

FIRST AMENDMENT TO MASTER AGREEMENT FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AND SAFETY LIGHTING (CONTRACT NO. 94-08-06)

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO MASTER AGREEMENT FOR MAINENANCE AND OPERATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AND SAFETY LIGHTING ("First Amendment") is made and entered into this __________, 2010("Effective Date"), by and between the CITY OF RIVERSIDE ("City"), a California charter city and municipal corporation, and the COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, a public entity ("County").

WHEREAS, on June 6, 1995, City and County entered into that certain Master Agreement for Maintenance and Operation of Traffic Signals and Safety Lighting ("Master Agreement") to provide for the maintenance and operation of existing and future signal systems at intersections located with the boundaries of both the City of Riverside and the County of Riverside; and

WHEREAS, City and County desire to amend the Master Agreement to update the Intersection Schedule attached thereto to accurately identify the intersections presently maintained by the parties and their proportional share of the costs associated therewith;

NOWTHEREFORE, in consideration of the forgoing recitals which are incorporated herein by their reference, City and County agree as follows:

- The Master Agreement is hereby amended to include the attached Intersection Schedule effective August 1, 2009.
- 2. All terms and conditions of the Master Agreement for Maintenance and Operation of Traffic Signals and Safety Lighting, not inconsistent herewith, shall remain in full force and effect and are hereby incorporated by reference into this First Amendment to Master Agreement as though set forth in full herein.
