RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board accept the low bid of S&S Grading & Paving, Inc. of Norco, CA in the amount of \$162,269. Award the contract to that firm and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents.

BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated November 24, 2009 (agenda item 3.112) the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of raised median improvements on Camino Real from Mission Boulevard to Avenida Baja/River Glen Drive, in the Rubidoux area. Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, December 16, 2009. Ten bids were received. The Transportation Department's established basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and

responsible bid for all schedules of work. The lowest bid was submitted by S&S Grading & Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$162,269. The total bid price, submitted by S&S Grading & Paving, Inc. is \$47,131 (22.51%) below the Engineer's Estimate. The project costs are within the project budget as shown on Attachment "A".

The proposed improvements will replace the interim asphalt concrete berms with concrete curbs, and install decorative concrete pavers and cobblestones within the median.

Construction of concrete raised median on Camino Real will be funded by the Redevelopment Agency (RDA) through a cooperative agreement with the County that is submitted to the Board of Supervisors for execution concurrent with this submittal.

The RDA will add irrigation and planting to the median as part of a separate contract to construct the Jurupa Valley Aquatic Center. The median hardscape and landscape will be maintained by the Riverside County Parks and Open Space District, which will be operating and maintaining the Jurupa Valley Aquatic Center.

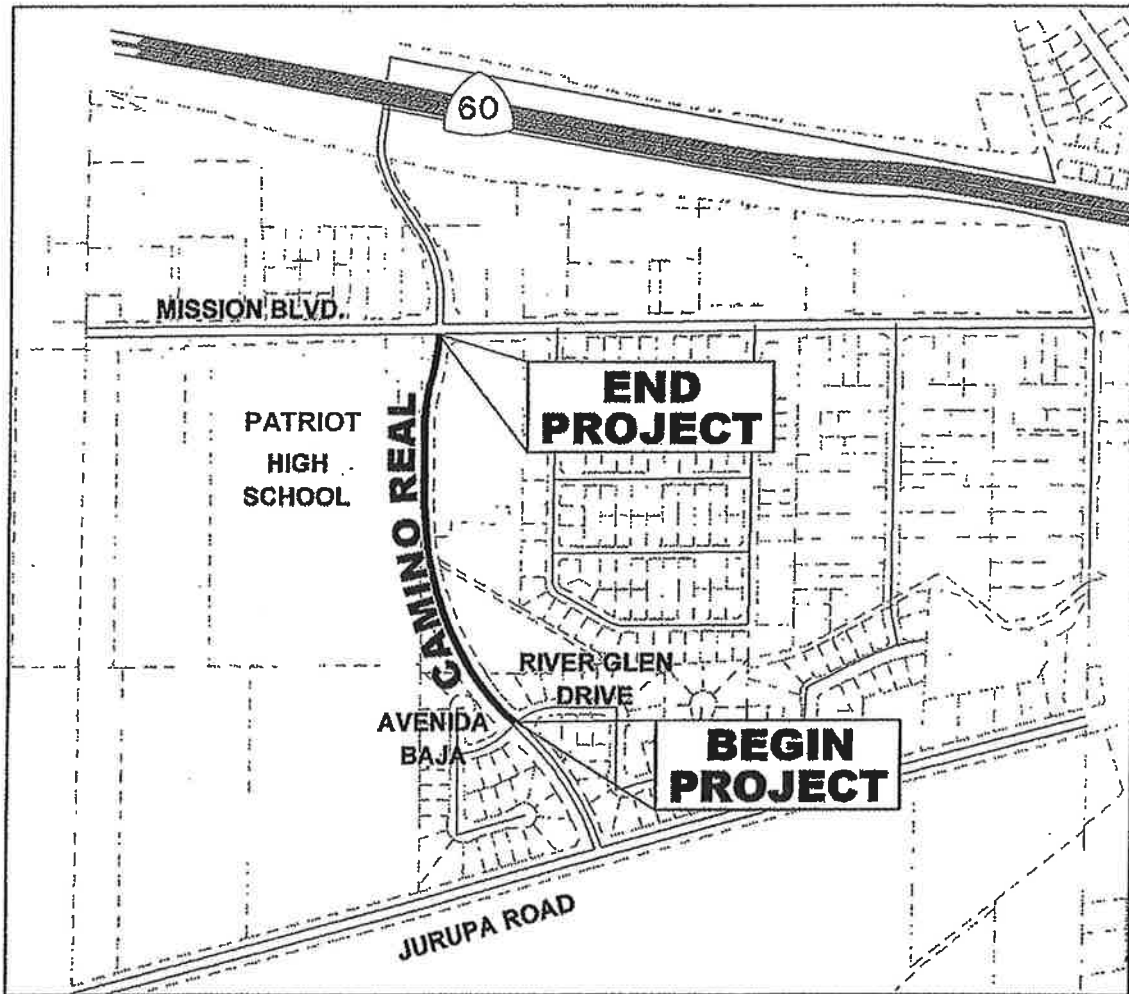
