**SUBJECT:** Amendment to Riverside County Ordinance No. 769, "Establishing Parcel Fees on Land Located in the Idyllwild, and Anza/Pinyon Areas to Provide for the Collection of Solid Waste Generated from Residential Use of Such Parcels"

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

1. That the Board introduces and sets for Public Hearing the adoption of Ordinance No. 769.3;
2. That the Board authorizes the Clerk to place an advertisement for the Public Hearing in the appropriate local publications; and
3. That, upon the close of the Public Hearing, the Board adopts Ordinance 769.3.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Board adopted a program to restructure the waste collection, transfer and disposal system for Franchise Area 8 (the Mountain Area). Ordinance 769 was developed to provide the legal basis to establish residential waste collection parcel fees. These fees are to cover the cost of operating the residential collection centers in Anza, Idyllwild and Pinyon. The Department of Waste Management administers the account and pays the franchise hauler for the cost of operating the collection centers. (Continued)

The placement of the costs on the property taxes keeps the service price low for residents by avoiding the cost of billing and collection.

### **Adjustment Details**

Using the CPI calculation as described in the Franchise Agreement, the total rate for residential access to the collection center is to increase from an annual rate of \$115.40 to \$116.89. The last adjustment for this rate was in June 2007.

### **FISCAL**

The approval of this change will result in no cost to the County. The Franchise Hauler has agreed to pay for one half of the cost of the legal publication for this ordinance amendment.
