SUBJECT: Approval of 2010/2011 Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) Award and Resolution No. 2010-177

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

1. Approve the 2010/2011 Juvenile Accountability Block Grant application and accept grant award;
2. Adopt Resolution No. 2010-177, authorizing the Sheriff or designee to sign the grant agreement and any future amendments, modifications, and/or claims;
3. Authorize the Sheriff or designee to sign an agreement with the City of Indio for their portion of the grant.

BACKGROUND: The State Corrections Standards Authority (CSA) has allocated funding to the County under the Federal Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) 2010/2011 Program. The purpose of this funding is to promote development or continuation of local juvenile justice programs that hold juvenile offenders accountable to the community and courts. The allocation to Riverside County for expenditures during Fiscal Year 2010-2011 is \$94,338, with a 10% match (\$9,434) of total project costs of \$103,772.

BR 11-002 Approval of 2010/2011 Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) Award and Resolution No. 2010-177
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In Fiscal Year 2010-2011 JABG funding of \$54,818 will be used to support the collection of data for the Coachella Valley Violent Gang Task Force (CVVGTF) by reimbursing the salary and benefits of an Office Assistant III position from the Riverside County Sheriff's Department.

The balance of the JABG funding, \$39,520, will be made available for reimbursement to the City of Indio for expenditures on behalf of the Gang Task Force for services and supplies. The City of Indio will fund their share of the match. The Sheriff's Department will prepare a funding agreement between the city and county.

The allocation of project funding to the two agencies will be:

The position funded by the grant is an ongoing grant-funded position included in the Sheriff's Department budget. Budget adjustments are needed to reimburse the City of Indio for their portion.

6 WHEREAS the County of Riverside desires to receive and utilize federal grant
7 funds available through the Juvenile Accountability Block Grants (JABG) Program
8 administered by the Corrections Standards Authority (hereafter referred to as CSA).

9 BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
10 Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on July 13, 2010, that
11 the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside does hereby:

- 12 1. Authorize, on behalf of the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors, the
13 Sheriff to submit the JABG application and sign the Grant Agreement with the
14 CSA, including any amendments thereof that does not change the basic scope
15 of terms;
- 16 2. Agree to provide all matching funds required for said project, and abide by the
17 statutes and regulations governing the JABG Program as set forth by the CSA;

- 19 3. Assure that the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant
20 expenditures controlled by this body.
