Appointment to Riverside County Children & Families Commission January 26, 2010

The Ordinance specifies the qualifications for appointment, which includes a representative of Educators Specializing in Early Childhood Development in Riverside County. Dr. Stephen Morford is presently retired, but previously spent 36 years working in public education including 29 years as an administrator of special education programs. Immediately prior to his retirement, Dr. Morford served as Special Education Local Plan Area (SELPA) Director for the Riverside Unified School District.
