BACKGROUND:

On July 14, 2009, the County Board of Supervisors approved a loan agreement for the use of Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) funds with Inspire Life Skills Training, Inc. (Inspire), a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, in the amount up to \$330,000 (NSP Loan Agreement) for acquisition and rehabilitation of one (1) vacant, foreclosed and bank-owned single-family property (Property) within the NSP Target Area inside the city of Norco and rent to very low-income (VLI) households (Project).

Under the terms and conditions of the NSP Loan Agreement, Inspire has not acquired the desired eligible Property in accordance to the established timeline due to the lack of available eligible foreclosed properties in the NSP target area.

Pursuant to Section 38 of the NSP Loan Agreement, in the event that Inspire does not perform, the County may terminate the NSP Loan Agreement and will not be obligated to make further reimbursement to Inspire.

The County and Inspire mutually desire to terminate the NSP Loan Agreement and NSP funds will be re-allocated for eligible NSP activities.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved as to form the attached Termination Agreement. Staff recommends that the Board approve the attached Termination Agreement.

5 This termination agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into on this
6 9th day of FEB, 2009, (the "Effective Date") by and between the County of
7 Riverside ("COUNTY") and Inspire Life Skills Training, Inc. ("INSPIRE").

8 **W I T N E S S E T H**

9 **WHEREAS**, on July 14, 2009, COUNTY and INSPIRE entered into a Loan Agreement
10 for the use of Neighborhood Stabilization Program ("NSP") Funds (the "NSP Loan
11 Agreement"); and

12 **WHEREAS**, under the terms and conditions of the NSP Loan Agreement, COUNTY
13 agreed to lend NSP Funds to INSPIRE in the amount up to \$330,000 for acquisition and
14 rehabilitation of one (1) vacant, foreclosed and bank-owned single-family property ("Property")
15 within the NSP Target Area inside the city of Norco and rent to very low-income ("VLI")
16 households (the "Project"); and

17 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 28, Performance Requirements, of the NSP Loan
18 Agreement, INSPIRE has not acquired the desired eligible Property in accordance to the
19 established timeline due to the lack of available eligible foreclosed properties in the NSP target
20 area; and

21 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 38, Termination, of the NSP Loan Agreement, in the
22 event that INSPIRE does not perform, COUNTY may terminate the NSP Loan Agreement and
23 will not be obligated to make further reimbursement to INSPIRE; and

24 **WHEREAS**, no funds were disbursed to INSPIRE; and

25 **WHEREAS**, INSPIRE is waiving its right to notice and cure set forth in Section 32 of
26 the NSP Loan Agreement; and

27 **WHEREAS**, COUNTY and INSPIRE mutually desire to terminate the NSP Loan
28 Agreement and NSP funds will be re-allocated for eligible NSP activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the preceding promises and the mutual

covenants and agreements hereinafter contained, the parties hereto do hereby agree as follows:

SECTION 1: The NSP Loan Agreement between COUNTY and INSPIRE is terminated as of the Effective Date of this Agreement.
