
SUBJECT: Fifth District Use of Community Improvement Designation Funds

Increase Appropriations: 20200-3100 200000-525440	Professional Services	\$10,000


BACKGROUND: In an effort to stimulate the local economy, the County has taken aggressive action to reduce our Development Impact Fees (DIF) and Western County Transportation Uniform Mitigation Fees (TUMF). It is important for the County to understand its competitive position by comparing our DIF fees against other cities and counties within the Inland Empire. This contribution will allow TLMA to contract with Development Research to perform the DIF comparison analysis and provide feedback to this board.
