Center. The tabulation shows that votes representing 0 parcels out of a possible 1 were cast, and that 0 votes (or 0%) were cast in favor of the annexation of Zone 150 to L&LMD No. 89-1-C and the levy and enrollment of the special assessment. Pursuant to Section 22593 of the Streets and Highways Code, this represents a majority protest and the proceedings for the annexation of Zone 150 must be abandoned.

The project proponent has since reapplied for annexation into L&LMD No. 89-1-C for traffic signal maintenance. A new election will be conducted pursuant to that application.
