

**BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:**

On June 9, 2009 the Board of Supervisors amended the membership section (Section 5, subsection B.) of Ordinance 784 to reflect the appointment of six Commissioners and six Alternate Commissioners. Each member of the Board of Supervisors is to appoint one Commissioner and one alternate with the sixth being an At-Large appointment by the entire Board. These appointments are in addition to those of a member of the Board of Supervisors, the County Health Officer, and an individual responsible for the management of one of several enumerated County functions. The Alternate Commissioners will also serve as Advisory Committee members, in compliance with Proposition 10 statutes.

The Ordinance specifies the qualifications for appointment, which includes an Educator Specializing in Early Childhood Development in Riverside County. Ms. Georgann Koenig taught early childhood education for local colleges, provided consultation services for early childhood education and served for 18 years as the Director of the San Geronio Child Care Consortium. In addition, Ms. Koenig was recognized by Prevent Child Abuse Riverside County for her work in fostering inclusive settings for children with special needs and has served on the First 5 Riverside Advisory Committee since 2001. Ms. Koenig's wealth of experience will be a tremendous asset to the Riverside County Children and Families Commission. Ms. Koenig will serve as an Alternate to Commissioner Sharon Baskett.
