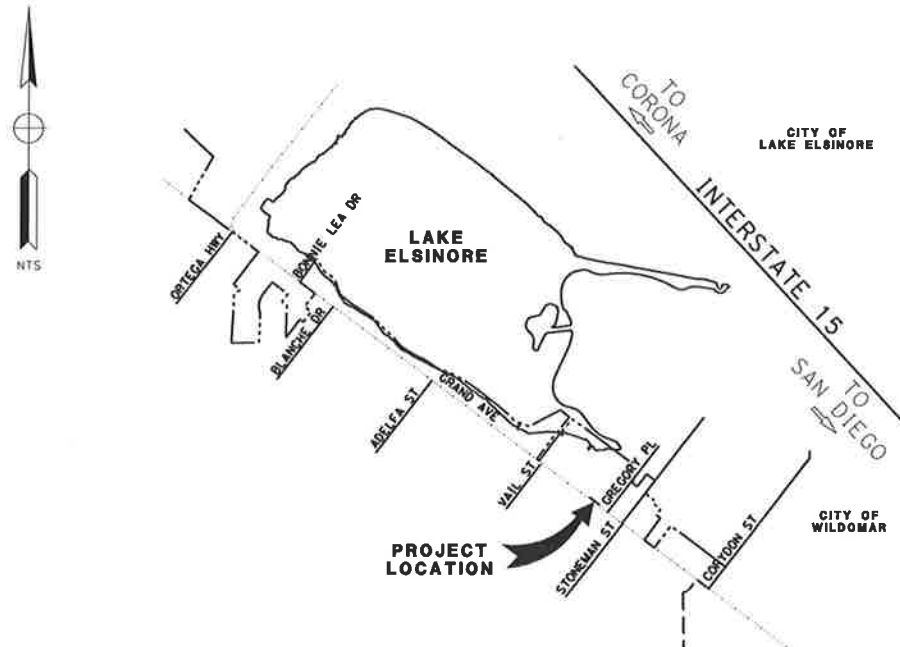

WITNESSETH

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, Grand Avenue Sidewalk Improvement Project, Approximately 505-foot Segment, Between Gregory Place and Fairmont Lane, Community of Lakeland Village, Project No. C6-0056, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders. (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of 2010 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda (One), (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract, the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

For the purposes of this extension personal effects means tangible property that is worn or carried by an insured including portable audio, visual, or electronic devices. Personal effects does not include tools, jewelry, guns, money and securities, or musical instruments

Q. EXTRA EXPENSE FOR STOLEN AUTO

Section III – Physical Damage Coverage, A.4. Coverage Extensions is amended by adding the following:

We will pay up to \$1,000 for the expense incurred returning a stolen covered "auto" to you because of the total theft of such covered "auto". Coverage applies only to those covered "autos" for which you carry Comprehensive or Specified Causes Of Loss Coverage.

R. RENTAL REIMBURSEMENT

Section III – Physical Damage Coverage, A.4. Coverage Extensions is amended by adding the following:

1. This coverage applies only to a covered "auto" for which Physical Damage Coverage is provided on this policy.

7. Coverage provided by this extension is excess over any other collectible insurance and/or endorsement to this policy.

S. AIRBAG COVERAGE

Section III – Physical Damage Coverage, B.3.a. Exclusions is amended by adding the following:

If you have purchased Comprehensive or Collision Coverage under this policy, the exclusion relating to mechanical breakdown does not apply to the accidental discharge of an airbag.

However, we waive any right of recovery we may have against any person, or organization with whom you have a written contract, agreement or permit executed prior to the "loss" that requires a waiver of recovery for payments made for damages arising out of your operations done under contract with such person or organization.

Y. UNINTENTIONAL FAILURE TO DISCLOSE EXPOSURES

Section IV – Business Auto Conditions, B.2. Concealment, Misrepresentation, Or Fraud is amended by adding the following:
