



12 "A valid license may be renewed for a period of one (1) year upon written
13 application to the Sheriff made not later than fifteen (15) days after the date of expiration of the
14 current license. Said renewal application shall be accompanied by a non-refundable renewal fee
15 in the amount of one hundred and eleven dollars (\$111.00)."



4 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
5 COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, REGULATING MASSAGE

6 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, ordains as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 6 (a) of Ordinance No. 596 is amended to read as follows:

8 "Applications for a massage business license, a massage technician license, or for
9 a renewal of such licenses, shall be filed with the office of the Sheriff on forms prescribed by the
10 Sheriff, and shall be signed under penalty of perjury. The fee for a massage business license is
11 five hundred and ninety-five dollars (\$595.00) plus such sum as is currently charged by the
12 Department of Justice of the State of California for a fingerprint check of an individual, and the
13 fee for renewal shall be three hundred and sixteen dollars (\$316.00). The fee for a massage
14 technician license is two hundred and twenty-four dollars (\$224.00) plus such sum as is currently
15 charged by the Department of Justice of the State of California for a fingerprint check of an
16 individual, and the fee for renewal is one hundred and twenty dollars (\$120.00). The appropriate
17 fee shall accompany the filing of each application. These fees are nonrefundable and shall be
18 used to defray the cost of processing each such application. The fees set forth herein shall be in
19 effect until the Board of Supervisors shall by resolution fix some other fees upon the basis of a
20 cost analysis as determined by the County Auditor-Controller."

21 Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the date of its adoption.



3 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF**
4 **RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 608**
5 **RELATING TO REMOVAL AND STORAGE FEES CHARGED BY THE CORONER**

6 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, ordains as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 608 is amended to read as follows:

8 “Pursuant to Government Code Section 27472, whenever the Sheriff-Coroner-Public
9 Administrator takes custody of a dead body pursuant to law, he or she may charge and
10 collect from the person entitled to control the disposition of the remains, as specified in
11 Section 7100 of the Health and Safety Code, the actual expense incurred by the Coroner
12 in removing the body from the place of death and keeping the body until its release to the
13 person responsible for its internment. The charge under Government Code Section
14 27472 shall not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00);

15 “Government Code Section 54985 (a) provides that notwithstanding any other
16 provision of the law that prescribes an amount or otherwise limits the amount of a fee or
17 charge that may be levied by a County, a County Board of Supervisors shall have the
18 authority to increase or decrease the fee or charge, that is otherwise authorized to be
19 levied by another provision of law, in the amount reasonably necessary to recover the
20 cost of providing any product or service or the cost of enforcing any regulation for which
21 the fee or charge is levied. The fee or charge may reflect the average cost of providing
22 any product or service or enforcing any regulation. Indirect costs that may be reflected
23 shall be limited to those items included in the federal Office of Management and Budget
24 Circular A-87 on January 1, 1984;

25 “The Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator has calculated the amount of \$320.00, as
the average cost incurred when removing a body from the place of death and keeping the

1 body until its release to the person responsible for its internment. This fee shall include
2 the following: salaries and benefits of County employees, indirect expenses and expenses
3 for materials and services; and

4 "The Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator is authorized to charge and collect from
5 the person entitled to control the disposition of remains, as specified in the Health and
6 Safety Code Section 7100, the fee of \$320.00 when removing a body from the place of
7 death and keeping the body until its release to the person responsible for its internment."

8 Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the date of adoption.

of an individual and shall forward the remainder to the Planning Department. When a renewal
application fee is paid, the Sheriff shall retain the entire amount."





Ordinance No. 596.2 (An Amendment to the Ordinance of the County of Riverside authorizing the Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator to charge a processing fee of \$595 for a license to operate a massage business and a processing fee of \$316 for a business license renewal; a processing fee of \$224 for a massage technician license and a processing fee of \$120 for a license renewal).

Ordinance No. 608.8 (An Amendment to an Ordinance of the County of Riverside authorizing the Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator to charge a fee of \$320 for body removal and storage).

Ordinance No. 743.3 (An Amendment to the Ordinance of the County of Riverside authorizing the Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator to charge a processing fee of \$510 for a license to operate a sex-oriented business and a processing fee of \$276 for a business license renewal).

Ordinance No. 836.3 (An Amendment to an Ordinance of the County of Riverside authorizing the Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator to sell bail bond signboard advertising in County Correctional Facilities for a fee of \$55 per month per facility).

Ordinance No. 837.4 (An Amendment to an Ordinance of the County of Riverside authorizing the Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator to charge a fee of \$1,958 for the performance of an autopsy).

BACKGROUND:

The Sheriff's Department has computed the appropriate updated billing rates for the Sheriff's Schedule of Fees, in accordance with the associated legal authority. These rates, except for those set by State law, reflect full cost recovery for all services listed.

The following fee modifications are noteworthy.

The administrative cost to draft ABC letters (a notification to the Alcohol Beverage Control Board that the Sheriff has approved a temporary permit to dispense alcoholic beverages) has increased due to the requirement that a Sheriff's Captain review the letter.

The cost for the Neuropathologist rate now includes fees from the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office, which is handling certain Neuropathology exams (study of the pathology of the brain, spinal cord and eyes) for the County under contract (4/20/10 3.63). Per this new contract, the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office charges on a three basis, relative to the complexity of the case.

Staff has added a County processing fee to the issuance of a Secondhand Dealer license and license renewal. The State authorizes the local authority to charge this fee per the Business and Professions Code in Sections 21641 & 21642.

Staff has also added a mileage rate for Sheriff's Corrections buses and vans.

The Updated Schedule includes six fees that require modification and are established by County Ordinance. Specifically, these Ordinances are:

Ordinance 508, last revised by the Board on November 18, 1987, includes the Sheriff's processing fees for an initial license and a renewal license to engage in fortunetelling. The current Ordinance sets license fees at \$250 for the initial license and \$100 for the renewal.

Based on current average salaries and benefits for positions involved in the licensing process, Sheriff's staff proposes the initial license fee be set at \$130, plus current State Department of Justice fingerprint check fees. Staff proposes the fee for a license renewal be set at \$111.

Ordinance 596, last revised by the Board on November 14, 1989, currently includes the Sheriff's processing fee for an initial massage business license and renewal, currently set at \$500 and \$200, respectively. Further, the Ordinance includes the Sheriff's processing fee for a massage technician license and renewal, currently set at \$200 and \$100, respectively.

Based on current average salaries and benefits for positions involved in the licensing process, Sheriff's staff proposes the initial massage business license fee be set at \$595, plus current State Department of Justice fingerprint check fees. Staff proposes the fee for a license renewal be set at \$316.

For a massage technician license and renewal, based on current average salaries and benefits for positions involved in the licensing process, Sheriff's staff proposes the initial license fee be set at \$224, plus current State Department of Justice fingerprint check fees. Staff proposes the fee for a license renewal be set at \$120.

Ordinance No. 608, last amended by the Board on November 18, 2008, established a fee of \$255 for the removal and storage of a body. Based on FY 2008-09 expenditures and current average salaries and benefits for positions involved in the process, Sheriff's staff proposes the fee be set at \$320.

Ordinance No. 743, last amended by the Board on July 2, 1996, currently includes the Sheriff's processing fee for an initial sex-oriented business license set at \$500 and \$250 for a license renewal. Based on current average salaries and benefits for positions involved in the licensing process, Sheriff's staff proposes the initial business license fee be set at \$510, plus current State Department of Justice fingerprint check fees. Staff proposes the fee for a license renewal be set at \$276.

Ordinance No. 836, last amended by the Board on July 17, 2007, established a fee of \$54 per month per County Correctional Facility for bail bond signboard advertising. Based on FY 2008-09 expenditures and current average salaries and benefits for a position involved in the process, Staff has recalculated the fee and proposes a monthly fee per facility signboard of \$55.

Ordinance No. 837, last amended by the Board on November 18, 2008, established a fee of \$2,045 for the County Coroner's Office to conduct an autopsy. Based on FY 2008-09 expenditures and current average salaries and

benefits for positions involved in the process, Sheriff's staff proposes the fee be set at \$1,958. If Toxicology tests are required, charges from a contracted laboratory will be added to this fee. If Histology tests are required, a fee of \$245 will be assessed, which includes charges from a contracted laboratory, plus costs for Sheriff's personnel time.

As indicated above, Sheriff's staff is proposing that public hearings on the modification of the fees associated with these Ordinances be set for July 13, 2010.

Section 1. Section 6 (B) (b) of Ordinance No. 508 is amended to read as follows:
"A non-refundable application fee consisting of the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars (\$130.00) plus such sum as is currently charged by the Department of Justice of the State of California for a fingerprint check of an individual."

Section 2. Section 8 (B) of Ordinance 508 is amended to read as follows:
"A valid license may be renewed for a period of one (1) year upon written application to the Sheriff made not later than fifteen (15) days after the date of expiration of the current license. Said renewal application shall be accompanied by a non-refundable renewal fee in the amount of one hundred and eleven dollars (\$111.00)."

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the date of its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 596.2

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, REGULATING MASSAGE**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 6 (a) of Ordinance No. 596 is amended to read as follows:
"Applications for a massage business license, a massage technician license, or for a renewal of such licenses, shall be filed with the office of the Sheriff on forms prescribed by the Sheriff, and shall be signed under penalty of perjury. The fee for a massage business license is five hundred and ninety-five dollars (\$595.00) plus such sum as is currently charged by the Department of Justice of the State of California for a fingerprint check of an individual, and the fee for renewal shall be three hundred and sixteen dollars (\$316.00). The fee for a massage technician license is two hundred and twenty-four dollars (\$224.00) plus such sum as is currently charged by the Department of Justice of the State of California for a fingerprint check of an individual, and the fee for renewal is one hundred and twenty dollars (\$120.00). The appropriate fee shall accompany the filing of each application. These fees are nonrefundable and shall be used to defray the cost of processing each such application. The fees set forth herein shall be in effect until the Board of Supervisors shall by resolution fix some other fees upon the basis of a cost analysis as determined by the County Auditor-Controller."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the date of its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 608.8

"The Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator has calculated the amount of \$320.00, as the average cost incurred when removing a body from the place of death and keeping the body until its release to the person responsible for its internment. This fee shall include the following: salaries and benefits of County employees, indirect expenses and expenses for materials and services; and

"The Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator is authorized to charge and collect from the person entitled to control the disposition of remains, as specified in the Health and Safety Code Section 7100, the fee of \$320.00 when removing a body from the place of death and keeping the body until its release to the person responsible for its internment."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the date of adoption.




