BACKGROUND: Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Resolution 2009-307 adopted November 24, 2009, the Board of Supervisors noticed a public hearing for January 12, 2010, to receive testimony regarding the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LMD No. 89-1-C). Annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97 will fund the provision of electricity for streetlights within public rights-of-way located northerly of Cajalco Rd in the Mead Valley area and includes 3 commercial parcels, totaling 1.79 acre(s).

BACKGROUND: Adoption of Resolution No. 2009-306 appoints the Director of the Transportation Department as the Engineer to prepare a Report regarding the proposed annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated ("L&LMD No. 89-1-C").

Resolution No. 2009-307 declares the Board's intention of ordering the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97 to L&LMD No. 89-1-C. Annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97 to L&LMD No. 89-1-C will fund the provision of electricity for streetlights within public right-of-way located northerly of Cajalco Rd in the Mead Valley area and includes 3 commercial parcels, totaling 1.79 acre(s).

The proposed budget for fiscal year 2010-11 for Street Lighting Zone 97 is \$330 that will result in an assessment for fiscal year 2010-11 within Street Lighting Zone 97 of \$184.36 per acre. The annual assessment will be adjusted annually by the greater of 2% or the cumulative percentage increase in the CPI-U for "electricity", if any, as it stands as of March of each year over the base index for March of 2009.

Consistent with the Board's direction regarding compliance with Article XIIID of the California Constitution and the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, the attached resolutions have been prepared and a public hearing scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on January 12, 2010 to receive testimony for and against the proposed assessment. Each property owner within the proposed Street Lighting Zone 97 will receive a notice of the public hearing and mail-in ballot, an impartial analysis, a copy of Resolution No. 2009-307, and an information sheet.

Ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing. If, at the time designated for the tabulation of the ballots, the ballots submitted in favor of the annexation and levy of the assessment exceed the ballots submitted in opposition of said annexation and levy, Street Lighting Zone 97 will be annexed to L&LMD No. 89-1-C.

The individuasl/entities which own all of the property within the proposed boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 97 have executed a "Waiver and Consent Regarding Date of Assessment Ballot Election" allowing for the election and public hearing to be held on January 12, 2010.



RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE DECLARING ITS INTENT TO ORDER THE ANNEXATION OF STREET LIGHTING ZONE 97 TO LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 89-1-CONSOLIDATED OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE PURSUANT TO THE LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ACT OF 1972 FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND SERVICING OF STREETLIGHTS: ADOPTING THE PRELIMINARY ENGINEER'S REPORT: GIVING NOTICE OF AND SETTING THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ANNEXATION OF STREET LIGHTING ZONE 97; ORDERING AN ASSESSMENT PROCEEDING; ORDERING A MAILED BALLOT ELECTION; AND DIRECTING NOTICE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING AND THE ASSESSMENT BALLOT TO BE MAILED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIIID OF THE CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTION AND SECTION 4000 OF THE ELECTIONS CODE

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (hereinafter the "Board of Supervisors") of the County of Riverside (hereinafter the "County") has adopted Resolution No. 2009-306 on November 24, 2009 initiating proceedings for the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97 (hereinafter "Street Lighting Zone 97"), as described and shown in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No.89-1-Consolidated of the County of Riverside, State of California, (hereinafter "L&LMD No. 89-1-C") pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (hereinafter the "Act"), which is Part 2 (commencing with Section 22500) of Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code (hereinafter the "Street and Highways Code"), and ordering the preparation of a report (hereinafter the "Report") regarding the proposed annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97 and the assessments to be levied within Street Lighting Zone 97 each fiscal year beginning fiscal year 2010-11 for providing electricity for streetlights within the public right-of-way within said Zone; and

WHEREAS, such proceedings shall comply with the requirements of Article XIIID of the California Constitution (hereinafter "Article XIIID:"), the Act, and Section 4000 of the Elections Code requiring voter approval of the proposed assessment to be levied by L&LMD No. 89-1-C for Street Lighting Zone 97; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors by Resolution No. 2009-306 directed the Director of the Transportation Department, or his designee (hereinafter the "Engineer"), to prepare and file the Report

with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in accordance with Sections 22608 and 22585 et. seq. of the Street and Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIIID; and

WHEREAS, said Engineer has filed the Report with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and the Report has been presented to and considered by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the sole owner of property within the proposed boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 97 as the applicant (the "Applicant") for these proceedings has executed a "Waiver and Consent Regarding Date of Assessment Ballot Election" allowing for the election to be held on January 12, 2010; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution of intention pursuant to Section 22624 of the Streets and Highways Code, which fixes and gives notice, pursuant to Section 22626 of the Streets and Highways Code, of the time and place of a public hearing on said Report, the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97, and the assessments to be levied on parcels within Street Lighting Zone 97 beginning in fiscal year 2010-11;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors in regular session assembled on November 24, 2009 as follows:

Section 1. Findings. The Board of Supervisors, after reviewing the Report, finds that:

- (a) The foregoing recitals are true and correct;
- (b) The Report contains all matters required by Sections 22565 through 22574 of the Streets and Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIIID and may, therefore, be approved by the Board of Supervisors;
- (c) The annual assessment for fiscal year 2010-11 on all parcels within Street Lighting Zone 97 proposed to be annexed to L&LMD No. 89-1-C will be \$184.36 per acre.

Section 2. Intent. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares its intention to order the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97, as described and shown in Exhibit "A", to L&LMD No. 89-1-C, and to levy and collect an annual assessment on all assessable lots and parcels of property within Street Lighting Zone 97 commencing with the fiscal year 2010-11 as set forth in the Report. The Report

expressly states that there are no parcels or lots within Street Lighting Zone 97 that are owned by a federal, state or other local governmental agency that will benefit from the services to be financed by the annual assessments. The annual assessments will be collected at the same time and in the same manner as property taxes are collected, and all laws providing for the collection and enforcement of property taxes shall apply to the collection and enforcement of said assessments.

Section 3. <u>Boundaries.</u> All the property within boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 97 is proposed to be annexed into L&LMD No. 89-1-C and shall include that property in the unincorporated area of the County as described and shown in Exhibit "A".

Section 4. <u>Description of Services to be Provided.</u> The service authorized for Street Lighting Zone 97 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C is the provision of electricity to all streetlights within the public right-of-way including incidental costs and expenses.

Section 5. Amount to be Levied. The assessment to be levied upon each parcel that benefits from the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C will be \$184.36 per acre for fiscal year 2010-11. As stated in the Report, the total budget for Street Lighting Zone 97 for the fiscal year 2010-11 is \$330; there are 3 parcel(s) that are to be assessed that aggregate to 1.79 acre(s). The annual assessment will be increased by the greater of two percent (2.0%) or the cumulative percentage increase, if any, in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers for "electricity" ("CPI-U") for the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County California Standard Metropolitan Statistical area ("Index") published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor. The annual CPI-U adjustment will be based on the cumulative increase, if any, in the Index as it stands on March of each year over the base Index for March of 2009. Any increase larger than the greater of 2.0% or the CPI-U annual adjustment requires a majority approval of all the property owners within Street Lighting Zone 97. The Board of Supervisors will levy the assessment in each subsequent fiscal year until the Board of Supervisors undertakes proceedings for the dissolution of Street Lighting Zone 97 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C. The annual assessment will fund the services described in Section 4 of

this Resolution. For further particulars, reference is to be made to the Report on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

Section 6. The Property to be Annexed. The property to be annexed into L&LMD No. 89-1-C is Street Lighting Zone 97. The boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 97 are located within the unincorporated area of the County and are described and shown in the Report and Exhibit "A".

Section 7. Report. The Report, which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and which has been presented to the Board of Supervisors, is hereby approved. Reference is made to the Report for a full and detailed description of the services, the boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 97, and the annual assessment to be levied upon assessable lots and parcels within Street Lighting Zone 97 proposed to be annexed to L&LMD No. 89-1-C.





NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors in regular session assembled on November 24, 2009 as follows:

Section 1. Findings. The Board of Supervisors, after reviewing the Report, finds that:

(b) The Report contains all matters required by Sections 22565 through 22574 of the Streets and Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIIID and may, therefore, be approved by the Board of Supervisors;

(c) The annual assessment for fiscal year 2010-11 on all parcels within Street Lighting Zone 97 proposed to be annexed to L&LMD No. 89 1 C will be \$184.36 per acre.

Section 2. Intent. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares its infention to order the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97, as described and shown in Exhibit "At, to L&LMD No. 89 1 C, and to levy and collect an annual assessment on all assessable lots and parcels of property within Street Lighting Zone 97 commencing with the fiscal year 2010-11 as set forth in the Report. The Report expressly states that there are no parcels or lots within Street Lighting Zone 97 that are owned by a federal, state or other local governmental agency that will benefit from the services to be financed by the annual assessments. The annual assessments will be collected at the same time and in the same manner as property taxes are collected, and all lows providing for the collection and enforcement of property taxes shall apply to the collection

tion and enforcement of said assessments.

Section 3. Boundaries. All the property within bound-

tion and enforcement of said assessments.

Section 3. Boundaries.All the property within boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 97 is proposed to be annexed into L&L.MD No. 89 1 C and shall include that property in the unincorporated area of the County as described and shown in Exhibit 'A'.

Section 4. Description of Services to be Provided. The service authorized for Street Lighting Zone 97 of L&L.MD No. 89 1 C is the provision of electricity to all streetlights within the public right-of-way including incidental costs and expenses.

Section 5. Amount to be Levied. The assessment to be levied upon each parcel that benefits from the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97 of L&L.MD No. 89 1 C will be \$184.36 per acre for fiscal year 2010-11. As stated in the Report, the total budget for Street Lighting Zone 97 for the fiscal year 2010-11 is \$330; there are 3 parcel(s) that are to be assessed that aggregate to 1.79 acre(s). The annual assessment will be increased by the greater of two percent (2.0%) or the cumulative percentage increase, if any, in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers for "electricity" ("CPI U") for the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County Colifornia Standard Metropolitan Statistical area ("Index") published by the Bureau of Labor. The annual CPI U adjustment will be based on the cumulative increase, if any, in the loak sait stands on March of each year over the base Index for March of 2009. Any increase larger than the greater of 2.0% or the CPI U annual adjustment requires a majority approval of all the property owners within Street Lighting Zone 97. The Board of Supervisors will levy the assessment in each subsequent fiscal year until the Board of Supervisors undertakes proceedings for the dissolution of Street Lighting Zone 97. Section 8. Public Hearing. The question of whether Street Lighting Zone 97 shall be annexed into L&LMD No. 89 1 C and an annual assessment levied beginning with fiscal year 2010-11 shall be considered at a public hearing (hereinafter the "Public Hearing") to be held on January 12, 2010, at 9:30 s.m. at the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors of the County at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, Colifornia.

Section 9. Majority Profest, Each owner of record of properly within Street Lighting Zone 97 is to receive by mail an assessment ballot that shall conform to the requirements of Section 4 of Article XIIID and Section 400 of the Colifornia Elections Code. The assessment bollots are to be returned prior to the Public Hearing. L&LMD No. 89 1 C shall not impose assessments on property within the boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 97 if there is a majority protest with regard to the annexation of Street Lighting Zone 97. A majority protest exists if, upon the conclusion of the Public Hearing, the tabulation of the assessment ballots submitted in opposition to the annexation and assessment of Street Lighting Zone 97. Section 10. Information. Any property owner desiring additional information regarding Street Lighting Zone 97 of L&LMD No. 89 1 C shall be given consistent with Section 26262 of the Streets and Highways Code and Section 40 of Artice XIIID.
