SUBJECT: Coachella Valley Air Quality Enhancement Trust Fund Grant Program

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the recommendations of the Coachella Valley Air Quality Advisory Committee for funding of air quality enhancement projects in the Coachella Valley, as shown on Exhibit A.
2. Direct the Executive Office to prepare contracts with the proposing agencies and authorize the County Executive Officer or his designee to sign County Counsel approved contracts for these projects.

BACKGROUND: The Executive Office administers the Coachella Valley Air Quality Enhancement Trust Fund established following a settlement with Colmac Energy, Inc. Staff solicited program proposals to improve air quality in the Coachella Valley and twelve entities submitted 20 applications for programs totaling \$819,375 for one year. The City of Palm Desert also requested \$26,000 for a second year of funding. As part of the process, the Coachella Valley Air Quality Advisory Committee (CVAQAC) reviews the proposals along with staff evaluations and makes funding recommendations to the Board of Supervisors. The committee consists of the Fourth District Supervisor, and representatives from the Coachella Valley Association of Governments and the South Coast Air Quality Management District.

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This year the annual \$275,000 funding allocation allowed staff to recommend that seventeen of the nineteen projects be partially funded at the one year request. The CVAQAC concurred with the staff recommendations and approved projects totaling \$249,000.
