RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the amendment to increase the annual aggregate to an amount not to exceed \$639,000 for the period of March 1, 2010 through June 30, 2010, and;
- 2) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the Amendment(s) with the following two Contractors: (a) Nutrition Ink and (b) CliniPro Staffing.

BACKGROUND: In March, 2006, County Purchasing on behalf of Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) issued a formal request for proposal, RFP MCARC013, to secure qualified temporary Dietetic registry services at the most economical rates. The Food and Nutrition Services Department at RCRMC has experienced difficulty with retention of qualified and Registered Dietitians in the past and continues to have vacant positions that have been classified as difficult to recruit. BACKGROUND (Continued):

In addition the impact of the mandatory furlough program has also affected the hospitals staffing issues making it more difficult to fill both Registered Dietitians and Technician positions for the department.

To ensure RCRMC meets Title XXII, Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and Joint Commission requirements for screening and assessment of the hospitalized patient's nutritional needs and as patient census continues to be high and service requirements have increased, a fully staffed team of Clinical Dietitians are needed. These temporary registry contractors provide the personnel needed to staff according to the number of hospitalized patients and the patient acuity level until vacant positions can be filled.

Although the contract aggregate amount will increase, the billing rates will remain at the same uniform rate for each contracted dietitian registry.

Therefore, RCRMC requests that the existing agreements with Nutrition Ink and CliniProStaffing be amended to increase the total aggregate amount for fiscal year 2009/2010.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The Contracts will be funded 100% under the Hospital Enterprise Funds.
