FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE CONSULTING SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE VERNOLA BASIN/PARK PROJECT BY AND BETWEEN THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND ALBERT A. WEBB ASSOCIATES

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties entered into the original Agreement on September 27, 2005 ("Agreement"), to provide engineering services to design the Bellegrave Flood Detention Basin, realign Bellegrave Avenue and Wineville Avenue, design Pat's Ranch Road, produce traffic signal plans, water and sewer improvements to the site, and provide construction management services, for a total contract amount of four hundred eighty-six thousand, one hundred fifty dollars (\$486,150); and

WHEREAS, additional construction management and administration services were required due to unforeseen circumstances associated with utility conflicts, field conditions, redesign and economic factors regarding specific plan 266 (I-215 Corridor), and the three month estimated schedule for street improvement construction extending to approximately twelve months, as described within Attachment "A-1"; and

WHEREAS, Agency requested that Consultant provide additional construction management and administrative services to ensure completion of the Vernola Basin and Park Project; and

WHEREAS, the additional fee for those services are sixty-seven thousand, nine hundred sixteen dollars (\$67,916).

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and providing that all other sections not amended remain intact, the parties hereto do hereby agree as follows:

- A. Section 1 of the Agreement is hereby amended by replacing the section as follows:
- "1. <u>SCOPE OF WORK</u>. CONSULTANT will provide services which are described on Attachment "A" and Attachment "A-1" attached hereto and incorporated here by this reference."
- B. Section 2 of the Agreement is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:
- "2. COMPENSATION AND METHOD OF PAYMENT. Consultant's compensation for work associated with the Agreement and First Amendment shall be an amount for actual work performed not to exceed five hundred fifty-four thousand, sixty-six dollars (\$554,066.00) The compensation for work under Attachment "A-1" is detailed in Exhibit "B-1" attached hereto and incorporated herein. Consultant shall submit invoices to the Agency for progress payments based on work completed to date and shall provide all required backup including certified payroll. The AGENCY shall reimburse the CONSULTANT within thirty (30) days of the receipt of invoice."
- C. Section 4 of the Agreement is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:
- 4. <u>TIME OF PERFORMANCE</u>. Consultant shall commence and complete performance of services described in Attachment "A" and Attachment "A-1" within fifty-six (56) months of the original execution of the Agreement by Agency, and agrees that it will diligently and responsibly pursue the performance of the services required of it by this Agreement.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

1. <u>Construction Management and Inspection Services for Wineville and Bellegrave Street Improvements:</u>

The most extensive change in our Scope of Services is the additional construction management and inspection services that have been provided. Originally, we were contracted to provide construction management and inspection services for a three month schedule (4 hours of inspection services and 3 hours of construction management services per day) in the amount of \$59,350. Due to the extended construction schedule; Webb Associates has provided construction management and inspection services for approximately twelve months.

Additionally, there have been other areas of work that have been included within the project that are outside our original Scope of Services. These efforts included:

- Bid support services;
- Construction support engineering services for Vernola Park;
- Off-site construction support engineering services for street and storm drain improvements;
- Review and approval of asphalt, cement, aggregate base, water, sewer, storm drain, traffic signal and other submittals as requested;
- Reviewed and responded to Requests for Information (RFI);
- Attendance at periodic meetings;
- Provided coordination with the County of Riverside;
- Provided coordination with Jurupa Community Services District and other utility companies;
- Provided staking services for the Southern California Edison Vault; and
- Reimbursable expenses, including mileage

Webb Associates is requesting an increase to the original budget in the amount of \$85,500 for the additional services provided.

2. <u>Deletion of Construction Staking and Surveying Services for Street Improvement and Traffic Signal:</u>

Our original Scope of Services included construction staking and surveying services in the amount of \$25,069. The contractor provided his own staking, surveying, and certification services for the street and traffic signal improvements, Vernola Park improvements, storm drain, sewer, water, and the area around the CDA well site. To offset the increase to the original contract amount; we request your permission to credit the unused staking and surveying budget into the construction management and inspection services budget.

3. Additional Services for Park Water and Sewer Line Design

Webb's original Scope of Services included the design of sewer lines for the proposed park and school site. The proposed sewer line that was to serve the school site was abandoned. Webb Associates was asked to prepare an alternative design for the proposed sewer line. This required additional coordination to obtain approval of the revised water and sewer plans from the Jurupa Community Services District, Riverside County Transportation Department, and Riverside County Fire Department. Webb Associates is requesting an additional \$11,785 for the increase to our Scope of Services.

4. Reimbursable Expenses:

Our original Scope of Services included a budget of \$4,300 for reimbursables to be used for printing, copying, and mileage.

5. Prepare As-built Plans:

Webb Associates will prepare "as-built" plans for water and sewer according to contractor provided redline. We will coordinate with Jurupa Community Services District for approval.
