On December 18, 2003 the RCPDFA issued \$22.31 million in Lease Revenue Bonds (2008 Series A) to construct various capital projects, one of which was the Coachella Valley Animal Campus.

On October 13, 2003, the RCPDFA entered into a sales agreement with The Animal Samaritans SPCA, Inc. to purchase approximately five acres of Animal Samaritans' 10.72 acres. In consideration for the purchase the RCPDFA paid Animal Samaritans \$100 (one hundred dollars) and agreed to make certain improvements around the properties, to include street improvements. These improvements were funded through the 2008 Series A and subsequently completed.

In 2009, as part of the Coachella Valley Animal Campus, Animal Samaritans constructed a new Veterinary Medical Center next to the RCPDFA animal shelter. Animal Samaritans notified the RCPFA that certain street improvements, as detailed in the sales agreement, had not been completed. Animal Samaritans completed the street improvements and are now asking for reimbursement from the RCPDFA. Upon review by the county transportation department, the RCPDFA had completed the improvements as required under the sales agreement. However, during negotiation of the sales agreement it had been the intent for the RCPDFA to provide street improvements along Animal Samaritans property that would allow them to construct their veterinary medical center.

Because Animal Samaritans clinic is intended to support the animal campus, the county, RCPDFA and residents will benefit from the additional street improvements. As such, it is being recommended that the county contribute \$138,155.08, from the Palm Desert Redevelopment Tax Increment, to the RCPDFA in order for the RCPDFA to pay for the street improvements in question.

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RESOLUTION NO. 2010-226

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TO MAKE A CONTRIBUTION TO THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY PALM DESERT FINANCING AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside and the Palm Desert Redevelopment Agency have formed the Riverside County Palm Desert Financing Authority ("RCPDFA") under Section 6502 of the Joint Powers Act (California Government Code Section 6500 et seq.) for the purpose of financing capital projects;

WHEREAS, Section 6504 of the Joint Powers Act authorizes members of a joint powers authority to make contributions to the authority from their respective treasuries in furtherance of any purpose of the authority;

WHEREAS, Section 8 of that certain RCPDFA Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement authorizes the County as a member of RCPDFA to make contributions to RCPDFA in furtherance of any purpose of RCPDFA and Section 7 of the agreement authorizes RCPDFA to receive and use contributions from the County for any purpose;

WHEREAS, in 2003, the RCPDFA issued \$22.31 million in lease revenue bonds to construct various capital projects, including the Coachella Valley Animal Campus;

WHEREAS, in 2009, as part of the Coachella Valley Animal Campus, Animal Samaritans SPCA, Inc. ("Animal Samaritans") constructed a new veterinary medical center that required the construction and completion of certain associated street improvements;

WHEREAS, Animal Samaritans constructed the required street improvements and requested reimbursement from RCPDFA;
