SUBJECT: Construction of pedestrian sidewalk and associated improvements on Krameria Avenue in the Woodcrest area and on Mayberry Avenue in the Valle Vista area.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board accept the low bid of Mamco, Inc. of Riverside CA, in the amount of \$264,277. Award the contract to that firm and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents. Amend the TIP by approval of the proposed budget for Krameria Avenue as shown on Attachment A.

BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated April 20, 2010 (agenda item 3.72) the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the Construction of pedestrian sidewalk and associated improvements on Krameria Avenue in the Woodcrest area and on Mayberry Avenue in the Valle Vista Area. Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, May 05, 2010. Five bids were received. The

Transportation Department's established basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid for all schedules of work. The lowest and best total bid was submitted by Mamco, Inc of Riverside CA, in the amount of \$264,277. The bid is \$ 139,923 (34.6%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

Krameria Avenue improvements include construction of sidewalk on both north and south sides of Krameria Avenue between Lois Lane and Washington Street. All existing obstructions such as fences, road signs, irrigation systems, mailboxes, trees, and water meters will be relocated as needed. Additional improvements such as widening, additional curb and gutter, curb returns, and curb outlets will also be constructed.

Mayberry Avenue improvements include construction of sidewalk on the south side of Mayberry Avenue between Darmouth Middle School and Stanford Street. All existing obstructions such as fences, road signs, irrigation systems, mailboxes, trees, and water meters will be relocated as needed. Additional improvements such as widening, additional curb and gutter, curb returns, and curb outlets will also be constructed.

The proposed sidewalk will provide a safe path of travel to school. Additional safety improvements include the installation of an access ramp at the intersection of Mayberry Avenue and Standford Street.

The bid documents include the following schedules of work:

Schedule A: Primary items of work on Krameria Avenue.

Alternate 1: Krameria Avenue, adjustment and relocation of water meters and fire hydrants, to be funded by the Western Municipal Water District.

Schedule B: Primary items of work on Mayberry Avenue.

Alternate 2: Mayberry Avenue, relocation of water meters, to be funded by the project, (Item 51) due to prior property rights of the District.

The work contemplated under Alternate bid schedule 1 will be performed by the utility owner, Western Municipal Water District, and that schedule of work is not recommended for award.

The work included in Alternate bid schedule 2 is recommended for award.

The Mayberry Avenue project is within the existing budget as shown on Attachment A.

The Contractor will execute the contract and provide bonds and insurance documents after Board approval. The Contractor is qualified.

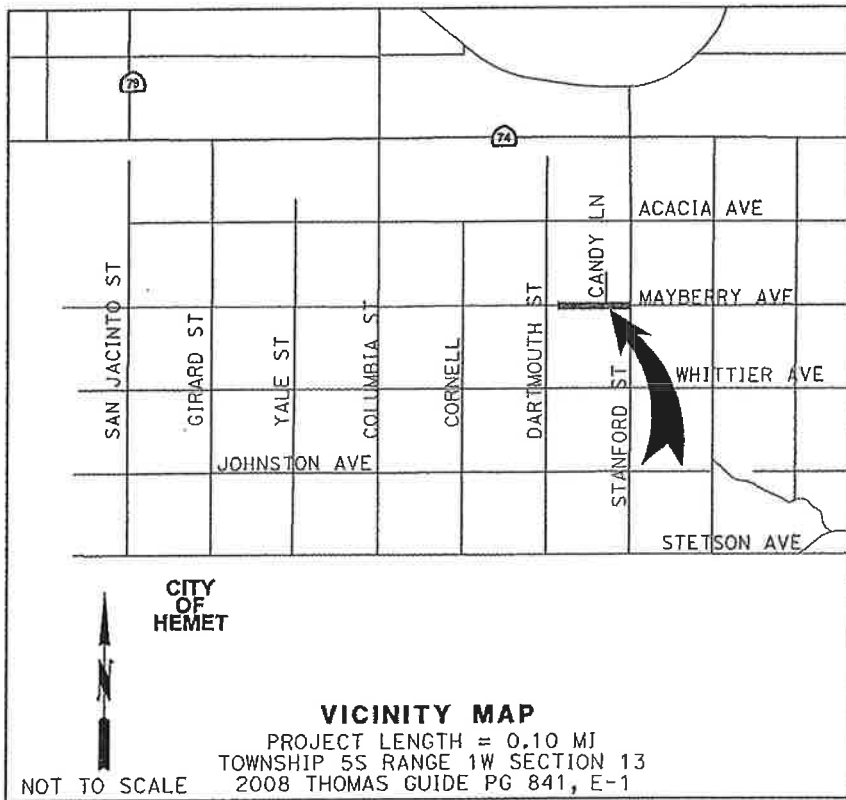

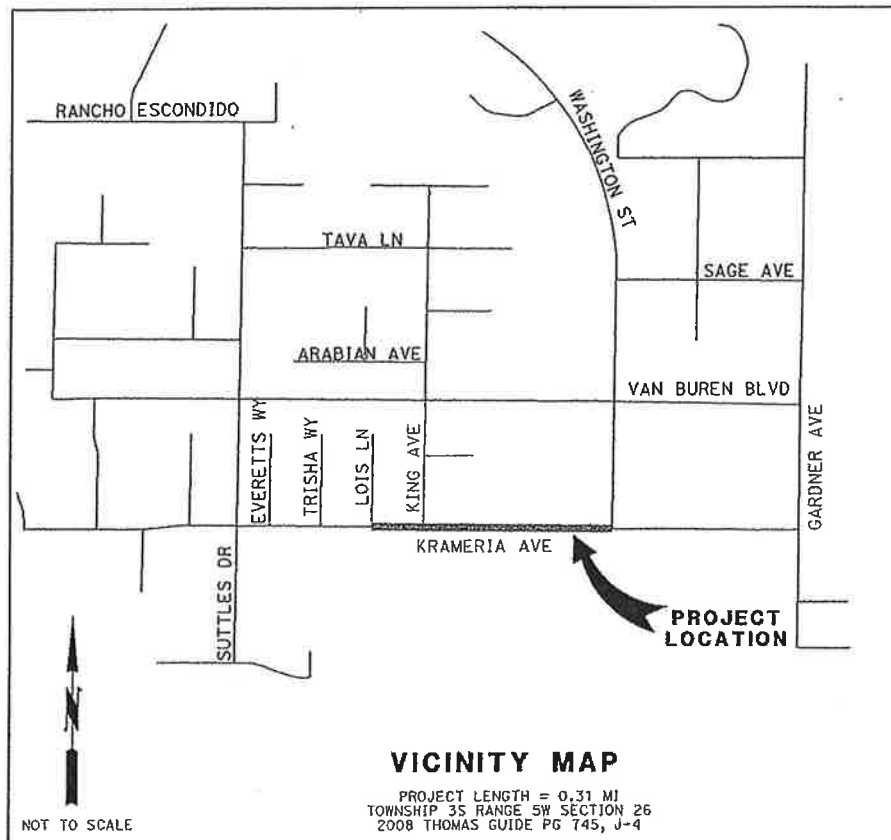
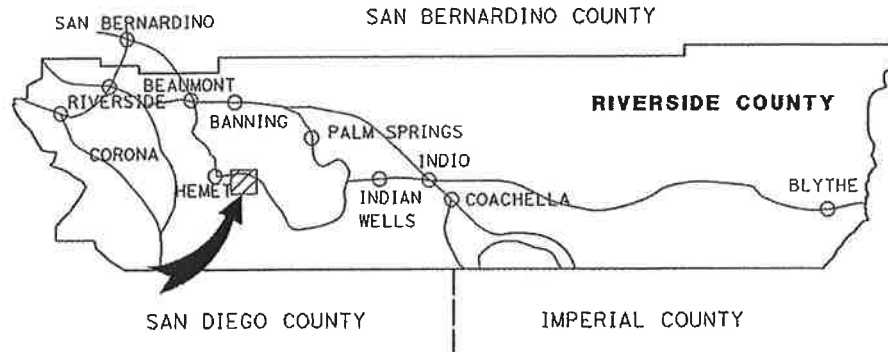

 - d. We will have the right to participate in the defense of claims or suits against you seeking damages because of injury to which this insurance may apply. We will have a duty to defend such claims or suits when the applicable limit of insurance of the "Underlying Insurance" has been exhausted by payment of judgments, settlements and any cost or expense subject to such limit. We may, at our discretion, investigate and settle any claim or suit. Our right and duty to defend end when the applicable limit shown in the Declarations has been used up by our payment of judgments or settlements.

SECTION II – EXCLUSIONS

The exclusions applicable to the "Underlying Insurance" also apply to this insurance.

SECTION III – LIMITS OF INSURANCE

1. The Limit of Insurance shown in the Declarations as EACH OCCURRENCE is the most we will pay for damages arising out of any one occurrence or offense.

5. If this policy is cancelled, we will send the first Named Insured any premium refund due. If we cancel, the refund will be pro rata. If the first Named Insured cancels, the refund may be less than pro rata. The cancellation will be effective even if we have not made or offered a refund.
6. If notice is mailed, proof of mailing will be sufficient proof of notice.


