



THIRD AMENDMENT TO LEASE 623 N. Main Street, Suites D9 thru D12, Corona, California

This THIRD AMENDMENT TO LEASE ("Third Amendment") is made as of 2010 by and between the COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County"), and CJP, Ltd., a California limited partnership ("Lessor").

1. Recitals.


- a. Lessor and County entered into that certain lease dated December 8, 1998, (the "Original Lease") pursuant to which County leased a portion of that certain building located at 623 N. Main Street, Suites D9 thru D12, Corona, California (the "Building"), as more particularly shown on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof.
 - b. The Original Lease has been amended by:
- i. That certain First Amendment to Lease dated April 13, 2004, (the "First Amendment").
- ii. That certain Second Amendment to Lease dated June 5, 2007, (the "Second Amendment").
- c. The Original Lease, as heretofore, currently, or hereafter amended, shall hereafter be referred to as the "Lease".

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 2. Capitalized Terms: Third Amendment to Prevail. Unless defined herein or the context requires otherwise, all capitalized terms herein shall have the meaning defined in the Lease, as heretofore amended. The provisions of this Third Amendment shall prevail over any inconsistency or conflicting provisions of the Lease, as heretofore amended, and shall supplement the remaining provisions thereof. The Lease remains in full force and effect except to the extent amended by this Third Amendment.
- 3. Lease Term. Section 1 of the Second Amendment to Lease shall be amended as follows: The term of this Lease shall be extended thirty-six (36) months commencing on March 1, 2010 and terminating on February 28, 2013.
- **4. Rent**. County shall pay to Lessor the monthly sums as rent for the leased premises during the term of this Lease as indicated below:
