RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation Funds for the renovation of the kitchen in the Kay Cineceros Cultural Center at the Edward-Dean Museum & Gardens; and
2. Direct the Auditor-Controller to adjust appropriations, estimated revenue and designations as follows:

Decrease Designation:

320135-10000-1000100000 Community Improvement \$50,000

Increase Appropriations:

551100-10000-1000100000 Contribution to other Co. Funds \$50,000

Increase Estimated Revenue:

790600-32710-1900100000 Contributions from other Co. Funds \$50,000


Increase Appropriations:

536200-32710-1900100000 Contribution to Non-Co Agency \$50,000

BACKGROUND: The Edward-Dean Museum & Gardens is a County museum and cultural resource. The kitchen at the Kay Cineceros Cultural Center is in desperate need of rehabilitation and renovation. This use of Community Improvement Designation funds contributes towards the cost.

I request that the Board of Supervisors approve a contribution of \$50,000 to support this effort.


