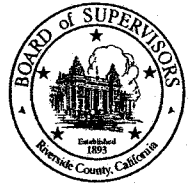





Appointment to the Children and Families Commission

BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:

On June 9, 2009 the Board of Supervisors amended the membership section (Section 5, subsection B.) of Ordinance 784 to reflect the appointment of six Commissioners and six Alternate Commissioners. Each member of the Board of Supervisors is to appoint one Commissioner and one alternate with the sixth being an At-Large appointment by the entire Board. These appointments are in addition to those of a member of the Board of Supervisors, the County Health Officer, and an individual responsible for the management of one of several enumerated County functions. The Alternate Commissioners will also serve as Advisory Committee members, in compliance with Proposition 10 statutes.

The Ordinance specifies the qualifications for appointment, which includes a representative of a Local Organization for Prevention or Early Intervention for Families at Risk in Riverside County. Lorie Nicholson is a probation officer with the County Probation Department and in that capacity works closely with at-risk youth and families and as such, she recognizes the importance of early intervention program such as those funded by First 5. In addition, as a mother of a one-year old daughter, she also appreciates the issues facing parents with children ages 0 to 5. Ms. Nicholson's commitment to serving children and families will be a tremendous asset to the Riverside County Children and Families Commission. Ms. Nicholson will serve as an Alternate to Commissioner Lupe Ramos-Watson.
