



The above-captioned matter came on regularly for hearing on January 25, 2005, before the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California in the Board Room, First Floor Annex, County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California regarding the real property described as 27530 Jackson Avenue, Romoland, Riverside County, APN 329-212-006 and referred to hereinafter as "THE PROPERTY."

Monica R. Romero, Deputy County Counsel, appeared along with Jim Monroe, Principal Code Enforcement Officer, on behalf of the Department of Building and Safety.

No one appeared on behalf of the owners of THE PROPERTY.

The Board of Supervisors received the Declaration of the Code Enforcement Officer, together with the attached Exhibits, evidencing the substandard structures, excessive storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish on THE PROPERTY as a public nuisance and violations of Riverside

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County Ordinance Nos. 457, 348 and 541 as codified in Riverside County Code Titles 15, 17 and 8.120.

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SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

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1. Documents of record in the Riverside County Recorder's Office identify the owners of THE PROPERTY as Clyde Smith and Bonnie Smith ("OWNERS").

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Documents of title indicate that other parties potentially hold a legal interest in THE

PROPERTY, to wit: Riverside County Tax Collector, Southern Idaho Production Credit Association, Southwest California Production Credit Association, United States of America - Farmers Home Administration, State of California Franchise Tax Board and Employment Development Department

Central Collection Division ("INTERESTED PARTIES").

3. THE PROPERTY was inspected by Code Enforcement Officers on September 24, November 5, December 9, 2003, March 4, April 27, May 10 and December 6, 2004.

4. During each inspection, two substandard structures (what appeared to be a former agricultural shop and machine shop warehouse) and outside storage of materials and rubbish were observed on THE PROPERTY. The structures were described as abandoned, dilapidated and vacant. The structures contained numerous deficiencies, including but not limited to: hazardous plumbing, hazardous wiring, dampness of habitable rooms, faulty weather protection, members of walls, partitions or other vertical supports that split lean, list or buckle due to fire damage, deterioration, damage and dry rot, improper maintenance, public and attractive nuisance. At the time of the inspection that was conducted on November 5, 2003, the outside storage of materials and rubbish consisted of but was not limited to: appliances, wood, auto parts, scrap metal, rusted metal, barrels, broken concrete piping, trash and various miscellaneous items and measured approximately ten thousand three hundred sixty (10,360) square feet.

5. THE PROPERTY was determined to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457, 348 and 541 (RCC Titles 15, 17 and 8.120) by the Code Enforcement Officer.

6. A Notice of Noncompliance was recorded on March 16, 2004, as Document Number 182101 in the Office of the County Recorder, County of Riverside.

7. On September 29 and November 6, 2003, Notices of Violation and Notices of Defects

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27 28 were mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested to the OWNERS and INTERESTED PARTIES.

On December 2, 2004, a Notice To Abate Nuisance providing notice of the public 8. hearing before the Board of Supervisors on January 25, 2005 was mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, to THE PROPERTY OWNERS and INTERESTED PARTIES and posted on THE PROPERTY on December 6, 2004.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

WHEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on January 25, 2005 finds and concludes that:

- WHEREAS, the substandard structures, excess outside storage of materials and rubbish on the real property located at 27530 Jackson Avenue, Romoland, Riverside County, California, also identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 329-212-006 violate Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457, 348, 541 (Riverside County Code Titles 15, 17 and 8.120) and constitute a public nuisance.
- WHEREAS, THE PROPERTY OWNERS, occupants and any person having 2. possession or control of the premises should abate the condition by razing, removing and disposing of the substandard structures and contents therein or by reconstruction of said structures provided that said reconstruction or demolition can be accomplished in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 457 within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of this order.
- WHEREAS, THE PROPERTY OWNERS, occupants and any person having 3. possession or control of the premises should abate the condition by removing and disposing of the excess outside storage of materials and accumulation of rubbish from the subject real property in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 and 541 (Riverside County Code Titles 17 and 8.120) within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of this order.
- WHEREAS, THE OWNERS AND INTERESTED PARTIES ARE HEREBY 4. FUTHER NOTICED that the time within which judicial review of the administrative determinations

ORDER TO ABATE NUISANCE

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the substandard structures on THE PROPERTY located at 27530 Jackson Avenue, Romoland, Riverside County, California, also identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 329-212-006 be abated by THE PROPERTY OWNERS, specifically Clyde Smith and Bonnie Smith, and anyone having possession or control of THE PROPERTY, by razing and removing the substandard structures and contents therein or by reconstruction of said structures provided such reconstruction can be accomplished in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 457 within ninety (90) days of the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the substandard structures are not razed, removed and disposed of, or reconstructed in strict accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 457, within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of this Order, the substandard structures and contents therein shall be abated by representatives of the Riverside County Department of Building and Safety, a contractor or the Sheriff's Department upon receipt of an owner's consent or a Court Order where necessary under applicable law authorizing entry onto THE PROPERTY.

FURTHERMORE, THE PROPERTY OWNERS are ordered to ascertain the existence or non-existence of asbestos containing materials in said structures by survey and materials sample testing by a duly licensed and certified asbestos consultant; and, prior to the abatement ordered hereinabove, to secure the removal of all asbestos containing materials discovered through such survey and testing by contract with a duly certified and licensed contractor for the handling of such materials to avoid citations and/or fines by South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD).

- 4. On December 8 and 17, 2003, a Notice of Intention to Abate and Remove the Vehicles or Parts was mailed via certified mail, return receipt requested, to the OWNERS and identifiable registered owners of the vehicles at the addresses as listed with the Department of Motor Vehicles.
 - 5. At OWNERS' request, an administrative hearing was held on March 30, 2004.
- 6. On April 1, 2004, the Hearing Officer issued a Decision/Order that all of the forty-five vehicles and parts as set forth on the vehicle inventory were abandoned, wrecked, dismantled, and/or inoperative and constituted a violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 520 and a public nuisance subject to abatement. The Hearing Officer further ordered that the County shall remove all forty-five abandoned, wrecked, dismantled, or inoperative vehicles and parts in accordance with Riverside County Code Title 10 and related statues, regulations and ordinances.
- 7. On or about April 8, 2004, OWNERS requested an appeal to the Board of Supervisors. On September 28, 2004, a "Notice of Hearing on the Appeal of Administrative Order to Abate Public Nuisance" providing notification of the Board hearing scheduled for October 26, 2004 was mailed to the OWNERS and Interested Parties and was posted on THE PROPERTY on October 5, 2004.

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FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

WHEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on October 26, 2004 finds and concludes that:

- 1. WHEREAS, the forty-five (45) abandoned, wrecked, dismantled or inoperative vehicles and parts thereof on the real property described as 27530 Jackson Avenue, Romoland, Riverside County, Assessor's Parcel Number 329-212-006 as set forth in the vehicle inventory list attached hereto, violate Riverside County Ordinance No. 520 (RCC Title 10) and constitute a public nuisance subject to abatement by removal and disposal.
- 2. WHEREAS, all due process requirements were satisfied by the Department of Building and Safety. The Administrative Hearing Order/Decision, exhibits and testimony have been considered.
 - 3. WHEREAS, the Administrative Hearing Order/Decision is affirmed;
- 4. WHEREAS, OWNERS, or anyone having possession or control of the vehicles or vehicle parts are required to abate the public nuisance by removing all the vehicles and vehicle parts, as set forth in the vehicle inventory list from THE PROPERTY within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of this Board Order or by making them operable within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of this Board Order or by completely enclosing them within a building in a lawful manner where they are not visible from the street or other public or private property within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of this Board Order in accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances and Codes, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 520 (RCC Title 10).
- 5. WHEREAS, if the above described nuisance is not abated within ninety (90) days of issuance of the Board order, a designated representative of the Department of Building & Safety, a towing contractor and/or Sheriff's Department representative shall abate the nuisance by removal and destruction of the vehicles and parts pursuant to Riverside County Code Title 10 and applicable laws.
- 6. WHEREAS, the Owners, Appellants and Interested Parties are hereby further noticed that the time within which judicial review of the administrative determinations made herein must

be sought is ninety (90) days from the posting and mailing of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions and Order To Abate Nuisance, and is governed by <u>California Code of Civil Procedure</u> Section 1094.6.

ORDER TO ABATE NUISANCE

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the forty-five inventoried abandoned, wrecked, dismantled or inoperable vehicles and vehicle parts on the real property described as 27530 Jackson Avenue, Romoland, Riverside County, and further identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 329-212-006 violate Riverside County Ordinance No. 520 and constitute a public nuisance subject to abatement by removal.

The Administrative Hearing Order/Decision issued on April 1, 2004, is affirmed.

OWNERS, or anyone having possession or control of the vehicles and vehicle parts are required to abate the public nuisance by removing the vehicles and parts as set forth in the vehicle inventory list attached hereto, making them operable or completely enclosing them within a building in a lawful manner where they are not visible from the street or other public or private property within ninety (90) days of the posting and mailing of the Board order in accordance with all Riverside County Ordinances and Codes, including but not limited to Riverside County Ordinance No. 520 (RCC Title 10).

If OWNERS or anyone having possession or control of the vehicles and vehicle parts do not properly abate the public nuisance within ninety (90) days of posting and mailing of this Board Order, a designated representative of the Department of Building & Safety, a towing contractor and/or Sheriff's Department representative shall abate the public nuisance by removal and destruction of the forty-five inventoried, wrecked, dismantled, or inoperative vehicles pursuant to Riverside County Code Title 10 and all other applicable laws.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that reasonable costs of abatement, after notice and opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on the property which may be collected as a special assessment against the property pursuant to Government Code Section 25845 and Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 520 and 725 (RCC Titles 10 and 1). 



