- (3) If the owner or whoever has possession or control of the real property does not take the above described action within ninety (90) days of the date of the Board's Order to Abate, that representatives of the Code Enforcement Department, Sheriff's Department, and/or a contractor, upon consent of the owner or receipt of a Court Order authorizing entry onto the real property, when necessary under applicable law, shall abate the accumulation of rubbish by removing and disposing of the same from the real property.
- (4) The reasonable cost of abatement, after notice and an opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on the real property, which may be collected as a special assessment against the real property pursuant to Government Code Section 25845 and Riverside County Ordinance No. 725.
- (5) County Counsel be directed to prepare the necessary Findings of Facts and Conclusions that the accumulation of rubbish on the real property is declared to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541, and a public nuisance, and further, to prepare an Order to Abate for approval by the Board.

JUSTIFICATION:

- 1. An initial inspection was made of the subject real property by the Code Enforcement Officers on June 30, 2009. The inspection revealed the accumulation of rubbish on the subject property in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541. The rubbish consisted of, but was not limited to: scrap wood, old furniture, trash, green waste, tires, and old clothes. There is approximately 150 tires on the property. The total square footage of rubbish on the property is 27,950, as measured by pace and fence post methods.
- 2. A subsequent inspection of the above-described real property on September 24, 2009 and December 30, 2009 revealed the property continues to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541.
- 3. Staff and the Code Enforcement Department have complied with the requirements set forth in the appropriate laws of this jurisdiction pertaining to the administrative abatement proceedings for the removal of accumulated rubbish.

DECLARATION OF CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER JENNIFER MORRIS

[R.C.O. No. 541 (RCC Title 8.120)]

I, Jennifer Morris, declare that the facts set forth below are personally known to me except to the extent that certain information is based on information and belief which I believe to be true, and if called as a witness, I could and would competently testify thereto under oath:

- 1. I am currently employed by the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department as a Code Enforcement Officer. My current official duties as a Code Enforcement Officer include inspecting property for violations and enforcement of the provisions of Riverside County Ordinances.
- 2. I am informed and believe and thereon allege that on June 30, 2009, Code Enforcement Officer Richard Arriola conducted an initial inspection of the real property described as 22841 Fisher Street, Perris, Riverside County, California and further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 325-200-042 (hereinafter referred to as "THE PROPERTY"). A true and correct copy of a Thomas Brothers map indicating the location of THE PROPERTY is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.
- 3. A review of County records and documents disclosed that THE PROPERTY was owned by Rita Nauta Alig (hereinafter referred to as the "OWNER"). Certified copies of the County Equalized Assessment Roll for the year 2008-2009 and County Geographic Information System ("GIS") report is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein by reference.
- 4. Based on the Lot Book Report from RZ Title Service on July 2, 2009, it is determined that additional parties may potentially hold a legal interest in THE PROPERTY, to wit: Scott Edward Darling, Eastern Municipal Water District, and Alice Beasley (hereinafter collectively referred to as "INTERESTED PARTIES"). True and correct copies of the Lot Book Reports are attached hereto as Exhibit "C" and incorporated herein by this reference.

5. I am informed and believe and thereon allege that on June 30, 2009, Code Enforcement Officer Richard Arriola conducted an initial inspection of THE PROPERTY. Officer Arriola observed THE PROPERTY to be unimproved and abandoned. After breaking the lock at the front gate pursuant to an inspection warrant, he entered onto THE PROPERTY and observed accumulation of rubbish throughout THE PROPERTY consisting of but not limited to: scrap wood, old furniture, trash, green waste, tires, and old clothes. Officer Arriola took measurements of the areas using the pacing method and the fence post method. The following is a summary of the measured areas.

- (a) Area #1 measured twenty-five (25) feet by thirty (30) feet, totaling seven hundred and fifty (750) square feet.
- (b) Area #2 measured seventy (70) feet by two hundred (200) feet, totaling fourteen thousand (14,000) square feet.
- (c) Area #3 measured ninety (90) feet by one hundred and twenty (120) feet, totaling ten thousand and eight hundred (10,800) square feet.
- (d) Area #4 measured thirty (30) feet by eighty (80) feet, totaling two thousand four hundred (2,400) square feet.

Based on his training and experience, he determined that the amount of accumulated rubbish on THE PROPERTY totaled twenty-seven thousand nine hundred fifty (27,950) square feet. He posted a Notice of Violation on THE PROPERTY.

- 6. As a result of the accumulation of rubbish, THE PROPERTY constituted a public nuisance in violation of the provisions set forth in Riverside County Ordinance No. 541, as codified in Riverside County Code Title 8.120.
- 7. A site plan and photographs of THE PROPERTY are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "D."
- 8. True and correct copies of each Notice issued in this matter and other supporting documentation are attached hereto as Exhibit "E" and incorporated herein by reference.
- 9. On July 27, 2009 a Notice of Violation was mailed to OWNER by certified mail with return receipt requested. On July 27, 2009 a Notice of Violation was mailed to INTERESTED PARTIES by certified mail with return receipt requested.

- 10. On September 24, 2009, I conducted a follow-up inspection of THE PROPERTY. I entered THE PROPERTY to make contact and found it was vacant and unoccupied. THE PROPERTY was open, with No Trespassing signs directed at illegal dumpers. I observed the parcel remained covered in rubbish, thus remaining in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541.
- 11. Based upon my experience, knowledge and visual observations, it is my determination that the conditions on THE PROPERTY are dangerous to the neighboring property owners and the general public.
- 15. A Notice of Noncompliance regarding the accumulation of rubbish was recorded in the Office of the Assessor, County Clerk & Recorder, County of Riverside, State of California, on July 28, 2009, as Instrument Number 2009-0400310. A true and correct copy of the notice is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "F".
- 16. On December 30, 2009 the second notice, "Notice to Abate Public Nuisance" providing notification of the Board of Supervisors' hearing scheduled for January 26, 2009, was mailed to OWNER and INTERESTED PARTIES by certified mail, return receipt requested and on December 30, 2009 was posted on THE PROPERTY. True and correct copies of the notice and supporting documentation are attached hereto as Exhibit "G" and incorporated herein by reference.
- 17. A follow-up inspection on December 30, 2009 revealed that THE PROPERTY remains in violation.
- 18. Removal of the accumulation of rubbish on THE PROPERTY is required to bring THE PROPERTY into compliance with Riverside County Ordinance No. 541 (RCC Chapter 8.120) and the Health and Safety Code. Under RCO No. 541, no amount of rubbish is allowed to accumulate on THE PROPERTY.
- 19. The Board of Supervisors is requested to issue an Order to Abate the Nuisance described herein. Accordingly, the following findings and conclusions are recommended:
- (a) the accumulation of rubbish on THE PROPERTY to be deemed and declared a public nuisance;
- (b) the OWNER and person(s) in possession of THE PROPERTY be required to remove all accumulated rubbish within ten (10) days of the date of the posting and mailing of the

Board's Order to Abate Nuisance, in accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to the provisions of County Ordinance No. 541;

- (c) in the event the rubbish is not removed and disposed of according to the above referenced ninety (90) day time period in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 541 (RCC Chapter 8.120), the rubbish shall be abated by representatives of the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department, a contractor or the Sheriff's Department; and
- (d) reasonable costs of abatement, after notice and opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on THE PROPERTY, which may be collected as a special assessment against THE PROPERTY pursuant to Government Code Section 25845 and Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 541 (RCC Title 8.120) and 725 (RCC Title 1).



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




