SUBJECT: June 8, 2010 Election Report

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors receive and file the attached report from the Executive Office and direct the Executive Office and the Registrar of Voters to proceed with proposed operational changes and equipment purchases described therein.

BACKGROUND: During the June 15, 2010 Board of Supervisors meeting, the Executive Office was directed to review procedures the Registrar of Voters used to conduct the June 8, 2010 primary election and report back within 30 days. The attached Executive Office report is based on information gathered from the Registrar of Voters, the Secretary of State, neighboring counties and other sources.

The report identifies and addresses issues and concerns about election operations, including an increasing number of vote-by-mail ballots returned on or just before Election Day; the late arrival of approximately 12,500 ballots after the polls closed; misunderstandings about the Registrar's report of a 100 percent precinct count; and staffing levels for counting vote-by-mail ballots before, during and after Election Day. Also attached is a report from the Registrar of Voters.

Recommendations at the end of the report include plans to continue working with the U.S. Postal Service to avoid future ballot delivery problems; equipment purchases to speed ballot counts; and improved communication and outreach programs to better inform the community about the elections process. The Executive Office will return to the Board for authorization once the county is prepared to proceed with equipment purchases.
