- If the owner of the real property does not take the above described action within ninety (90) days of the date of the Board's Order to Abate, that representatives of the Code Enforcement Department, Sheriff's Department, and/or a contractor, upon consent or receipt of a Court Order authorizing entry onto the real property when necessary under applicable law, shall abate the excess outside storage and accumulation of rubbish by removing and disposing of the same from the real property.
- 4. The reasonable costs of abatement, after notice and an opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on the real property, which may be collected as a special assessment against the real property pursuant to Government Code Section 25845 and Riverside County Ordinance No. 725.
- 5. County Counsel be directed to prepare the necessary Findings of Fact and Conclusions that the excess outside storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish on the real property is declared to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541, and a public nuisance, and further, to prepare an Order to Abate for approval by the Board.

## JUSTIFICATION:

- 1. An initial inspection was made of the subject property by the Code Enforcement Officer on April 21, 2009.
- The inspection revealed the excess outside storage of materials and an accumulation of rubbish on the subject property in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541. The items included but were not limited to: bikes, a barbecue, old furniture, mattresses, household trash, scrap wood, a travel trailer, tires, tools, bins, boxes, and miscellaneous debris.
- 3. Subsequent follow up inspections of the above-described real property on September 1, 2009, October 23, 2009 and February 16, 2010 revealed that the property continued to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541.
- 4. Staff and the Code Enforcement Department have complied with the notice requirements set forth in the appropriate laws of this jurisdiction pertaining to the administrative abatement proceedings for the removal of excess outside storage and accumulated rubbish.

DECLARATION OF OFFICER CYNTHIA BLACK

[R.C.O. NO. 348, R.C.C. Chapter 17, R.C.O. NO. 541, R.C.C. Chapter 8.120]

I, Cynthia Black, hereby affirm and declare that the facts set forth below are personally known to me except to the extent that certain information is based on information and belief which I believe to be true, and if called as a witness, I could and would competently testify thereto under oath:

- 1. I am currently employed by the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department as a Supervising Code Enforcement Officer. My current official duties as a Supervising Code Enforcement Officer include inspecting property for violations and enforcement of the provisions of Riverside County Ordinances.
- 2. I am informed and believe and thereon allege that on April 21, 2009, Code Enforcement Officer Arriola conducted an initial inspection of the real property described as 22163 San Jacinto Avenue, Perris, Riverside County, California and further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 325-100-006 (hereinafter referred to as "THE PROPERTY"). A true and correct copy of a Thomas Brothers map indicating the location of THE PROPERTY is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
- 3. A review of County records and documents disclosed that THE PROPERTY is owned by Jean Coleman (hereinafter referred to as "OWNER"). A certified copy of the County Equalized Assessment Roll for the year 2009-2010 and a copy of the report generated from the County Geographic Information System ("GIS") is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "B." THE PROPERTY is located within the R-R (Rural Residential) zone classification. This zone classification allows outside storage on an improved parcel with the amount of storage to be two hundred (200) square feet for properties that are a minimum of one acre in size. The unimproved property is approximately 2.35 acres.

- 4. Based upon the Lot Book Reports issued by RZ Title Service on May 7, 2009 and updated on November 4, 2009, it is determined that other parties potentially hold a legal interest in THE PROPERTY, to wit: Craig Fay, Robert Wilson and Eastern Municipal Water District (hereinafter referred to as "INTERESTED PARTIES"). True and correct copies of the Lot Book Report are attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "C."
- 5. I am informed and believe and thereon allege that on April 21, 2009, Officer Arriola drove to THE PROPERTY for a scheduled inspection. At THE PROPERTY, Officer Arriola made contact with OWNER and her daughter who gave him permission to inspect. Officer Arriola observed excess outside storage and accumulated rubbish on THE PROPERTY. Using the pacing method, Officer Arriola determined the amount of outside storage of materials and accumulated rubbish to be approximately seven thousand one hundred (7,100) square feet. The outside storage of materials and accumulated rubbish were intermingled and consisted of but was not limited to: bikes, a barbecue, old furniture, mattresses, household trash, scrap wood, a travel trailer, tires, tools, bins, boxes and other miscellaneous debris.
- 6. As a result of the excess outside storage of materials and accumulated rubbish, THE PROPERTY constituted a public nuisance in violation of the provisions set forth in Riverside County Ordinance ("RCO") No. 348 as codified in Riverside County Code ("RCC") Chapter 17.16 and RCO No. 541, as codified in RCC Chapter 8.120.
- 7. On April 21, 2009, Notices of Violation for the excess outside storage of materials and accumulated rubbish were posted on THE PROPERTY.
- 8. On July 28, 2009, Notices of Violation were mailed to the OWNER and INTERESTED PARTY by certified mail with return receipt requested.
- 9. On September 1, 2009, I conducted a scheduled follow-up inspection with Supervising Code Enforcement Officer Overholt. We met with OWNER who granted us permission to inspect THE PROPERTY. I observed that THE PROPERTY remained in violation of RCO 348 (RCC Chapter 17.16) and 541 (RCC Chapter 8.120).
- 10. On October 23, 2009, I conducted another follow-up inspection on THE PROPERTY that revealed the excess outside storage and accumulated rubbish remained on THE DECLARATION OF CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER 2

PROPERTY in violation of RCO 348 (RCC Chapter 17.16) and 541 (RCC Chapter 8.120).

- 11. A site plan and photographs depicting the condition of THE PROPERTY during the above referenced inspections are attached hereto as Exhibit "D" and incorporated herein by reference.
- 12. True and correct copies of each Notice issued in this matter and other supporting documentation are attached hereto as Exhibit "E" and incorporated herein by reference
- 13. Based upon my experience, knowledge and visual observations, it is my determination that the conditions on THE PROPERTY are dangerous to the neighboring property owner and the general public.
- 14. I am informed and believe and based upon said information and belief alleges that the OWNER and INTERESTED PARTIES do not have legal authority or permission to store or accumulate the above described materials on THE PROPERTY.
- 15. A Notice of Non-Compliance was recorded in the Office of the County Recorder, County of Riverside, State of California, on October 6, 2009 as Instrument Number 2009-0518218, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "F".
- 16. On February 16, 2010, I conducted a follow-up inspection on THE PROPERTY that revealed the excess outside storage and accumulated rubbish remained on THE PROPERTY in violation of RCO 348 (RCC Chapter 17.16) and 541 (RCC Chapter 8.120).
- 17. On February 10, 2010, the second notice "Notice to Correct County Ordinance Violations and Abate Public Nuisance" providing notification of the Board of Supervisors' hearing scheduled for March 16, 2010, as required by Riverside County Ordinance No. 725, was mailed to THE OWNER and INTERESTED PARTIES by certified mail, return receipt requested and on February 16, 2010, was posted on THE PROPERTY. True and correct copies of the notice, returned receipt cards, together with the proof of service, and the affidavit of posting of notices are attached hereto as Exhibit "G" and incorporated herein by reference.
- 18. The removal of all outside storage of materials and the removal of accumulated rubbish currently on THE PROPERTY is required to bring THE PROPERTY into compliance with Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348, 541 and the <u>Health and Safety Code</u>. Given the size of the parcel and the zoning classification, no amount of outside storage is allowed on THE PROPERTY under RCO No.



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



The above-captioned matter came on regularly for hearing on November 23, 2004, before the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California in the Board Room, First Floor Annex, County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California regarding the real property described as 22163 San Jacinto Avenue, Perris, APN: 325-100-006 and referred to hereinafter as "THE PROPERTY."

Monica R. Romero, Deputy County Counsel, appeared along with Jim Monroe, Principal Code Enforcement Officer, on behalf of the Director of the Department of Building and Safety.

No one appeared on behalf of owner.

The Board of Supervisors received the Declaration of the Code Enforcement Officer together with attached Exhibits evidencing the excessive outside storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish on THE PROPERTY as a public nuisance and violations of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541 as codified in Riverside County Code Titles 17.16 and 8.120.

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FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS AND ORDER TO ABATE NUISANCE

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## SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

- Documents of record in the Riverside County Recorder's Office identify the owner 1. of THE PROPERTY as Jean Coleman. ("OWNER").
- Documents of title at the time of the inspection indicated that other parties potentially hold a legal interest in THE PROPERTY, to-wit: Robert Wilson ("INTERESTED PARTY").
- THE PROPERTY has been inspected by Code Enforcement Officers February 10, 3. August 19, November 19 and 21, 2003, March 2 and November 19, 2004.
- During each inspection, outside storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish were observed on THE PROPERTY. The materials included but were not limited to: scrap wood, scrap metal, metal barrels, furniture, tires, furniture, appliances, a bicycle, and miscellaneous household trash and debris. On November 19, 2003, the total area of outside storage and/or rubbish was approximately thirteen thousand seven hundred sixty (13,760) square feet.
- THE PROPERTY was determined to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 (RCC Title 17.16) and 541 (RCC Title 8.120) by the Code Enforcement Officer.
- A Notice of Noncompliance was recorded on August 27, 2003 as Document Number 660285, in the Office of the County Recorder, County of Riverside.
- On November 19, 2003, a Notice of Violation for Violation of RCO Nos. 348 and 541 was posted on the property and on October 8 and December 2, 2003, and January 20, 2004, Notices of Violation were mailed to the Owner and Interested Party respectively, by certified mail, return receipt requested. On January 16 and February 28, 2003, Notices of Violation were mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested and regular U.S. mail to the Owner and Interested Parties, respectively.
- On October 4, 2004, a "Notice To Abate Nuisance" providing notice of the public 8. hearing before the Board of Supervisors on November 23, 2004, was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to THE PROPERTY OWNER and INTERESTED PARTY and posted on THE PROPERTY on November 3, 2004.

## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

WHEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in

- WHEREAS, THE OWNER AND INTERESTED PARTIES ARE HEREBY 3. FUTHER NOTICED that the time within which judicial review of the administrative determinations made herein must be sought is ninety (90) days from the posting and mailing of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions and Order To Abate Nuisance, and is governed by California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.6.

## ORDER TO ABATE NUISANCE
