SUBJECT: Proposed Amendment to County Ordinance 849 Relating to the Approval of the Cost of Support for Minors in Detention and Treatment Facilities.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Introduce and Set for Public Hearing the Proposed Ordinance 849.1 Amending Ordinance 849. Relating to the Fee Schedule for services rendered by the Probation Department as outlined in Attachment ASIL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
- 2. Upon the Close of the Public Hearing, Adopt Ordinance 849.1 Amending Ordinance 849.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with Board of Supervisors Policy Number B-4, County Departments may evaluate existing rates for services on an annual basis and make recommendations for changes. Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC) Section 903 authorizes the County to collect the cost of support for a minor detained or placed in a juvenile institution or other place from the minor's parents or other parents liable for the minor's support. The costs eligible for recovery are limited to the un-reimbursed cost incurred by the County for food and food preparation, clothing, personal supplies, and medical expenses.

Ordinance 849 was last amended on January 14, 2006, Agenda Item 9.5, to establish a fee of \$15.28	3 for
housing minors in detention and treatment facilities. Per WIC, the maximum allowable cost is \$30	per
day as of 2009 with an adjusted inflation rate every 3 years based on the California Consumer P	rice
Index (CPI)	11.5%

As such, based on this provision, the calculated rate is \$30.00 per day. According to the department's review and analysis of the FY2008/09 actual expenditures, the proposed fees reflect full cost recovery for allowable costs incurred in all detention/treatment facilities. The appropriate updated billing rates are in accordance with the associated legal authority.

In addition, the cost of housing minors in the California Division of Justice Juvenile (DJJ) facilities, formerly known as the California Youth Authority (CYA), is also included in Ordinance 849. Those fees are updated each year by the State. The DJJ fees are charged directly to the County. The County then collects those fees from the minors to recover the payment to DJJ. With the implementation of the Youthful Offender Program (YOP) in 2007, the Probation Department has seen a 117% decrease in the fees charged by DJJ from \$717,099 in FY 2007/08 to \$329,350 in FY 2008/09. Savings from this program have assisted the department in offsetting the reduction in other funding sources. The proposed fees are summarized on Attachment 1, Section II.

The fee for clothing allowance for other court ordered placement shall remain the same.

FINANCIAL DATA

These proposed rates have been reviewed by the Auditor-Controller's Office and approved as to form by County Counsel in accordance with the Board of Supervisors Policy B-4. If approved, the fee adjustments will result in an increase in revenue. The department anticipates a minimal increase in FY 2009/10 and no budget adjustment will be required at this time.
