BACKGROUND: Mr. Mizak is an Air Force veteran, served in Vietnam, and was nominated for VAC membership by VFW Post 9223, Riverside, CA. He has been active in the VFW, the American Legion and the RNC Memorial Honor Detail.

Mr. Hagen is a Navy veteran, also served in Vietnam, and was nominated by AMVETS Post 66, Rancho Mirage, CA. He has been active in the Navy League and the AMVETS-Express transportation service, transporting veterans from the Coachella Valley to the Loma Linda VA Medical Center.

Ms. Powell retired from the military as a Chief Master Sergeant after serving 38 years in the USAF, Air Force Reserves and the California Air National Guard. She has an extensive background in the medical and aero-space industries combining management, quality control and training skills and experience.

At the VAC's regular May 4, 2010 meeting, the district representatives present voted to recommend to the Board of Supervisors that Mr. Mizak, Mr. Hagen and Ms. Powell be re-appointed to a new 2-year term.
