

BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:



Each member of the Board of Supervisors is to appoint one Commissioner and one alternate with the sixth being an At-Large appointment by the entire Board. These appointments are in addition to those of a member of the Board of Supervisors, the County Health Officer, and an individual responsible for the management of one of several enumerated County functions.

The Ordinance specifies the qualifications for appointment, which includes a representative of a Local School District in Riverside County. Mr. Hoffman is the Superintendent of the Nuview School District, a position he has held since July 1997. Prior to this position, Mr. Hoffman also served as Assistant Superintendent with the Temecula Valley Unified School District and was previously an elementary school principal and assistant principal. Mr. Hoffman was instrumental in implementing a Preschool-for-All pilot and school readiness programs at Nuview Elementary School and committed to inclusion of preschool and quality child care programs as part of the school district programs. Mr. Hoffman was also instrumental in the development of the Pediatric Dental Clinic that opened this year in Nuview and was named in his honor. Mr. Hoffman has served on the Riverside County Children and Families Commission since June 2007 and will continue to be a tremendous asset to the Commission.
